

Fabric Care & Cleaning Guide

Care instructions for all Napa Canvas fabric materials.

Sunbrella Fabric

Woven Acrylic — Care & Cleaning Guide

Light Cleaning	Heavy Cleaning / Mildew
1. Brush off all loose dirt.	1. Combine 1 cup bleach and 1/4 cup mild soap per gallon of water.
2. Hose the fabric down thoroughly.	2. Apply solution and allow to soak for up to 15 minutes.
3. Prepare a solution of mild soap and water.	3. Scrub with a soft bristle brush.
4. Use a soft bristle brush to clean.	4. Rinse thoroughly until all soap residue is removed.
5. Allow the solution to soak into the fabric.	5. Air dry completely.
6. Rinse until all soap residue is removed.	6. Repeat if necessary.
7. Air dry completely.	7. Re-treat fabric for water and stain resistance after bleach use.
<i>* Hose down monthly to prevent dirt buildup and reduce the need for deep cleaning.</i>	<i>* Bleach may affect non-Sunbrella components (thread, hardware). Use caution near plants or water. Always air dry — never machine dry.</i>

Weblon Coastline Plus

Vinyl-Coated Fabric — Care & Cleaning Guide

Light Cleaning	Heavy Cleaning / Mildew
1. Hose the fabric down.	1. Make a 50/50 bleach and water solution.
2. Apply mild soap to areas of accumulated dirt.	2. Use the solution to scrub stubborn areas with a soft brush.
3. Scrub gently with a soft bristle brush.	3. Allow the solution to remain for 2–3 minutes.
4. Rinse thoroughly and air dry.	4. Rinse thoroughly, keeping solution away from plants or materials that can be damaged by bleach.
<i>* Vinyl is waterproof and highly durable. Hosing down is sufficient for routine maintenance.</i>	<i>* Vinyl is mildew-resistant, but regular cleaning keeps commercial awnings looking sharp year-round.</i>

Phifertex / Phifer Solar Screen

Mesh Screen Fabric — Care & Cleaning Guide

Light Cleaning	Heavy Cleaning / Mildew
1. Prepare a solution of 1 tbsp. liquid dish detergent and 2 tbsp. household bleach in a gallon of water.	1. Use the same cleaning solution (1 tbsp. dish detergent + 2 tbsp. bleach per gallon of water).
2. Clean fabric using a sponge or soft cloth dipped in the solution.	2. Apply to affected areas and allow to soak briefly.
3. Rinse thoroughly with clean water.	3. Scrub gently with a soft cloth or sponge.
4. Air dry completely.	4. Rinse thoroughly and air dry.
<i>* Avoid direct contact with oil-based products, which may cause accelerated aging of the fabric.</i>	<i>* If oil-based contact occurs, clean promptly using the standard solution to minimize damage.</i>

Cordura Nylon

High-Tenacity Nylon — Care & Cleaning Guide

Light Cleaning	Heavy Cleaning / Mildew
1. Brush off loose dirt or debris.	1. Mix a solution of mild detergent and warm water.
2. Hose down with clean water.	2. Apply to stained areas and allow to soak for 5–10 minutes.
3. Apply a mild soap and water solution.	3. Scrub with a soft brush.
4. Scrub gently with a soft bristle brush.	4. For mildew, use a diluted bleach solution (1/4 cup bleach per gallon of water).
5. Rinse thoroughly and air dry.	5. Rinse thoroughly and air dry flat or hung.
<i>* Cordura Nylon is highly abrasion-resistant. Avoid harsh chemicals or solvents that may degrade the fabric coating.</i>	<i>* Do not machine wash or tumble dry. Always air dry to maintain shape and coating integrity.</i>
