

Charter School Bermondsey celebrates record GCSE results

This year, 65% of students achieved a grade 4 or above in both English and Mathematics, while 44% secured a grade 5 or above in both subjects. An impressive 60% of students achieved a grade 5 or higher in English.

DfE [School Performance Tables](#) show headline Progress 8 scores of **+0.29 in 2023** and **+0.08 in 2024**, compared to the National average of **-0.03**. This means our students, on average, made better progress across their curriculum than those with similar starting points nationally.

The DfE is not able to calculate Progress 8 scores for academic years 2024/25 and 2025/26. Progress 8 shows the average progress pupils made from their Year 6 baseline. This is because no KS2 assessment data is available to calculate the baseline for Progress 8 for these years due to Covid-19 disruption.
