TERMS AND CONDITIONS

WHO CAN ENTER?

The competition is FREE and open to anyone living in Western Australia, aged 17 and under.

HOW TO ENTER:

- The competition commences 14 March 2019 and finishes the 12 May 2019.
- To be a winner participants must locate either a Gold or Silver Feather bookmark in their local libraries.
- Participants are only eligible to receive a prize once for discovering either a Gold or Silver Feather.

HOW TO WIN:

- The participant that locates a Gold or Silver Feather bookmark must notify their parent/guardian and the librarian.
- Their parent/guardian must then follow the instructions provided and contact Scribblers Festival to claim the prize.
- In order to claim their prize, winners will need to post their Gold or Silver Feather along with the name and age of the child who has won as well as their parent or guardian's, address, contact telephone number and email address to FORM at:

- Scribblers Festival will only use this information in relation to communication about the Festival and Competition. Participants can choose to stop receiving information about Scribblers Festival at any time.

PRIZES:

SILVER FEATHER WINNERS

There are 20 Silver Feather bookmarks in circulation. Each participant who finds a Silver Feather will receive x1 age appropriate book, signed by the author and/or illustrator – the book will be selected by a representative of Scribblers Festival.

- Signed books will be posted to the Silver Feather winners at their specified address after the 12 May 2019.
- Prizes are non-refundable and cannot be exchanged.
- Prizes cannot be transferred to another party and are only redeemable by the feather finder.
- In the event the competition expires (a feather is not located, or a feather is located post 12 May 2019), in no way will Scribblers Festival be liable and therefore the prize will be deemed invalid.

GOLD FEATHER WINNERS

There are five (5) Gold Feather bookmarks in circulation which, when located, will result in a major prize. Each participant who finds a Gold Feather will receive:

- x1 iPad – (Apple iPad 32GB Wi-Fi).
- x2 night's accommodation in the Scribblers Festival hotel Friday 10 May and Saturday 11 May (children must be accompanied by their parent/guardian).
- Festival accommodation is at the Sage Hotel, West Perth. We offer one room with a maximum occupancy of two people with breakfast included. Participants will be responsible for any other expenses incurred as part of their stay at the hotel as per the hotel guidelines.
- VIP pass to Scribblers events at the Family weekend 11-12 May 2019 – the winner will be able to participate in two workshops for no cost and access front row seats at marquee events of their choice across the Festival weekend (the sessions the prize winner wants to attend must be sent through in writing to the Festival team prior to the commencement of the Festival).
- The prize winner along with their parent/guardian, will have access to the Festival green room for the duration of the Festival weekend.
- The prize winner will receive an age appropriate book pack.

All prizes will be given to the Gold Feather winners in person at the Festival 11-12 May 2019. In the event that the winner cannot attend all non-festival event related prizes (for example books) will be posted to the winner at their specified address after the 12 May 2019.

Prizes are non-refundable and cannot be exchanged.

Prizes cannot be transferred to another party and are only redeemable by the feather finder.

- Spending money, meals, travel to and from departure point are the responsibility of the winner unless otherwise stipulated.
- A travel allowance is available for winners living in regional areas within driving distance from Perth to assist with travel costs (regional areas are classed as areas 100km – 500km from Perth). The allowance will be determined on a case by case basis.
- A flight and accommodation package is available to winners living in remote regional areas (remote regional areas are classed as areas 500km or more from Perth). The package will be determined on a case by case basis.
- If applicable, flights and accommodation will be determined and organised by the Festival. In the event that the winners and their parent/guardian choose not to accept the flights and accommodation arranged by the Festival, the Festival will not be responsible for the travel or accommodation costs.
- The prize is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- In the event the competition expires (a feather is not located), in no way will Scribblers Festival be liable and therefore the prize will be deemed invalid.
