To begin, click each image in the order listed below:

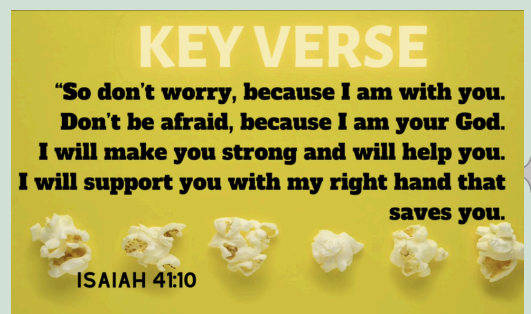
- **Image #1** - Click to see the Big Idea

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DISCUSS & DISCOVER

We looked at what it means to choose trust over fear. We kicked things off by watching a movie clip from Disney's Luca, specifically the "Silenzio Bruno" scene where Luca has to quiet his inner fears to take a big, scary step into a brand-new world. We connected his story to Matthew 14:22-33, where Peter has to make a very similar choice: stay safe in the boat during a huge storm, or trust Jesus and step out onto the water. We learned that while fear always talks to us, it shrinks when we choose to focus on and trust Jesus.

1. In the movie clip from Luca we watched, the characters tell their fear, "Silenzio Bruno!" to make it be quiet. If your fear had a silly name, what would you name it? What is a loud worry or fear it tries to whisper to you sometimes?
2. Peter had to take a literal step out of a boat into stormy waves to get to Jesus. What is something new or scary that feels like "stepping out of the boat" for you right now? (Parents: Share a time you felt this way too!)
3. We did an object lesson today where we watched a "Fear Balloon" shrink and pop when we chose to trust Jesus. What is one practical thing we can do as a family this week like praying together or remembering a specific promise to help our fears shrink when they start getting too big?

Pray: Dear God, Thank you for being bigger than any storm or fear we will ever face. When our worries start to feel as loud as the waves, help us to fix our eyes on Jesus and listen to His voice instead. Give us the courage to step out of our comfort zones this week, knowing that You are holding our hands every step of the way. We love You! Amen.
