Anderson, president of the Ethics and Public Policy Center, invites us to read the Declaration of Independence alongside the opening chapters of Genesis and to consider the vision of the human person the two hold in common.

Reflecting on creation, the natural law, and the "Nature and Nature's God" the founders invoked, Dr. Anderson will explore what it means that each of us is made in the image and likeness of God — and how that truth undergirds our endowment with life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. He will consider why we are created male and female, and why we are made not for isolation but for friendship and communion, with one another and with God, and the significance of the family as the foundation of society.

Come for an evening of substance and hope, with time for questions and conversation to follow.

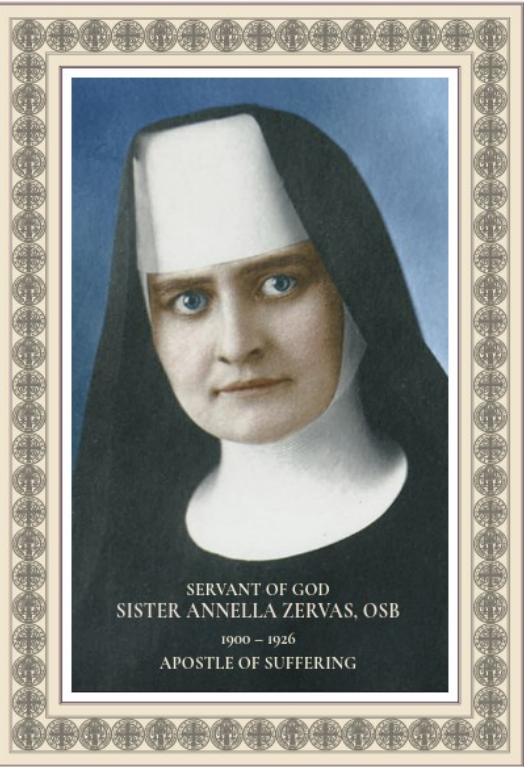
