5. What does this illustration say about God? How does it help you better understand God and the importance of studying His word?
6. What do you think is the purpose of God sending out His word? What difference does this make in the things you think about and do daily?

Look Ahead:

In what ways are you "stuck" in unhealthy habits? What will you do differently to renew your mind?

Notes

God wants to transform our minds, but we tend not to let him. We trust our feelings instead of God's word and thoughts. Isaiah tells us that all we really need to do is turn to God to receive mercy and a new direction. If you choose to reject God, he allows it - He will not force you into heaven.

God promises to transform us with His word doing the work. He is capable of renewing our mind and creating new pathways that are in alignment with His.
