In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus looks out at the crowds and His heart breaks. He sees people who are tired, lost, and completely overwhelmed, like sheep without a shepherd. Instead of just feeling sorry for the crowd, He takes action. He calls His disciples together, gives them His own authority, and sends them out to help. This is the exact moment they change from followers into apostles, which literally means "those who are sent." Their job is to let everyone know that God's kingdom is right here.

That same mission falls on our parish today. Look around, and you will see plenty of people who are spiritually exhausted or carrying heavy burdens alone. Through our Baptism, Jesus sends us into our neighborhoods and workplaces to be His hands and feet. As He reminds us today: "Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give." Let's share His grace just as generously.

Let's also take this thought into deep prayer and consideration this week. Pray especially to realize how you have been given so much in your life with no cost to yourself. I know some people have had to earn everything they have, but many of us have simply been born into a good family that raised us well and nourished us with the faith.
