International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (PYP)

Designed for students aged 2 to 12. The PYP focuses on the development of the whole child as an inquirer — both within the classroom and in the wider world. Learning is guided by six transdisciplinary themes of global significance, explored through subject knowledge, skills, and conceptual understanding, with a strong emphasis on inquiry-based learning. The programme nurtures students to become active, caring, and lifelong learners.

Cambridge Curriculum Checkpoint & IGCSE

The Cambridge Checkpoint and Cambridge IGCSE form part of the Cambridge International Curriculum Framework.

- Cambridge Checkpoint provides structured academic benchmarks in Grades 7-8.
- Cambridge IGCSE is a globally recognised qualification for students aged 14-16, (in Grades 9-10), forming part of the Cambridge Secondary stage.

These programmes support academic progression and prepare students for further international qualifications.

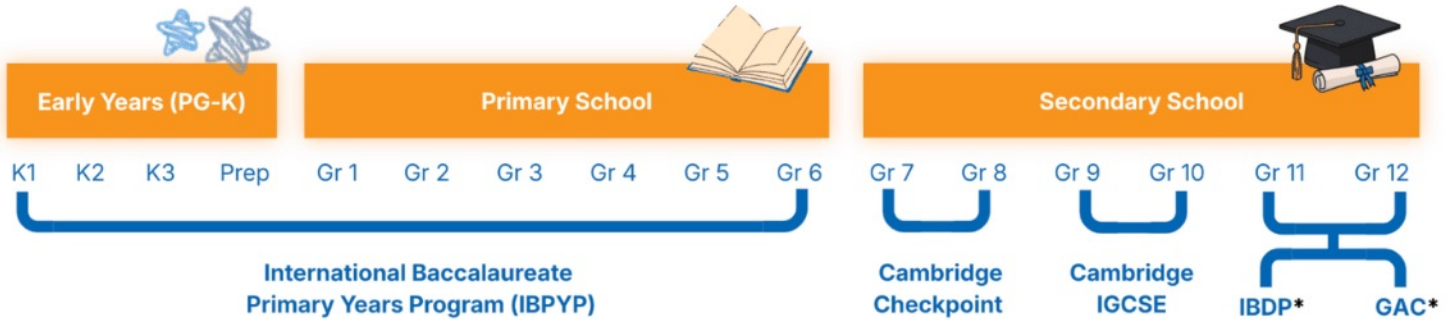

International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP)

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme is a two-year programme for students in Grades 11 and 12, providing an internationally recognised qualification for entry into higher education.

The IBDP is administered by the International Baccalaureate and is offered in IB World Schools across more than 140 countries.

Students study six subjects, one from each subject group, alongside three core components:

- Extended Essay (EE): An independent 4,000-word research essay
- Theory of Knowledge (TOK): Exploring how knowledge is constructed and connected across disciplines
- Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS): Encouraging personal growth, self-reflection, and community engagement

Assessment includes both internal and external components, with final examinations externally assessed by the IB.

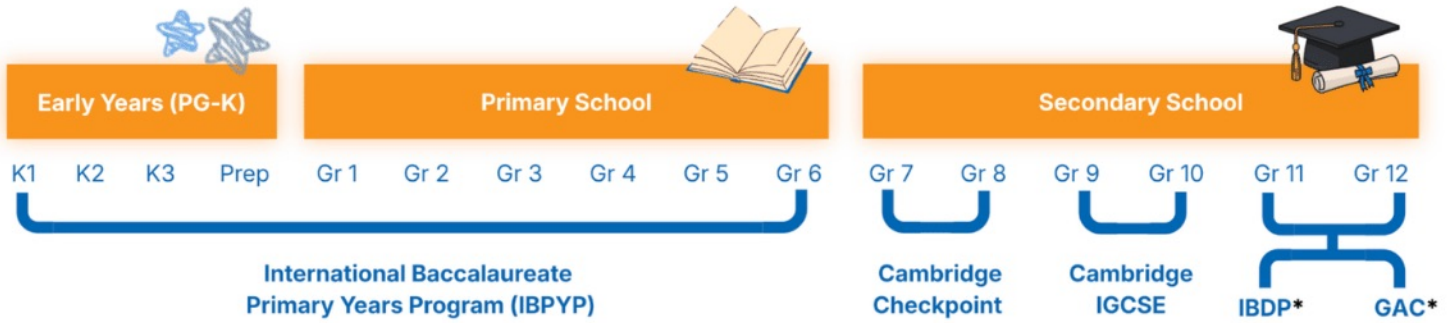

The Global Assessment Certificate (GAC) is an internationally recognised university preparation programme designed for students planning to pursue higher education in English-speaking countries.

The GAC focuses on:

- Academic English proficiency
- Critical thinking and research skills
- Communication and independent learning

The curriculum is structured across three progressive levels, covering subjects such as Academic English, Mathematics, Science, and Social Science, and includes preparation for standardised tests such as IELTS and ACT.
