

Look Back:

- What was the greatest gift you received from God last year?

Look Up:**Read : John 16:12-15**

- Why do you think Jesus starts by telling his disciples that He had more to tell them, but that they could not bear it? How does this apply to people today?
- What does verse 13 say is the role of the Holy Spirit? What do these verses say that the Holy Spirit will guide people to? What does this mean to you personally?
- What do these verses say about “how” the Holy Spirit guides people? What does verse 14 say is the reason “why” the Holy Spirit guides believers?
- What do these verses say about God’s ability to communicate with us?

Read : Luke 11:5-13

- Why do you think Jesus used this illustration when teaching His disciples about prayer? What does this say about God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit?
- Why does prayer impact our communication with God? How has prayer impacted your communication with God in the past? How can it make a difference today?
- What do people typically ask God for in their prayers? What does John 16:13 imply that we should be asking for? Do you need to make any changes in what you have been asking God for?

Overall (Discovery Bible Study)

- What do these scriptures say about God?
- What do they say about people?
- How will I apply this to my life?

Look Ahead:

In what area of your life do you need to hear God’s guidance and truth right now?
Commit to asking God for guidance, rather than results in your prayers this week.
