Connect

The Bible has two sections—the Old Testament and the New Testament. Today's story comes from the New Testament book of Ephesians.

While in prison for sharing the gospel, a follower of Jesus named Paul wrote a letter to the Christians living in the city of Ephesus to share some incredible news about who God made them to be. As a family this week, talk about how Paul shared God's love even during tough times, and how we can share His love, too!

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DISCUSS & DISCOVER

1. This Bible story shows that God loves us so much. He made us alive even when we were stuck in sin, like we were dead! God gave us an “all-access wristband” to Him! God sent Jesus to give us a relationship with Him, now and forever, when we turn from sin and trust Jesus! We are saved by God’s grace when we turn from sin and follow Jesus. Then He helps us do good works, which God has planned for us from the beginning. What are some good works that you can do this week to help point others to God? (I can show love and kindness, even when someone does not deserve it. I can help others, sharing that I help because I love God. I can pray for others.)
2. Paul told the Christians in Ephesus that God made them alive through faith in Jesus. How can following Jesus make a difference in our lives? (We can know the peace and joy of God. We can know we have purpose because God has a plan for our lives.)
3. At some point, you might hear someone say, “I haven’t done a lot of bad stuff. Do I need God’s forgiveness?” How could today’s Bible story help answer that question? Can anybody be good enough not to need rescue from sin? (Nobody is good enough not to need rescue from sin. All of us have sinned, and all of us are separated from God. We all need God’s forgiveness because we are dead in sin.)

Pray: God, thank You so much for sending your Son, Jesus. Thank You for making the way for us to have new life with You. Help us turn away from our sins so we trust follow You forever. As we follow You, help us do good works as Your workmanship. Amen.
