Read [Matthew 22:37-39](#) and [Ephesians 2:10](#)

3. What do these verses say is God's purpose for our lives? Why was it necessary for God to create people to fulfill this purpose?
4. What does it mean to "love God with all your heart," and why is this important to God? What role does "loving our neighbors" play in fulfilling the purpose God has for our lives?
5. Where do you look to find the "good works" that God has prepared for you and your life? What are the dangers of looking to other places for answers?

Read [1 Corinthians 15:54-55](#), [John 11:25-26](#) and [John 14:1-3](#)

6. What do these verses say about what happens when our life on earth ends?
7. How difficult or easy is it for you to believe the promises that Jesus makes? What keeps you from believing in Him and accepting His offer of eternal life at His side?
