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Raw materials

Top-grain leather

- The topmost layers of the hide are buffed or sanded to allow for a desired appearance, improve finish adhesion, and reduce or remove the appearance of natural markings such as bug bites and wrinkles.
- A consistent or corrected grain is added back to the hide by embossing.
- Top-grain crust starts out like a blank canvas, perfect for consistency, yield, advanced finishes, and custom orders.

Full grain leather

- Full grain leather is not buffed or sanded and is designed to purposely maintain the naturally variable grain patterns and highlight the unique markings of each hide, such as wrinkles, scratches, stretch marks, brands, and bug bites.
- Some are mezza fiore: only buffed very slightly to allow for better adhesion of finishes.
- Generally, full grain leather is made from a higher grade crust with fewer markings and can be more expensive.

Where it gets confusing

Sometimes the surface of full grain leather is also lightly embossed to add grain consistency and increase yield, but the other natural markings such as stretchmarks and brands are purposely maintained to celebrate the unique beauty and luxury of full grain's distinctive characteristics.
