Are you being called to be a permanent deacon? Do you know someone you can invite to discern the diaconate? The Diocese of Crookston recently celebrated the ordination of

three men to the Permanent Diaconate. We have another group who are entering their third year of formation in the fall. The next formation group for the Diocese of Crookston will begin in the Fall of 2027. From Fall 2026 through Winter 2027, the Diocese will host a number of "Discerning the Diaconate" sessions for men, and spouses if married, to provide more information about the diaconate and deacon formation. An announcement with specific dates will be coming out in the fall.

In the meantime, if you wish to talk about the program before then, you can email Dcn. Mark Krejci, Director of Deacon Formation, at mkrejci@crookston.org to arrange a phone or zoom call. You are also strongly encouraged to talk with your pastor as well as deacons you may already know.

If you believe you know a man who should consider the diaconate, I encourage you to share this information with him. In a recent survey of Catholic deacons, they indicated that a parishioner's encouragement played a significant role in the deacon deciding to enter the formation program. Please approach men in your parish or encourage your priest to do so.
