Vinyl-Coated Fabric — Care & Cleaning Guide

Light Cleaning	Heavy Cleaning / Mildew
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Hose the fabric down.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Make a 50/50 bleach and water solution.
<ol style="list-style-type: none">2. Apply mild soap to areas of accumulated dirt.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">2. Use the solution to scrub stubborn areas with a soft brush.
<ol style="list-style-type: none">3. Scrub gently with a soft bristle brush.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">3. Allow the solution to remain for 2–3 minutes.
<ol style="list-style-type: none">4. Rinse thoroughly and air dry.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">4. Rinse thoroughly, keeping solution away from plants or materials that can be damaged by bleach.
<p><i>* Vinyl is waterproof and highly durable. Hosing down is sufficient for routine maintenance.</i></p>	<p><i>* Vinyl is mildew-resistant, but regular cleaning keeps commercial awnings looking sharp year-round.</i></p>
