4. **Contact Information:** Your full name, mailing address, telephone number, and email address.
5. **Good Faith Statement:** A statement that you have a good faith belief that the use of the material is not authorized by the owner, its agent, or the law.
6. **Accuracy Statement:** A statement that the information in the notification is accurate.
7. **Penalty of Perjury:** A sworn statement that you are authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is allegedly infringed.
