To begin, click each image in the order listed below:

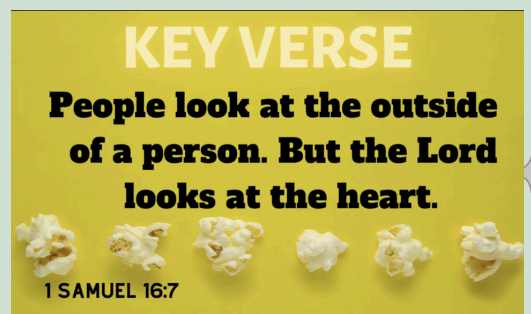
- **Image #1** - Click to see the Big Idea

DISCUSS & DISCOVER

Our lesson focused on a powerful truth: God looks at our hearts, not just our outside appearance, and He always sees our true potential! We started by watching a clip from Disney's Zootopia, where Officer Judy Hopps works hard to prove herself even though almost everyone else underestimates her because of her size. We connected this to the famous story of David and Goliath (1 Samuel 17). Even though David's own brothers, the soldiers, and the giant Goliath doubted him because he was just a young shepherd boy, God saw a brave future king.

1. In Zootopia, people didn't think Judy Hopps could be a real police officer just because she was a small bunny. Have you ever felt like someone doubted you or thought you couldn't do something just because you are a kid? How did that feel?
2. When the giant Goliath looked at David, he just laughed. But our lesson today showed that God saw courage, faith, and a giant-slayer! When you look in the mirror, what is one thing you hope God sees growing inside your heart?
3. We opened a plain, ordinary cardboard box today to find an awesome treasure inside. How can we practice looking past the "outside" of people at school or church this week so we can see them the way God does? (Parents: Tell your child about a time you felt underestimated, and how God helped you through it!)

Pray: Dear God, Thank you that You don't look at us the way the world does. While people look at the outside, we are so grateful that You look at our hearts and see all the potential, courage, and future plans You have put inside us. Help us remember that when others doubt us, Your opinion is the only one that matters. Give us the confidence to stand tall this week, knowing that You see more in us than anyone else can. Amen.
