Introduction

Requirements



I'm so glad you decided to press in for the next sixteen weeks, but before you get started, there are four things I need you to commit to doing from this moment forward. If you can't commit, this is not the devotional for you. Here it goes:

1. **Declare Each Prayer Point Out Loud**

I'm not asking you to say things because I'm on a power trip. When you speak out the truths contained in God's Word, something happens in the spirit—you are shaping a new reality that will inevitably manifest in the natural. Repeating your prayers rewires your brain. Whatever you want—be bold enough to declare it.

I used to refuse to say things like, "I'm rich." I thought it was a taboo thing to say. I thought rich people were supposed to pretend they didn't have money. Wealth was viewed negatively in the Hispanic culture that I grew up in, especially within Christian circles. It was considered spiritual to take an oath of poverty, and anything that resembled wealth was seen as worldly. So, we used

to hide nice things or downplay their worth, and even if we paid full price for something, we'd say, "Oh, this is from Goodwill."

My husband, Jonathan, was the first person I heard say, "I'll never be broke another day in my life." I remember thinking, 'We can say that?' I sheepishly repeated it, and that was the moment my life began to change. I started declaring all these promises of God over my life:

I will never be sick another day in my life.
I will never be poor another day in my life.
I'm the head and never the tail.
I'm above and never beneath.
I am blessed coming in and blessed going out.
I am a force in this world.
I am a blessing.

Now it's your turn. I want you to make these declarations daily and say them with your whole chest.

2. Meditate on These Truths Daily

Be specific and proactive. After you confess a prayer point out loud, meditate on it consistently. Focus on whatever you are believing God to do—one truth at a time. When you reinforce your confession with meditation, it keeps you in alignment with the words you've spoken. If you're driving home and suddenly find yourself worrying about finances, you can sidestep that thought and replace it with the meditation of your heart until it alters your thought process. Look up Scripture and repeat it throughout the day.

If you're battling depression, I want you to know that this is exactly what I did to break free from a suicidal mindset. I needed help and I didn't know what to do. So, I wrote a scripture on a little card or piece of paper and stuck it in my back pocket.

Whenever I started to feel anxiety, worry, or oppression, I'd recite the scripture on the card, then meditate on it until I stopped thinking about depression and fear. I focused on the Word of God until every oppressive thought left. Gloria Copeland says, "There is power in consistency," and nothing could be more true because this is what I did every day.

3. Align Your Actions with Your Words

Next, you need to take repeated action. Align your actions with what you speak and believe to create long-term habits. When you speak and meditate on God's Word and align your behaviors with Scripture, you will create a reality that reflects God's plan and purpose for your life.

4. Visualize Your Answered Prayer

Imagination is incredibly important. I read a book titled *The Power of Imagination* by Andrew Wommack, and it changed my life. I learned that your brain can't tell the difference between what it imagines and the reality it experiences.

I want you to practice visualizing what you're expecting God to do in your life. If it's healing—stop visualizing yourself in a casket with your children grieving your death. Why would you visualize not being alive to walk your daughter down the aisle? Knock it off! Envision yourself walking your daughter down the aisle. Picture yourself picking up your grandkids with your hair done and a face full of makeup, high heels on, driving in a convertible.

Picture your success, and then repeat it over and over with each prayer point. Visualization strengthens your brain's belief in what you see—it carves a path for your faith to take hold immediately. Have you ever noticed how some people say a thing, and it just manifests? I know a few people who get whatever they say without fail. It's because they've developed pathways of faith within

themselves, and it's enabled them to sidestep hesitation. I want you to get there. I want you to receive whatever you visualize, but that takes development—and that's what this book is designed to help you do.

You have to understand, with clarity, what belongs to you in the Scriptures, then close your eyes and imagine it taking place. You can't wait until a time of adversity rears its head. That's not how it works. You need to do it now when times are good so that when it's time to fight, you'll succeed.

The Bible says you can be fully equipped and lack no good thing (Psalm 34:10). You already have every offensive and defensive weapon at your disposal—identify them (Ephesians 6:13-17). Become familiar with the helmet of salvation, the breastplate of righteousness, the belt of truth, the shield of faith, the sword of the Spirit, and the shoes of peace.

Your knowledge and understanding will make you successful on the day of attack and adversity, so put in the effort now. Cement God's Word in your heart so that breakthrough quickly manifests. You can be confident God will come through because you've spent time in His Word and know His character so intimately, there's no room for doubt.

Week One

Build Your Faith



There are three aspects to faith: belief, confession, and action. This week, we will tackle all three to create a platform to receive answers to all the other prayers contained in this book.

Your Belief

Faith is the foundation for every prayer you'll ever pray. Without faith, there's no cause for you to expect your prayers to be heard or answered by God. It's integral that right off the bat, before you pray for anything, you understand how to pray prayers of faith. Jesus' words in the book of Mark demonstrate the faith necessary to receive from God.

Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."

MARK 9:23 (NKJV)

Jesus told the man that *all*, not some things, are possible when you believe. Anything in your life that seems like an impossibility, whether it's growth in your business, a breakthrough in your

ministry, or a transformation in your family, is in the realm of possibility for you *if* you can believe it.

My husband and I had dinner with our besties, Brother Jesse Duplantis and his wife Cathy, and I asked how they managed to break free from the religious Catholic mentality of poverty to enter into the blessing of God. Brother Jesse's response was illuminating. He told me that the more he studied the life of Jesus, the more he discovered that Jesus wasn't poor. That discovery led him to search for the true reality of Jesus' life. What was Jesus like? How did He live? What kind of resources did He command? The deeper he dove into Scripture, the easier it was for him to simply believe he had access to the same blessing Jesus did when He was on the Earth. That's when he decided to launch his ministry.

Forty-nine years later, his ministry is one of the most impactful in the world. That's what faith can do. Make no mistake—it took faith for him to start his ministry, and it required faith to build and grow it. When he first started, he had no invitations to preach and no leads. He stared at his yellow wired phone hanging on the wall (a long time ago, in a land far, far away, phones didn't have screens—they were hunks of plastic screwed to a wall.) Brother Jesse stood in front of the yellow phone on his wall and said, "Ring" with all the authority he could muster. Within three seconds, the phone rang. The person on the other end invited him to preach at a youth convention. That opportunity led to him preaching at a businessman's conference for the Assemblies of God. The person scheduled to preach was sick, and they asked him to come instead. Brother Jesse preached, and the crowd went wild. After the service, there was a line full of ministers who wanted him to preach for them. That one meeting enabled him to book a full schedule of preaching for the next five years.

You don't have to do things like everyone else does them—all you have to do is believe. The Bible says all things are possible if you just believe.

Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears, “Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!”

MARK 9:24 (NKJV)

For a long time, this verse didn't make sense to me. I used to wonder, 'How can you believe and also not believe?' The answer is: you can't. If you believe something, faith is present. As I studied this verse further, I discovered there's a difference between belief and faith. Belief is an intellectual agreement, a mental assent to what you hear, but faith takes action on your belief to create your reality.

DAY ONE

Eject Doubt

Jesus said to him, “If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes.”

MARK 9:23 (NKJV)

I want you to pray this prayer from your heart and truly mean it. Don't just read the words—speak them out loud to God.

Pray this out loud:

Lord, I believe Your Word. I command all forms of unbelief to leave my life. Strengthen my faith and silence every voice of doubt in my heart. I choose to stand on Your Word, knowing that all things are possible with You, in Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY TWO

Strength for All Things

I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

PHILIPPIANS 4:13 (NKJV)

Go back. Read that verse out loud. That scripture leaves no room for any excuses. If you can do all things through Christ, who gives you the strength, why would you ever allow the words “I can’t” to come out of your mouth? Why would you think or tell others that you’re not qualified? Allow me to let you in on the truth of the matter. You’re not too black, too Puerto Rican, too white, or too anything to complete the task God assigned you. Since you can do all things through Christ, who gives you strength, you can get out of any mess or difficult situation.

Declare this out of your mouth:

Father, I thank You that through Christ I have strength for every challenge. Help me to trust in Your power that’s within me, and empower me to walk boldly in faith. I refuse to doubt your ability or Your integrity, in Jesus’ name, Amen.

You have the strength for every challenge. You walk boldly in His power that’s within you. Refuse to doubt God’s ability at work in you. You have been strengthened to accomplish the impossible and glorify the name of the Lord. Believe in yourself.

No more excuses. It’s time for you to step out and do exactly what He’s called you to do because if He called you to do it, He equipped you for it.

Your Confession

This Book of the Law shall not depart out of your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, that you may observe and do according to all that is written in it. For then you shall make your way prosperous, and then you shall deal wisely and have good success.

JOSHUA 1:8 (NKJV)

It's vitally important to pray and speak with a heart that believes. The above scripture says, "You will make *your* way prosperous." You are the difference maker. You must align yourself with what you meditate on, day and night—the Word of God. Once you grasp this, your faith becomes strong.

The more you feast on the meat of the Word, the greater the onus and responsibility you must take over your words and actions. If you fail to align what you say and do with what God has written about you, you'll continue to struggle. You can pray until you're blue in the face. You can fast until you're ninety-two pounds, and it still won't affect your outcome because nothing will change until your heart does. The only way to change your heart is to hold yourself accountable and speak the Word over your situation.

Most failures are byproducts of what you've trained your mind to believe. If you struggle with insecurity and constantly battle thoughts that you're not good enough, it's because you've told yourself that lie so often you've started to believe it. Now, you believe it so strongly, you even speak it out of your mouth—it's been cemented into your heart. That's not a God issue or a church issue—it's a *you* issue.

If you have a desire to prosper, you have to meditate on the Word every day. The Bible is specific about what it takes to prosper. It could have said, "Do not allow the Word to depart from

your mind,” but it doesn’t. It says, “Do not allow God’s Word to depart from your *mouth*.” If you want something to come out of your mouth, it must first be in your heart. That’s why the Bible says, “Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks” (Luke 6:45).

When you meditate on God’s Word long enough, your heart believes it, and then out of your mouth it comes. All you have to do is rewire your brain and create new highways of faith by meditating on God’s Word constantly, then speaking it out of your mouth. Meditate, speak, and repeat. It’s so simple. The same way fear and anxiety slip in is the way belief and faith come—through repetition. If your life is full of failure and defeat or sickness and disease, you have a part to play in your victory and healing by aligning yourself with the Word of God.

DAY THREE

Align Your Confession

Death and life are in the power of the tongue,
and those who love it will eat its fruit.

PROVERBS 18:21 (NKJV)

Pray this out loud:

Lord, teach me to speak words of life and faith. Let my words align with Your promises, and cause them to bring hope and victory to every situation. I declare that my tongue will glorify You in all things. I refuse to align myself with death. I choose to speak life today. I refuse to side with destruction and defeat. I side with abundant life, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Your Action

Action is how you bridge the gap between mentally agreeing to something in your mind and receiving what you believe by faith. You can believe God to bring you to a higher level, but faith asks what's required to bring it to pass. I pray that this year will be a standout year for you. You may be reading this thinking, 'Yeah, I should be healthier. I should be doing more in this endeavor,' but if there's no action behind that belief, nothing will change. Everybody can believe. People believe in Santa, but that doesn't make him real. The true game changer occurs when you pair your belief with faith. The man in Mark 9:24 believed, but he lacked faith. He knew Jesus could help Him. He'd seen Him help others. He'd heard about the marvelous works of Christ, but he still had a sliver of doubt. That's why he asked Jesus to help his unbelief.

Doubt is a spirit, and God is disgusted by it. The only way to live in perpetual faith is by hearing, and *hearing* the Word of God (Romans 10:17). You've probably read and heard that verse hundreds of times, but there's an intellectual hearing, and then there's a spiritual hearing. A spiritual hearing causes your faith to come alive. It connects your spirit with God's Spirit and removes all doubt.

Oftentimes, people desire to be healed, but they're waiting for something to manifest in their bodies. In the natural, they still feel pain, they can still feel the tumor, or touch the scab. That's not how it works. Healing is not a natural transaction. It occurs in the spirit first, then the natural takes effect.

Faith transcends belief. It actively trusts and relies on God. That's how you tap into the power of God. Fully engage in and rely on God's Word every day. Commit to walking in faith every day for the rest of your life. I know you can do it!

DAY FOUR

Faith to Act

But be doers of the word, and not hearers only,
deceiving yourselves.

JAMES 1:22 (NKJV)

Be a doer of the Word. You must act to receive God's promises through faith.

Pray this prayer out loud:

Lord, give me the boldness to act on what I believe. I don't want to just hear Your Word—I want to live it. Help me to step out in faith, knowing that You're with me every step of the way, in Jesus' name, Amen.

As you declare these words, fear must go—timidity and excuses leave now. You will step out and do what God has called you to do.

DAY FIVE

Bold Faith

By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going.

HEBREWS 11:8 (NKJV)

Safety isn't as secure as you may think. Stepping into the unknown is necessary to see change take place in your life. Don't fear change—it's a required prerequisite for growth. Comfort isn't okay. If you find yourself doing the same things every single day, clocking in from nine to five, then going home to eat and binge television, that lifestyle won't lead to increase. What actions are you taking to manifest increase in your life? What are you believing God to do for you?

Don't be average, and don't be mediocre. God's call on your life is greater than that. You're called to be a star that shines brighter and brighter until the coming of the Lord (Proverbs 4:18). Step into whatever God has called you to do with boldness and tenacity. God's calling on your life might force you out of that comfort zone, but do it anyway because there's an inheritance waiting for you.

Declare this:

Father, help me to trust You as I step out of my comfort zone. Strengthen my faith to walk boldly into the unknown. I'll do whatever You call me to do, speedily, without hesitation, in the mighty name of Jesus, Amen.

Faith is utterly useless if you don't step into action. You may not know how it will all work out, but as long as you take the steps necessary to walk in obedience to God, you'll end up on top. God's blessing is in your obedience.

DAY SIX

Faith Without Hesitation

For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

JAMES 2:26 (NKJV)

All excuses and hesitation end today. From this moment forward, refuse to waste any more time, in the name of Jesus! Don't wait for others to move on your behalf—that's irresponsible faith. Make moves to accomplish what God has called you to do. Take action today. Do what you have to do. Go where you need to go. Speak what God tells you to say.

Don't you dare wait for the prophecy to happen before you make a move. Don't play! If you're honest with yourself, you'll have to admit: you've been playing too much. We don't have much time left on this Earth. What are you doing waiting for someone to move so that you can get the job done? Get over yourself and do what God tells you to do.

Declare this:

Father, help me to trust in the promises contained in Your Word and to act in faith before I see the fulfillment of prophecy. Teach me to walk in obedience without hesitation.

DAY SEVEN

Faith Takes Back What the Devil Stole

For You, O LORD, will bless the righteous; with favor. You will surround him as with a shield.

PSALM 5:12 (NKJV)

Have you ever been stolen from? To recover what's been stolen, you must be prepared to do what's necessary to take it back. Faith takes back what the Devil stole. Nothing happens by chance. Thieves don't drop your belongings back in your lap. You've got to fight for what belongs to you!

Maybe the Devil stole and sought to oppress and depress in the past, but now you know better. Take it back with God's supernatural favor on your life. Refuse to sit back and watch as the world passes you by. You will not die in defeat. You will rise up and take what belongs to you today.

Declare this:

Lord, surround me with Your favor as I take the steps to recover everything that's been stolen. Fear, I command you to go. I will not stop believing because of what I see. I will stand in faith, and I will proclaim Your victory, because You open doors that no man can shut, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Your children will serve the Lord all the days of their lives. If you have backslidden children, thank God that He is bringing them to their knees in preparation for a divine encounter. Having done all to stand (Ephesians 6:13), stand therefore, and declare the promises of God, knowing your children will be saved. Your spouse will be saved. You will rise and fight. You will pursue, overtake, and recover all (1 Samuel 30:8).

Week Two

Divine Healing



Healing is essential for every believer. If you disagree, then you've likely never been truly sick! Jesus didn't just die for our sins—He also died for our healing. Why? Because He loves us and because we have a mission to fulfill.

What many don't realize is that sickness is a dream killer. When you're battling pain, it's hard to think beyond the next thirty minutes, let alone plan for the future. That's the enemy's strategy—to wear you down, discourage you, and make you quit by attacking your body. Once you recognize that sickness is not just an inconvenience but an assignment to stop you, you'll fight it differently.

The Bible says in Mark 16:15, "*Go into all the world and preach the Gospel.*" The "you" in that verse is personal—it's talking about YOU. But how can you "go" when you're in constant pain, confined to a bed? This truth should ignite a holy anger against anything that threatens your health. Sickness is not just something to endure—it's something to resist and overcome!

DAY ONE

Resist the Spirit of Infirmity

Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.

1 PETER 2:24 (NKJV)

Declare this out loud:

Father, I stand on Your Word and declare healing as my covenant right. Sickness—you have no place in my body. Disease—go back to Hell where you came from. I rebuke every symptom and command my body to align with Your Word, Lord, in Jesus' name, Amen!

Thank the Lord for His healing power that is at work on the inside of you right now. Receive your healing by faith, and begin to give God all the glory, even now. Continue to rebuke every symptom, from the top of your head to the soles of your feet. Anything that does not belong, every tree planted by the evil one, command it to be uprooted in the mighty name of Jesus (Matthew 15:13). At the mention of the name of Jesus, tumors dissolve, pain ceases, and healing and wholeness take their place.

Now begin to manifest speedy recovery and complete healing in the mighty name of Jesus. The same quickening power that raised Christ from the dead now dwells in you, and it brings life and healing to your flesh today.

DAY TWO

Walk in Health

But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities, the chastisement for our peace was upon him, and by his stripes, we are healed.

ISAIAH 53:5 (NKJV)

Say this out loud:

Father, I thank You for divine health. Sickness and disease have no place in my body. This year, I walk in the healing and health Jesus purchased for me.

It makes no difference to God where or when you're reading this. Maybe you're confined to a hospital bed or sitting in your living room. I command every infirmity, whether it's disease in your blood, fever, or infection—every source of pain or defeat to come off of you now. I command healing to enter your body wherever you are.

Begin to thank your heavenly Father that His healing power is flowing in your body right now, in the mighty name of Jesus. Thank Him for the blood of Jesus that purchased your freedom and delivered you from every form of sickness and disease in your life. This will be a year of divine health, strength, grace, and favor. It will be the healthiest you've ever been.

Don't act based on your feelings or what you've been told. You know that God's Word is true, even if you don't see it. I command you to walk by faith and not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7). Tell everything in your body to be corrected and made brand

new. Your Father in Heaven has all the spare parts you need—whether it be a heart, kidneys, spine, new muscles, ligaments, or tissues. Thank your Father for supernaturally healing your body.

DAY THREE

Christ Your Healer

“If you diligently heed the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I am the LORD who heals you.”

EXODUS 15:26 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Lord, I declare that You are my Healer. I acknowledge it is Your will for me to be made whole. I reject every lie of the enemy that says otherwise. I thank You that healing is my covenant right through the finished work of Jesus on the cross. I receive it now by faith, in Jesus' name.

Reject any pain you feel and any diagnosis you may have received. You walk in divine health and healing, for He is the Lord who heals you.

Speak to the pain and command it to be removed. Speak to the tumors and command them to be gone in the name of Jesus. Speak to your blood—command it to be made normal. Every bone, spine, and organ comes into alignment with the Word of God. Declare that every part of your body will function the way it was designed to, in Jesus' name.

DAY FOUR

Heal from the Past

“Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past. See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland.

ISAIAH 43:18-19 (NIV)

It’s impossible to run from a memory. You must run *to* a future. God is doing a new thing, and it involves you!

As you pray this prayer, really mean it—don’t just say it like a robot. If you’re someone who constantly looks at your past, drop it today. You can’t enter into new, uncharted territories carrying the baggage of yesteryear. So, drop that load today.

Pray this out loud to your Heavenly Father:

Lord, heal me from the wounds of the past and guide me towards the glorious future You’ve already planned for me.

You can’t change the past. You can’t change what people have said, nor can you change what others have done, but you can look into the future and see how glorious it is. Recognize that God is doing a new thing in your life. Every heavy burden, every weight trying to entangle you—choose to drop it now in the mighty name of Jesus (Hebrews 12:1-2).

DAY FIVE

Receive Your Daily Bread

That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses."

MATTHEW 8:17 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Heavenly Father, thank You for making healing Your children's bread. I receive my healing now through the finished work of Calvary. No sickness or disease can remain in my body because Your Word declares that Jesus took my infirmities and carried my disease, in Jesus' name.

You can command every tumor to shrivel up and die. Command your headache to quit in Jesus' name. Command your eyes to see clearly and your ears to hear perfectly.

Jesus took every infirmity from you. That means you don't have them anymore. Thank your Father for His healing power. The same power that raised Jesus Christ from the dead now dwells in you, and it quickens your mortal body. Thank Him for His miraculous work in your life.

DAY SIX

Healed Family Relationships

Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

COLOSSIANS 3:13 (NIV)

You must be intentional about relationships and take accountability for their outcome. You can't just write it off as a toxic relationship. If you have strained relationships—speak faith. Openly declare the goodness of God over your relationships. As you begin to believe the power of your words, everything will soon follow. Suddenly, you'll notice you have love, compassion, and forgiveness for people, but it can only happen once you understand your role in your relationships.

Pray this:

Father, bring healing and restoration to the broken relationships in my family. Help me to forgive and love them. Bring unity today in my home and my life. I have a part to play, so I'll do it. I command every broken relationship to be restored in the name of Jesus. I walk in forgiveness and love because I know that as I do, everything will turn around, in Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY SEVEN

Restored Health

But I will restore you to health and heal your wounds,' declares the LORD.

JEREMIAH 30:17

This will be a wonderful year full of His promises, blessings, and opportunities. That means you need to be in your right mind and in perfect health.

Declare this:

Father, thank You for making this a year of unusual divine health from head to toe. My focus will be on advancing the Kingdom of God and being a blessing to this generation.

As the Word declares, He will restore you to health. So, expect unusual health and vitality, in the mighty name of Jesus. You will not spend a small fortune trying to figure out a diagnosis. You will not need doctors or medicine.

God's hand is on your life, and He will supernaturally restore what men say cannot be restored. You will not die before your time. Neither you nor anyone in your family will have any accidents or hospital visits unless it's to push out a baby.

I command every spirit of infirmity to come off you today. Begin to thank Him for divine health and healing. Stand on the Word, and confidently believe and proclaim that by His stripes you were healed.

Week Three

Complete Restoration



Complete restoration is essential for living the abundant life God intends for you. In John 10:10, Jesus says, *“The thief comes only to steal, kill, and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it more abundantly.”* Abundant life begins when a person is made whole.

Too often, we glorify brokenness as if it holds more significance than wholeness, but the truth is, God receives the greatest glory when you are whole! Scripture tells us that *“Those who seek the Lord lack no good thing”* (Psalm 34:10). Think about that—you have everything you need for life and godliness (2 Peter 1:3)!

When the enemy tries to steal from you, it is God’s job to restore, bring recompense, and vindicate—if you’ll let Him. Yet, many of us hold onto our brokenness as if we deserve to stay in that place. We’ve conditioned ourselves to sit in defeat rather than invite God in to heal and restore.

The Bible says, *“The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit”* (Psalm 34:18). If that’s you today, I encourage you—let God step into your situation and do what He does best: RESTORE.

DAY ONE

Recover & Restore All

So I will restore to you the years that the swarming locust has eaten, the crawling locust, the consuming locust, and the chewing locust, my great army which I sent among you.

JOEL 2:25 (NKJV)

As you pray this, I want you to believe every bit of what you're about to say. Scripture is laced with truth. When you intentionally declare the Word of God, believing every word that you speak, your prayers are much more effective because you're declaring one hundred percent the Word of God—and it never fails. Everything else may fail, but the Word of the Lord stands forever.

Pray this out loud:

Father, You are the God of restoration. According to Joel 2:25, You promised to restore to me the years that the locust has eaten. I trust You to recover all that I have lost in every area of my life, in Jesus' name, Amen.

As you believe what you say with all your heart, you will recover all that was lost—everything that has been stolen from you will be recovered, in the mighty name of Jesus.

DAY TWO

Restored Relationships

And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.

ROMANS 8:28 (NKJV)

Declare this:

Lord, restore every broken relationship that aligns with Your purpose in my life. Mend what is broken. According to Your Word, You heal the brokenhearted and bind up their wounds. Father, mend what is broken and heal what is wounded in Jesus' name, Amen.

Refuse to carry hatred and bitterness. Reject defeat and failure. Give everything in your life that is broken to the Lord to bind, heal, and restore, in the mighty name of Jesus.

DAY THREE

Double Restoration

Instead of your shame you shall have double honor, and instead of confusion they shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore in their land they shall possess double; Everlasting joy shall be theirs.

ISAIAH 61:7 (NKJV)

Pray this out loud:

Lord, I claim double for everything the enemy has stolen from my life. Restore my health, my finances, my relationships, and my peace. Use what the enemy meant for evil and turn it around for good, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Thank God for giving you double for your trouble. Place a demand on God's Word right now. Ask God to expose every enemy. God's Word declares the thief has to pay you double. So claim that for your life in the mighty name of Jesus. You will receive double for everything the enemy stole from you. You'll receive double honor instead of confusion in the mighty name of Jesus.

DAY FOUR

Divine Alignment

And I will restore or replace for you the years that the locust has eaten—the hopping locust, the stripping locust, and the crawling locust, My great army which I sent among you.

JOEL 2:25 (AMPC)

This verse is so powerful, you need to run it back—read it again.

Pray this:

Father, I pray for the restoration of missed opportunities and stolen blessings. Bring me to a place of divine alignment, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Refuse to speak of anything contrary to your divine alignment. Thank Him for restoring every missed opportunity and blessing. Align yourself with His Word. Begin to thank Him for great opportunities, favor, and blessings. You may have missed it once, but you won't miss it again, in Jesus' name!

DAY FIVE

Supernatural Breakthrough

For you shall not go out with haste, nor go by flight; For the LORD will go before you, and the God of Israel will be your rear guard.

ISAIAH 52:12 (NKJV)

Ephesians 6 illustrates the full armor of God—the breastplate of righteousness, the gospel of peace, the shield of faith, the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit—but it leaves your back exposed. This verse helps you understand why—it’s because God is your rear guard.

Pray this:

I declare supernatural breakthrough in every area of my life. Let every obstacle be removed. Let every barrier be broken. I step into the fullness of Your promises today, in Jesus’ name, Amen.

Don’t wait for breakthrough, claim it right now. Declare supernatural breakthroughs will begin to take shape all around you—in your finances, in your health, in your mind, in your family, and in your nation. Step into the fullness of His promises in your life right now by faith.

DAY SIX

Confident Trust

Being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ.

PHILIPPIANS 1:6 (NKJV)

Declare this:

Lord, I know You're not finished with me. Every bit of insecurity that tries to tell me I'm not enough is a lie. I choose to trust You because I know my life is secure in Your hands, and Your work is complete, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Rest assured that you lack no good thing (Psalm 34:10). There are no gaping holes in your life. Thank your Father for filling them all. Work confidently because you know that you lack nothing. If you haven't seen the totality of what God has called you to do, you can be certain He will complete it through you.

You don't have to live with insecurity and doubt. Cast them aside today and walk in the confidence that comes from knowing that you are every bit of who God has called you to be.

DAY SEVEN

You Are Fully Equipped

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light

1 PETER 2:9 (NKJV)

Say this out loud: **I'm special.**

Now declare this:

I am chosen by God, uniquely designed for His purpose. I refuse to measure myself by my past or the opinions of others. I stand on the truth—I am fully loved, accepted, and equipped for everything God has called me to do.

Command the foul spirit of insecurity to be uprooted from your life in the name of Jesus. Never again will you have to wonder who you are. You are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation. You are God's special people.

How can insecurity remain when you know who you are and who He's called you to be? Any mistakes you've made in the past are irrelevant—they can't dictate where you're headed. God wants to use you right now. You are fully loved and accepted, and you lack nothing.

Week Four

Divine Vision & Guidance



You shall be blessed above all peoples; there shall not be a male or female barren among you or among your livestock.

DEUTERONOMY 7:14

Did you know that everything you do bears an eternal repercussion? You haven't the slightest idea the magnitude of impact you would make if you aligned yourself with the call and dream God has placed within you. Your actions activate your faith because your faith without any work is dead (James 2:17). Simply having a vision isn't good enough. It's boring. Join the club—everyone has a dream, but most never activate it.

It's your responsibility to align yourself with your dream every single day. Refuse to be fruitless. Decide today that this will be your most productive year. Fruitfulness is not an option—it's your covenant heritage. The blessing of Abraham is not addition—it's multiplication. It yields fruitful production in every area of your life—spiritually, physically, and materially. You carry the same blessing as Abraham, and action activates the Abrahamic blessing in your life.

Barrenness is not your portion. Stagnation will not be your story. You were designed by God to flourish like a tree planted by the rivers (Jeremiah 17:7-8; Psalm 1:1-3).

Let me ask you a few questions:

Why did you decide to read this book?

What do you hope to accomplish by reading and praying these prayer points out loud every day?

What do you desire to accomplish this year?

You must set aside time to write down the vision God has given you for this year. Let's be honest—you could do a little more. You can always do a little more.

Faithfulness and fruitfulness are rooted in your obedience. Obedience is an action word. You can be obedient through giving, or relocating, or maybe it's doing something that makes you uncomfortable. Whatever it is God told you to do—do it quickly.

DAY ONE

Divine Vision

Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us

EPHESIANS 3:20 (NKJV)

God put something inside of you. Maybe you've known it since childhood, and you've placed it on the back burner because you think it's out of reach. Today, you're going to brush the dust off and speak life into your dreams.

Pray this out loud:

Father, You are the God of the impossible. Expand my vision and enlarge my dreams to match Your purpose for my life. Allow me to see beyond what is natural, and let my faith rise to accomplish what You've placed in my heart, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Begin to thank God for increasing you, even now. Every dream you've put on the back burner will come alive on the inside of you in the mighty name of Jesus!

DAY TWO

Vision to Accomplish Dreams

For the vision is yet for an appointed time;
but at the end it will speak, and it will not lie.
Though it tarries, wait for it; because it will
surely come, it will not tarry.

HABAKKUK 2:3 (NKJV)

Say this:

Lord, I thank You in advance for fulfilling the dreams You've placed in my heart. I rejoice in your faithfulness and give You all the glory for the victories ahead.

Thank your heavenly Father for bringing every one of your dreams to pass. Everything you've asked God for in your time of prayer will be fulfilled in your life. Don't wait to see it manifest in the natural to give God thanks and praise for it—begin to rejoice in it now. Thank Him for making a way where there was no way. Thank Him for causing justice to prevail and for bringing vindication. Thank Him for being a present help in times of trouble. Thank Him for mending your broken heart.

You serve a God who is conscious of every one of your needs. He told you to cast all your cares on Him because He cares for you (1 Peter 5:7). Thank Him for caring about you and delighting in your desires. He wants you to accomplish everything in your heart. Aren't you glad you don't serve a God who merely meets your needs, but He goes far beyond—He wants to blow your mind with His goodness. He is wonderful and worthy. He is great and greatly to be praised. There is no one like Him. He's the beginning and the end and everything in between.

DAY THREE

Supernatural Creativity

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

EPHESIANS 2:10 (NKJV)

Pray this out loud:

Lord, You are the Creator of all things. Let Your creativity flow through me. Bring me unique ideas, innovative solutions, and strategies to fulfill the dreams You've given me, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Thank God for giving you the mind of Christ. Thank Him for empowering you to do all things through Christ, who gives you strength. Thank Him for empowering you to do everything He's called you to do with *excellence*.

God has placed a call on your life, and He's given you effective strategies and unusual creativity to accomplish that which He's called you to do. Everything you produce will be the best. Receive it in Jesus' name!

DAY FOUR

Reveal What Is Hidden

‘Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.’

JEREMIAH 33:3

Pray this out loud:

Father, open my eyes to see the hidden opportunities and strategies You prepared for me in this season. Reveal to me the treasures in Your Word, in Jesus’ name, Amen.

The Lord will reveal Himself to you in a new and deeper way if you ask Him. He will show you strategies you couldn’t see before. He wants to show you great and mighty things you would never know without His divine revelation. Ask Him to open your eyes to see the hidden opportunities He’s prepared for you.

DAY FIVE

Divine Guidance

Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

PROVERBS 3:5-6 (NIV)

Having a standout year requires you to know exactly what to do. If you want to experience a new dawn, you must expect to receive something new, and you have to be prepared to properly navigate through the unknown. If you want a successful year, you need the Lord to guide you.

Pray this:

Father, in the mighty name of Jesus, I ask You to guide me in every decision I make. Let Your Word be a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path, leading me to success in every area of my life, in the mighty name of Jesus, Amen.

You don't have to make a single misstep. God will keep you from turning to the left or to the right. He will help you stay on that path He's set before you. Thank God for guiding you by His Holy Spirit—step by step. Allow Him to ordain your every step by His Spirit.

Your job is to trust in God and the promises contained in His Word, so that you don't miss a step. He is your light in the darkness. Submit your ways and your life to Him, and you'll never be led astray. He only leads to unending success.

As you follow Him, an overwhelming peace will consume you. You will know exactly what to do in every situation. You won't miss it in the little things, but in everything, you will know the way to go and walk confidently in it.

DAY SIX

Protect Your Vision

No weapon formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment you shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is from Me," Says the LORD.

ISAIAH 54:17 (NKJV)

Declare this:

Lord, I plead the blood of Jesus over the dreams You've given me. Protect them from the schemes of the enemy, and give me the wisdom to steward them with excellence, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Ask God to protect the dreams He's given you from every form of darkness, defeat, failure, and scheme the enemy would try to throw at them, in the mighty name of Jesus. He will give you the wisdom to proceed in the way you should go. He'll provide the wisdom necessary to handle the vision and steward it with excellence. Let everything you do be done with a spirit of excellence.

DAY SEVEN

Eliminate Distractions

Let your eyes look straight ahead and your eyes look right before you.

PROVERBS 4:25 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Father, I ask for clarity and focus this year. Help me to eliminate distractions and stay fixed on the purpose You've called me to do. I am laser-focused on my mission, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Get rid of every distraction that doesn't align with what God has called you to do. Pray for clarity and focus like you've never experienced. No distractions. Laser focused. You are on a mission.

Week Five

Supernatural Wisdom



Prayer is your opportunity to seek God’s face. If you don’t sow seeds of prayer, you won’t reap a harvest of revelation. That’s the simple truth of how God works. A farmer doesn’t plant a seed and walk away forever—he has to water it. It’s his job to protect it from being uprooted and water it to ensure it grows.

Don’t be the type of Christian who receives a seed in word form and tucks it away, thinking, ‘If it’s God’s will, it will happen.’ No—water it with prayer and fasting. Prayer is how you water the seeds of destiny in your life. Receive the wisdom and revelation to water every seed God has given you until it grows into the beautiful harvest it was meant to produce.

DAY ONE

Transform Your Mind

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

ROMANS 12:2 (NKJV)

Say this out loud:

Heavenly Father, I surrender my thoughts to You. Transform my mind by Your Word, the ultimate truth, so I can see the world through Your eyes. Help me to focus on Your truth and reject anything that doesn't align with Your will, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Refuse to be conformed to this world or its ways, but determine to be transformed by the renewing of your mind through God's Word. His Word enables you to discern what is good, acceptable, and perfect.

Allow His Word to transform your mind today so you can see the world through His eyes. Ask God to empower you to see things the way He sees them, and hear things the way He hears them, that you might know things the way He knows them.

DAY TWO

Wisdom to Endure & Excel

If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.

JAMES 1:5 (NIV)

Wisdom is directional. You need to be endowed with supernatural wisdom to know what to do and where to go. You can ask God to give you wisdom, just as He gave Jesus wisdom and made Him wise far beyond His years.

Pray this:

Father, endue me now with supernatural wisdom from Heaven to navigate through the challenges of this year. Empower me to excel in every endeavor I attempt, in the mighty name of Jesus, Amen.

You have the wisdom to succeed in every endeavor, whether it's business, family, or ministry. God will enable you to understand His will and His ways. You have the supernatural wisdom to navigate through any challenges that arise. God will give you ideas that cause you to stand out. Thank Him in advance for supernatural wisdom.

Confusion and uncertainty must leave because you walk in divine, supernatural wisdom. God promised to give you whatever you ask for, so receive it now by faith, in the mighty name of Jesus.

DAY THREE

Wisdom to Recover All

So David inquired of the LORD, saying, “Shall I pursue this troop? Shall I overtake them?” And He answered him, “Pursue, for you shall surely overtake them and without fail recover all.”

1 SAMUEL 30:8 (NKJV)

Lift your hands and say this:

Lord, guide me with Your divine wisdom. Show me the steps to recover all that has been taken from me, in Jesus’ name, Amen.

DAY FOUR

Systems that Produce Fruit

Commit to the LORD whatever you do, and he will establish your plans.

PROVERBS 16:3 (NIV)

Contrary to popular belief, systems are better than goals. Everyone has goals. The entire world begins the new year with a goal. Your gym is full in January and February, but by March, it's a ghost town because goals don't get the job done—systems do.

Press in and ask the Lord to show you what systems or routines you need to implement in your life, and then walk in them. It's easy to get so caught up trying to finish everything on your to-do list that you bypass and ignore the most important things. Be intentional about the call of God on your life.

Pray this:

Lord, give me the wisdom to create sustainable systems that align with Your will and produce lasting fruit. According to Your Word, if I commit my ways to You, You'll establish my plans, in the mighty Name of Jesus, Amen.

As you commit all of your ways to the Lord, He will establish your plans and give you the next step.

DAY FIVE

Wisdom to Create Wealth

“And you shall remember the LORD your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.

DEUTERONOMY 8:18 (NKJV)

Pray this out loud:

Lord, I receive Your divine wisdom and creativity to generate wealth for my family and Your Kingdom purpose, in Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY SIX

Wisdom to Stay Silent

Make it your goal to live a quiet life, minding your own business and working with your hands, just as we instructed you before.

1 THESSALONIANS 4:11 (NLT)

Stop giving unsolicited advice. Minding your business will set you free. It's so much better to just mind your business. Don't be that person walking around asking people if they want prayer out of the blue.

Pray this:

Father, give me discernment to know when to speak and when to remain silent. Let my words always be led by Your Spirit, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Pray this over and over again. Unsolicited advice is never good advice. Ask God to help you keep your mouth shut. The only debt you owe is the debt of love to your fellow brothers and sisters. Love them and pray for them from a distance. Remain in alignment, in the name of Jesus.

DAY SEVEN

Wisdom to Follow

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.

JAMES 1:5 (NKJV)

Lift your hands and pray this out loud:

Father, I ask for divine wisdom to make decisions that align with Your will. Let every step I take be directed by You because I know in doing so, I will win, in the mighty name of Jesus, Amen.

Ask the Lord to lead you in every decision you make. He will order and direct your every step. You are destined to win. You can't lose with God ordaining each and every step—it's impossible.

He leads you into all truth by His wonderful Spirit. He fortifies you with divine wisdom to make decisions that align with His perfect will for your life. May you never miss a step in the mighty name of Jesus. You will never go to the left or to the right, but you will always walk in alignment with His Spirit.

Week Six

Unmerited Favor



We are stepping into a new dawn era! This means everything is leveling up, and with that comes change. But don't fear change—embrace it! There will be moments when you feel unprepared or ill-equipped, but don't buy into the enemy's lies! *"God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and a sound mind"* (2 Timothy 1:7). If you wait for the "perfect" moment, you'll never move forward—just as Ecclesiastes 11:4 warns, *"Whoever watches the wind will not plant; whoever looks at the clouds will not reap."*

So, what's the solution? Favor! God's favor means blessing, approval, and preferential treatment. He will move mountains and pass over thousands just to reach you! This favor will protect you and keep you! *For You, O Lord, bless the righteous; You surround them with favor as with a shield*" (Psalm 5:12). This year, step boldly into your new dawn—because God's favor is on you.

DAY ONE

Favor to Thrive

Surely, LORD, you bless the righteous; you surround them with your favor as with a shield.

PSALM 5:12 (NIV)

Declare this:

This year, favor will surround me like a shield. Wherever I go, whatever I do, doors open up for me that no man can shut. What was hard before will become easy, by the hand of God. Lord, thank You for bringing divine connections to fulfill the dreams You've given me, in Jesus' name.

From this point forward, everything comes to you with ease. The favor of God is coming upon you and surrounding you like a shield, in the mighty name of Jesus. When times are unfavorable, they'll be favorable for you, your family, and your business. When things are closing down all around you, you will continue to thrive. You are susceptible to the things of the Earth but you are connected to a different Kingdom. All Hell could break loose, and it wouldn't affect the divine favor and blessing on your life.

Thank God for bringing people who will be present in your life for the rest of your life. Thank Him for placing you in the right place at the right time to meet the connections necessary to launch you into your destiny, in the name of Jesus.

DAY TWO

Favor & Recognition

Surely, LORD, you bless the righteous; you surround them with your favor as with a shield.

PSALM 5:12 (NIV)

God has given every person a platform, and it takes divine favor and recognition for your assignment to take off. Influence is not a bad thing—it's a God-given force that makes everything you do outstanding. You were created to make an impact in the world. Whatever field you're in, you are a standout.

Say this out loud:

I declare unending favor and unending recognition in the mighty name of Jesus, Amen.

You are not far from supernatural recognition. All it takes is one video to go viral to put you on the map. Your business will grow, and your platform will increase.

Thank Him for recognition, influence, and favor. You walk in divine recognition in the mighty name of Jesus. Let this year be a standout. Everything you put your hand to do will grow exponentially.

DAY THREE

Open Doors

See, I have placed before you an open door that no one can shut. I know that you have little strength, yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name.

REVELATION 3:8 (NIV)

The first step in walking through an open door is to discern which door is meant for you to walk through. If you want change, you have to do something to facilitate it. Sometimes it requires you to step into the unknown, but when you do, it's a blessing. It produces growth and successful opportunities.

Declare this:

Father, help me to discern and walk through the open door You have for me. I declare this is a year of open doors of opportunities that could only have come by Your hand. No opportunity meant for me shall be missed, in Jesus' name, Amen.

When God opens a door, He does it in a way that only He can take credit. The opportunities He affords to His children are always a supernatural blessing. Thank Him ahead of time for success, favor, breakthrough, and blessing. Every form of fear and hesitation leaves today. Make sure you're prepared to do what's required to walk through the open door God has for you. Refuse to miss your divine opportunity to produce a great blessing.

DAY FOUR

Divine Acceleration

Then the LORD gave special strength to Elijah. He tucked his cloak into his belt and ran ahead of Ahab's chariot all the way to the entrance of Jezreel.

1 KINGS 18:46 (NLT)

Pray this:

Heavenly Father, this year I will experience divine acceleration in every area of my life. What would have taken me years to accomplish will be done in days because Your hand is on my life, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Thank Him for accelerating your purpose, call, and efforts. As you put the work in, He will bless the work of your hands.

DAY FIVE

Dispatch of Heaven's Resources

So we may boldly say: "The LORD is my helper;
I will not fear. What can man do to me?"

HEBREWS 13:6 (NKJV)

Say this out loud:

Father, I call on Heaven's resources now. Let angels be dispatched to bring breakthroughs, open doors, and supernatural answers. You are my Father, and You act on my behalf, in the mighty name of Jesus, Amen.

Your heavenly Father is walking before you, making every crooked path straight (Isaiah 40:4-5).

God is moving on your behalf even as you sleep. He's working things out for the good of those who love Him and are called according to His purpose (Romans 8:28). If that's you, count it as done and say Amen!

DAY SIX

Supernatural Favor

For You, O LORD, will bless the righteous; with favor You will surround him as with a shield.

PSALM 5:12 (NKJV)

Declare this:

Lord, let Your supernatural favor surround me like a shield, opening doors that no man can shut. Give me favor with God and man in everything I do, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Pray that God would surround you with supernatural, unusual favor. He will open doors for you that no man can shut. He will position you for greatness. You'll receive promotions that don't make any sense—your boss simply favors you.

Thank Him for opening doors you're not even qualified to walk through. He will open them for you anyway because you are favored.

DAY SEVEN

Immediate Obedience

The plans of the diligent lead surely to abundance and advantage, but everyone who acts in haste comes surely to poverty.

PROVERBS 21:4 (AMP)

Lift your hands and declare this:

Father, from this moment on, whatever You put in my heart to do, I'll do quickly. I won't hesitate because hesitation is for losers, in Jesus' name, Amen.

When God tells you to go—GO. When He tells you what to say—say it. When He instructs you to sow—sow immediately. God called you righteous, and according to God's Word, you will surely walk in abundance and overflow.

Declare abundance and advantage over your life. Hesitation and trepidation are things of the past. Refuse to be slow about what God has called you to do. You will follow every instruction God gives you immediately.

Follow the example of Abraham, our father in the faith. When God told him to do something, he did it. He didn't hesitate, even when his instructions were to sacrifice his son. He woke up the next day, ready to do it. Like Abraham, you will walk in this blessing of God, in the mighty name of Jesus.

Week Seven

Fulfilled Purpose & Destiny



No destiny in Christ can be fulfilled without prayer. If you want to experience the supernatural in your life, you need to access it supernaturally. Spirit can only coincide with spirit. You cannot receive something in the natural until it's first received in the spirit. Healing and salvation are received spiritually, and so is everything you seek to obtain from God. That's why this book is so important—without prayer, it is impossible to access the fullness of God's plan for your life.

Bishop David Oyedepo says it this way: "Until you travail in prayer, you cannot prevail in life." If you've never seen a glimpse of what your destiny looks like, it's because you haven't asked to see it. You can ask for a preview, and the Spirit of God will show you. Prayer allows you to see God's destiny for your life—that's why we pray.

DAY ONE

Pursue Purpose

Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.”

JOSHUA 1:9 (NKJV)

Say this out loud:

Father, give me the boldness to step out in faith and pursue the dreams You've placed in my heart. Let fear be silenced and empower me to move forward with the assurance that You are with me every step of the way, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Starting today, say no to every form of fear attempting to block your destiny. You will be strong and courageous this year. You will never allow fear to dictate where you should go or what you should do, in the name of Jesus. Silence all fear—every lie, doubt, and form of unbelief is exposed and rooted out in Jesus' name.

DAY TWO

Align My Desires with God's Will

Delight yourself also in the LORD, and He shall give you the desires of your heart.

PSALM 37:4 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Father, I commit my heart to You. Let my greatest delight be in You, knowing You will align the desires of my heart with Your perfect will, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Ask God to search your heart. Pray that everything that is not pleasing to Him will be removed from your life in the name of Jesus.

DAY THREE

Become A Living Testimony

Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

MATTHEW 5:16 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Father, let the fulfillment of my dreams glorify You and bless others. Let my life be a living testimony of Your goodness that inspires others to pursue You, in Jesus' name, Amen.

The sole purpose of excelling is to give God glory. Everything you've accomplished is because of Him. Everything good in your life comes from Him. Ask Him to help you fulfill the dreams He's given you so that you will be a blessing to the nations of the world.

He will empower you to be a light in the darkness. He wants you to shine so bright that it brings people to know Him. He'll use you to save them. Your testimony will bring in a multitude of lost souls because people will see what God has done in your life and be drawn to Christ in you.

DAY FOUR

Enjoy Your Life

So I saw that there is nothing better for people than to be happy in their work. That is our lot in life. And no one can bring us back to see what happens after we die.

ECCLESIASTES 3:22 (NLT)

Are you happy? You have to love what you do. Whatever it is that you love, do it, and don't feel bad about it because God wants you to be happy.

I've been in ministry for eighteen years, and over the years, I've seen people fizzle out. One thing I noticed about those who didn't make it in ministry for the long haul was that they were miserable—they didn't enjoy their work or their lives. They didn't fellowship with others, and they had no outlets for joy.

If you like video games, play video games. I recognize my husband, Jonathan, loves video games. Sometimes, it ticks me off that he plays all the time, but I don't say anything because I know it's his outlet. He's a hard worker, and he deserves to relax and do what makes him happy. I like to go rabbit hunting, but I know Jonathan wouldn't be caught dead waking up early on a Saturday morning to hunt rabbits with me, so I found people who love to do it too. I do what I love, and he does what he loves, and we're both better for it.

Life is not a sprint—it's a marathon. We're in it for the long haul. You need an outlet of joy in your life that will help you grow and energize you.

Pray this:

Father, show me how to enjoy the work of my hands. Let me pursue the passions You've placed in my heart for Your glory, in Jesus' name, Amen.

I bet you've never asked God to show you how to enjoy life before—it's a powerful prayer. God will help you pursue your passions because He put them in you for a reason. He wants everything you do to bring joy and happiness because the joy of the Lord is your strength (Nehemiah 8:10).

DAY FIVE

Commit Your Plans

Commit your works to the Lord, and your thoughts will be established.

PROVERBS 16:3 (NKJV)

Declare this:

Father, I commit all my plans and works into Your hands. Give me divine strategies that will bring success and the fulfillment of your purpose in my life, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Don't just say the words—believe it. Believe that your heavenly Father will give you a divine blueprint, complete with strategies that lead to your success. He will provide you with everything you need for success and prosperity in your business, your marriage, your family, and every part of your life. You've already thanked Him for the vision—now thank Him for the plan.

DAY SIX

Fulfill Your Destiny

The LORD will fulfill his purpose for me; your steadfast love, O LORD, endures forever. Do not forsake the work of your hands.

PSALM 138:8 (ESV)

I want this year to be a year of fulfillment of destiny in your life.

Pray this out loud:

Father, I align myself with Your purpose for my life. I will fulfill my God-ordained destiny and call, and accomplish everything that You have planned for me, in Jesus' name, Amen.

You will fulfill every plan God has for your life. If you've been running from His call your entire life, today is the day you run towards your destiny and the plans He has for your life, in the mighty name of Jesus.

Throw your hands up and give God thanks for the best year of your life—starting now. Thank Him for being your God, for opening your eyes to all the wonderful things He has in store for you, and for bringing you into the light. Tell Him how grateful you are for who He is to you.

DAY SEVEN

Patience

To everything there *is* a season, a time for every purpose under heaven

ECCLESIASTES 3:1 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Lord, I trust in You and Your perfect timing. Help me to be patient as I wait in diligent preparation, knowing Your timing will bring the best fulfillment of my dreams, In Jesus' name, Amen.

Commit to putting in the work and grinding it out—whatever it takes. Thank God for His perfect timing and for providing you with spiritual patience. Develop the attitude that if the promotion doesn't come from Him, you don't want it.

Week Eight

Supernatural Abundance



Supernatural abundance isn't a luxury—it's a necessity for every obedient and responsible child of God. Scripture calls us to feed the hungry, clothe the naked, and care for those in need (Matthew 25:35-40), but how can we fulfill this divine mandate through natural means alone? We need abundance—overflow, surplus, and a mindset that aligns with God's limitless provision.

God doesn't give small dreams. He is compassionate, abundant, and extravagant in His generosity (Ephesians 3:20). If your vision doesn't require His help, it's too small. So, embrace the supernatural abundance He has in store for you because fulfilling your calling depends on it!

DAY ONE

Unending Provision

And my God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

PHILIPPIANS 4:19 (NKJV)

Declare this:

Heavenly Father, You are my provider. I declare that every resource I need to fulfill my dream is released from Heaven now. Let provision flow from unexpected places to accomplish Your will in my life, in Jesus' name, Amen.

As you proceed and move in the ways He's called you to go, you will never be in lack. Thank Him for provision from the north, south, east, and west. Expect provision to flow from unexpected places to accomplish the perfect will of God in your life. Thank Him for unexpected bonuses, blessings in the mail, and in person, in Jesus' name.

DAY TWO

Multiplication and Overflow

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

JOHN 10:10 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Lord, restore my finances. Bless the work of my hands. Multiply my resources and remove every form of lack. Thank You for empowering me to live life to the fullest, overflowing with blessings. I decree that this is the year of overflow in my life and finances, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Thank the Lord for giving you superabundantly more than you could ever ask, think or imagine. He will bless you infinitely beyond your greatest prayers, hopes, and dreams in every area of your life, in Jesus' name.

You won't just be restored to your original condition—the restoration of the Lord will bring overflow in every area of your life. He will turn everything the Devil meant for harm and destruction into good. Trust the process and allow Him to lead you in His ways and bring you to a place of overflow and abundance all the days of your life.

DAY THREE

Crowned with Goodness

You crown the year with a bountiful harvest; even the hard pathways overflow with abundance.

PSALM 65:11 (NLT)

Pray this:

Father crown this year with Your goodness and let it overflow with blessings and joy. Cause even the hard pathways to overflow with abundance, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Pray the Lord would cause overflow to overtake you in areas you didn't even know could overflow.

Declare it now:

This year will be a year of overwhelming blessing, favor, health, vitality, and strength in the Spirit.

Let this be your crowning year!

DAY FOUR

A Bountiful Harvest

The LORD will open the heavens, the storehouse of his bounty, to send rain on your land in season and to bless all the work of your hands. You will lend to many nations but will borrow from none.

DEUTERONOMY 28:12 (NIV)

God said in His Word that He would open His storehouses of abundance. So, thank Him for overwhelming your business with blessing and opportunity.

Say this out loud:

Father, thank You for opening the heavens and filling my storehouse with a bountiful harvest. Thank You for sending rain on Your land to bless the work of my hands. Thank You for overwhelming everything I set out to do with supernatural blessing in the mighty name of Jesus, Amen.

Thank Him for supernatural understanding, connections, and favor. You will have the absolute best year of your life. Your business will thrive. Your relationships will thrive. Everything will fall into alignment, and all the help you need will make its way to you.

Let the blessing of God overwhelm and overtake you this year in the mighty name of Jesus. Ask God to teach you how to prosper. Ask Him for the grace to be a blessing to others through the abundance that He has provided.

DAY FIVE

Grace to Be a Faithful Steward

If you are faithful in little things, you will be faithful in large ones. But if you are dishonest in little things, you won't be honest with greater responsibilities.

LUKE 16:10 (NLT)

Pray this:

Father, give me the wisdom and grace to steward the financial increase You have supplied. Teach me to be faithful with what You have entrusted to me, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Sound financial stewardship is how you unlock the blessing of God. If you can be diligent in the small things, greater opportunities will be open to you. Make it your goal for God to deem you trustworthy. Ask Him to help you make better decisions so you can steward everything He's given you well. He will teach you to be faithful with what He's entrusted to you.

Begin to give God the thanks He deserves. Thank Him for listening to you. Thank Him for never leaving you. He's never forgotten about you. He's wonderful and worthy to be praised. He is good, worthy, and holy. He's better than the best—there's no one like Him. No one can compare to Him. He is awesome in all His ways. It is a privilege to know and have a relationship with Him—don't take that for granted. Thank Him for His voice and presence in your life. Thank Him for joy, health, and vitality, in the mighty name of Jesus.

DAY SIX

Financial Breakthrough

And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

PHILIPPIANS 4:19 (NKJV)

Say this out loud:

Thank You for being the source of all my provision. Today, I declare that financial breakthrough belongs to me. Thank You for financial breakthrough in every area of my life, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Pray for your business and your finances. Pray for your bank accounts. This will be the best financial year of your life. Everything He sets your hand to do will experience an exponential increase. Your heavenly Father will overwhelm you with blessing—thank Him in advance!

DAY SEVEN

Sowing & Reaping

Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.”

LUKE 6:38 (NKJV)

Declare this:

My harvest is connected to my seed. I will sow my time, my resources, and my love with generosity and faith, knowing that God always rewards obedience and cheerful giving, in Jesus' name, Amen.

You cannot expect to harvest something you've never sown towards. If you want to experience change, you have to sow for it. You wouldn't expect to see a six-pack of abs if you'd been eating Doritos and cotton candy for the past six months. Every seed you sow should be meaningful. It's not just about money. It's about your time, resources, and love. You are a seed. You can plant yourself. When you give the best of yourself, you will produce the best in return.

Week Nine

Triumph Over the Enemy



Victory isn't something we hope for—it's something we already possess in Christ! As believers, we are called to live as more than conquerors (Romans 8:37), fully equipped to triumph over every scheme of the enemy. The battle is real, but so is our authority. The Devil comes to steal, kill, and destroy (John 10:10), but Jesus has already secured our victory through His death and resurrection.

The question isn't *if* you can overcome—the question is *will* you walk in the power and authority that God has given you? When you know who you are in Christ and stand firm in His Word, no weapon formed against you will prosper (Isaiah 54:17). It doesn't matter what the enemy is planning behind your back—God will step into your situation and take care of it on your behalf. It's time to rise up, take your place, and triumph over every attack of the enemy!

DAY ONE

Reveal What Is Hidden

For nothing is secret that will not be revealed,
nor anything hidden that will not be known
and come to light.

LUKE 8:17 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Father, I pray that every hidden work of darkness will be brought to light. Let every lie, deceit, and evil plot designed to withhold my blessing be uncovered and destroyed. Shine Your light in every dark place and let justice and truth prevail, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Use your God-given authority to command that every hidden work of the Devil be exposed in the mighty name of Jesus. He will uncover every friend who's a foe in disguise. He will reveal everything holding back your blessing and let the truth prevail.

DAY TWO

Expose and Frustrate the Enemy

No weapon formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is from Me," says the LORD.

Pray this:

In the name of Jesus, I cancel every plan of the Devil against my life and family. Let every trap set by the enemy backfire and every evil agenda be exposed and thwarted, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Pray for God to cancel the enemy's plan of lack, poverty, sickness, and disease. He will expose every hidden attack and agenda. Thank Him for frustrating the plan of the evil one on your behalf. No weapon formed against you shall prosper, in the mighty name of Jesus. Every attempt of the enemy backfires now.

DAY THREE

Reclaim What's Yours

Yet when he is found, he must restore sevenfold; He may have to give up all the substance of his house.

PROVERBS 6:31 (NKJV)

Declare this now:

Father, I boldly take back everything the enemy has stolen from me. I plunder the camp of the wicked one and claim victory in every area of my life, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Settle it in your spirit right now—you have come to plunder the enemy and take back everything he has stolen from you. You won't just get it back—you'll take back seven times what was stolen from you. You don't fight in the flesh, but you war in the spirit. So go to war against defeat. You will fight the good fight of faith (1 Timothy 6:12) in the spirit, and you will win and claim the spoils, in Jesus' name.

DAY FOUR

God—Your Righteous Judge

For we know Him who said, “Vengeance is Mine, I will repay,” says the Lord. And again, “The LORD will judge His people.”

HEBREWS 10:30 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Lord, You are my righteous judge. Repay the enemy for every attack against me and my family. Let justice flow like a river, and cause the Devil to repay every loss in my life, in Jesus’ name, Amen.

Vengeance belongs to the Lord—so don’t touch it. When God intervenes, you know He’s intervened. As much as you want to take vengeance on people for the wrong they’ve done, you don’t have to. All you have to do is sit back, relax, sip some tea, and watch the Lord do the work. Let the Lord overturn, expose, and enact judgment. The Devil will pay for every loss in your life.

DAY FIVE

Take Authority Over the Enemy

There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.

1 JOHN 4:18 (NKJV)

Pray this out loud:

Father, fear has no place in my life. I walk in faith and boldness because Your perfect love casts out *all* fear. I stand confidently, knowing that You are with me and You have given me authority over every enemy, in Jesus' name, Amen.

You have nothing to fear—no cause for anxiety or worries. You are filled with faith and boldness because God's perfect love casts every fear from your life. You can say no to fear. Be confident because God has your back. He's directing and leading you into all truth. You have all authority over every enemy, so there's no reason to be anxious. God is with you. And if He's with you, who can be against you?

DAY SIX

Break Free from Oppression

It shall come to pass in that day that his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, and his yoke from your neck, and the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil.

ISAIAH 10:27 (NKJV)

Say this and mean it with all your heart:

Lord, let Your anointing destroy every yoke of oppression in my life. I declare complete freedom from every oppression of the Devil. Every form of sickness, poverty, failure, and stagnancy—I command it to be destroyed by the anointing on my life, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Your heavenly Father destroys the heavy yoke of bondage. Thank Him for breaking every form of oppression over your life, in Jesus' name. No sickness or disease can withstand the anointing on the inside of you.

DAY SEVEN

Authority Over the Enemy

No weapon formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment you shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is from Me," Says the LORD.

ISAIAH 54:17 (NKJV)

Declare this:

Father, I take authority over every plan of the enemy to keep me in loss, defeat, and stagnancy. I declare total victory in the name of Jesus. My mouth will never speak anything contrary to Your Word. No weapon formed against me, my family, The Church of the Lord Jesus Christ, or its people will prosper, in Jesus' name, Amen.

I want to encourage you to take authority over every plan of the enemy to keep you in a state of loss, failure, stagnancy, and defeat. Overwhelming victory belongs to you. Joy, unspeakable, along with healing, vitality, strength, endurance, and resistance are yours.

Week Ten

Total Dominion & Victory



Sweetie, you were never meant to live in defeat—dominion is your birthright! From the very beginning, God gave mankind authority to rule and subdue the Earth (Genesis 1:26-28), and through Christ, that dominion has been fully restored. You are not a victim of circumstances, the enemy, or the world's systems—you are more than a conqueror (Romans 8:37).

Victory isn't something you strive for—it's something you *walk in*. Jesus has already won, and He has seated you with Him in heavenly places, far above all powers and principalities (Ephesians 2:6; Colossians 2:15). The only question is—will you take your place? It's time to rise in faith, enforce your God-given authority, and live in the dominion and victory that belongs to you!

DAY ONE

Dominion To Recover All

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have *it* more abundantly.

JOHN 10:10 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Lord, open my eyes to see what the enemy has stolen from me. Give me the strength and authority to take it back by Your power, in Jesus' name, Amen.

The Lord will empower you to see what the enemy has stolen. Not only that, He has given you the authority and strength to go after it and recover all. Every delay or speed bump must leave now, in the mighty name of Jesus. Take back what belongs to you!

DAY TWO

Authority to Possess What Is Yours

The LORD said to Abram, after Lot had left him, “Now lift up your eyes and look from the place where you are standing, northward and southward and eastward and westward; for all the land which you see I will give to you and to your descendants forever.

GENESIS 13:14-15 (AMP)

Pray this out loud:

Father, in the name of Jesus, I take authority over every spiritual force working to block my possession of what Your Word declares belongs to me. I walk in dominion. I take what belongs to me. I will perform my due diligence. I will be wise in my investments and be a good steward of the resources You’ve entrusted to me, in Jesus’ name, Amen.

You need eyes to see in the spirit. When you have eyes that can see in the spirit, you take dominion over whatever is necessary to produce change. You understand that things don’t automatically happen according to God’s Word—you must enforce them.

Get smart. If you want to own real estate—get serious. Research a plot of land and find out the protocol for the transfer of land. Study how to be a good landlord. Start making moves like you’ve already taken what belongs to you. Don’t remain ignorant.

I command you to succeed and be overwhelmingly good at everything you do. I command the wisdom of God to overtake you, so you’ll know exactly what to do and say. You will possess an understanding of all things critical to your divine assignment.

DAY THREE

Possess the Land

Every place upon which the sole of your foot shall tread, that have I given to you, as I promised Moses.

JOSHUA 1:3 (AMPC)

Declare this:

Today, I stand on God's Word, knowing that He desires for me to walk in dominion on this Earth. Land, property, homes, and vehicles supernaturally come into my possession now by faith, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Declare your rightful ownership of land and property today—they're part of God's covenant blessing. It doesn't matter if you're eighteen or eighty years old—they belong to you now. So, take them!

Acreage, buildings, warehouses, whatever type of property you need, comes into your possession supernaturally. You won't have property to hoard it—you'll use it to establish the work of God's Kingdom.

While other people worry about gas money and the cost of groceries, you'll be taking back property. You will possess the land as your inheritance. It is yours, in the mighty name of Jesus. Satan must take his hands off it.

DAY FOUR

Power to Walk in Victory

But those who wait for the Lord [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] shall change and renew their strength and power; they shall lift their wings and mount up [close to God] as eagles [mount up to the sun]; they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint or become tired.

ISAIAH 40:31(AMPC)

Throw up your hands and say this:

Lord, give me strength to fight for what is mine. Empower me to walk in victory, and let me never, ever, ever, ever grow weary, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Maybe you haven't seen the manifestation, but don't grow weary in well-doing. Continue to claim victory, blessing, prosperity, and healing—they belong to you. Ask God to empower you by His Spirit. He'll help you—you'll never be a loser. He's your guide, sustainer, helper, and friend.

The Lord will cause new strength to come alive on the inside of you. You will never grow weary as you believe for blessing, breakthrough, and restoration, in the name of Jesus.

DAY FIVE

Supernatural Strength and Endurance

But those who wait on the LORD
Shall renew their strength;
They shall mount up with wings like eagles,
They shall run and not be weary,
They shall walk and not faint.

ISAIAH 40:31 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Father, give me supernatural strength. Empower me to stand firm during trials. I am unshakable in every circumstance in my life because You are with me, in Jesus' name, Amen.

No more weakness and flip-flopping. Wishy-washy Christianity ends today. You will be strong in the power of the Lord. He gives you the supernatural strength you need to endure and persevere through every challenge and trial. You have nothing to fear, and no reason to worry.

DAY SIX

Answered Prayer

It shall come to pass that before they call, I will answer; and while they are still speaking, I will hear.

ISAIAH 65:24 (NKJV)

I want you to take your hand, smack it on your head, and say this:

Heavenly Father, thank You for answering my prayers even before I finish praying, in the name of Jesus, Amen.

Prepare to receive everything you've been asking God to do. Thank Him for supernatural turnarounds, breakthroughs, open doors, and wisdom in the mighty name of Jesus.

Now, lift your hands and give God the glory. Seal your prayers with a little bit of worship. Thank Him for allowing you the privilege to see another day. He is wonderful and greatly to be praised.

Never grow weary of counting your blessings. Exalt and magnify your heavenly Father. Give Him all the glory, all the love, and all the praise because it belongs to Him and Him alone, in the mighty name of Jesus.

DAY SEVEN

Reflect God's Glory and Excellence

So then, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you may do, do all for the honor and glory of God.

1 CORINTHIANS 10:31 (AMPC)

If there's anything you're not happy with—change it. If you're self-conscious about your smile—fix it. If you're uncomfortable because you're overweight—hit the gym. Be excellent in everything you do, embody the glory of God, and be a great representative of Christ.

Pray this:

Lord, help me reflect Your glory in my appearance and demeanor. Let everything about me represent Your excellence. Let Your glory attract people to me, so that I might speak the truth of Your Word into their lives. Lord, I will do my part, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Go to war against anything attempting to limit you from completing everything God has called you to do. Decide today to begin tackling every instruction He's given you. You will become the embodiment of God's glory—a true representation of Christ.

Lord, put the joy of the Lord on the inside of everyone reading. Cause people to be attracted to them. Let the joy of the Lord open doors of opportunity and favor, in the mighty name of Jesus.

Week Eleven

Undisturbed Composure



The LORD will keep you from all harm—he will watch over your life.

PSALM 121:7 (NIV)

Supernatural protection is a benefit of being a child of God. He will protect you everywhere you go. He protects your children when they're at school. God protects you and your family from every form of harm.

Not only does God protect you and your family, but He has placed a hedge of protection over everything that belongs to you. He sends His angels to encamp around you. Anything the Devil meant for harm, your heavenly Father will use for your good. He frustrates every plan of the enemy that comes against you. Every plan of attack against you will fail.

Your knowledge and understanding of these truths put you at complete peace and undisturbed composure. How can you be disturbed when you know God has promised to keep you from all harm?

DAY ONE

God's Perfecting Grace

And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness."

2 CORINTHIANS 12:9a (NKJV)

You have absolutely no reason to worry. God's grace is more than enough to account for your weakness. Any area in your life that's lacking is simply an opportunity for God to make it perfect.

Say this out loud:

I declare that God's grace is more than enough for me. No insecurity has any power over me because His strength is made perfect in my weakness. I will no longer focus on what I lack, but rather on His limitless power at work in me, in Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY TWO

Reject Fear

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

2 TIMOTHY 1:7 (NKJV)

Slap your hand over your head and say this:

Lord, I reject every form of fear. Thank You for giving me power, love, and a sound mind filled with Your wisdom to provide all I need. Strengthen my faith as I declare Your promises over my life. Fear has no place in my heart, for I walk by faith and not by sight. I will trust in You even when I don't see the whole picture, in Jesus' name, Amen.

I command you to walk through every open door. I declare every form of fear will be unveiled at the source and shut down by the power of God.

Refuse to allow this year to be marked with any kind of fear, anxiety, or stress. You don't need to fear just because everyone else is afraid. You can stand firm, smiling—happy as can be—full of joy and peace because you know God has not given you a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and control over your thoughts.

DAY THREE

Align Your Thoughts with God's Word

Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if *there is* any virtue and if *there is* anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.

PHILIPPIANS 4:8 (NKJV)

Pray this out loud:

Father, help me to meditate on what is pure, noble, and true. Let my thoughts align with Your Word, so I can reflect Your goodness in everything I do. Thank You for filling my mind with peace and clarity, in Jesus' name, Amen.

It doesn't matter what is happening around you—choose to meditate on what is pure, just, noble, lovely, and praiseworthy. All of Hell could literally break loose, but the peace of God that surpasses all understanding is found in God's Word. The Holy Spirit will help you meditate on what is good.

DAY FOUR

Surrender Every Negative Thought

For as he thinks in his heart, so is he. “Eat and drink!” he says to you, but his heart is not with you.

PROVERBS 23:7 (NKJV)

Say this out loud:

Lord, I surrender every negative thought to You, and I ask You to replace them with thoughts of victory, peace, and joy. Let my mind reflect Your greatness and goodness. Help me to think in alignment with who You have called me to be, in Jesus’ name, Amen.

Take every thought into captivity that goes against what God is speaking on your behalf. Refuse to align your thoughts with lies. Instead, choose to associate yourself with God’s Word and everything He has declared over you, in the mighty name of Jesus.

DAY FIVE

Diligence & Transformation

Keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life.

PROVERBS 4:23 (NKJV)

Put your hand over your heart and declare this:

Lord, I commit my heart and mind to You. Let Your Word transform every part of my being, so that I will reflect Your wonderful glory. Guard my heart against anything that would hinder my faith. I declare a lasting transformation in my life, in Jesus' name, Amen.

No more inconsistency—no back and forth, or ups and downs. You won't be good for three years, then backslide for two. You will experience a lasting transformation in the name of Jesus. Commit your heart and mind to His Word and allow it to transform every part of who you are. As you do, you will reflect God's glory and goodness in the land of the living (Psalm 27:13).

Ask God to guard your heart against anything that would hinder or pull you away from His presence. Don't back down when circumstances become difficult—stay committed.

DAY SIX

Walk in the Joy of the Lord

Do not grieve, for the joy of the LORD is your strength.

NEHEMIAH 8:10b (NIV)

Do not allow your happiness to depend on the decisions of another person. Stop relying on other people to make you happy—it's toxic. Nothing and no one can bring you fulfillment except Jesus Christ—nothing—not a relationship, a marriage, or a child. Nothing will bring you purpose except a relationship with Christ.

Don't place the onus on your spouse or another individual—it's not fair. Place your joy in Christ alone. No one else can unlock your happiness.

Pray this:

Lord, teach me to find my joy and contentment in You alone—not in the decisions or actions of others. Father, overwhelm me with Your joy and peace in Your presence, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Take a moment to rejoice in the Lord. Joy is a fruit of the spirit—that means you already have it. Share your joy with others. Let God's joy shine through your life today.

DAY SEVEN

Live Peaceably

Endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

EPHESIANS 4:3 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Lord, help me to walk in peace with others. Let strife have no place in my life. Empower me to be a peacemaker—not a drama queen, in Jesus’ name, Amen.

That’s a good one. Pray that every kind of drama will miss you. God will make you a peacemaker. Thank Him for helping you walk in divine unity.

Everything of discord and disunity is broken, now. In the mighty name of Jesus, be filled with compassion and love for those around you. Let your mind become so preoccupied with building up others that you couldn’t fathom tearing anyone down.

Week Twelve

Prayer for Your Family



Your family needs you! You may be the only one standing in the gap for them in prayer. It is a privilege and responsibility that carries both weight and reward. If you don't intercede, who will? Scripture reminds us that "*The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective*" (James 5:16), and your prayers can shift the course of your family's destiny.

Even if you haven't yet seen the full manifestation of your loved ones walking with God, don't lose heart. "*Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household*" (Acts 16:31).

Keep praying, keep believing, and trust that God is working behind the scenes. There is no greater joy than seeing your family serve the Lord together, and in due time, you will reap the harvest if you do not give up (Galatians 6:9)!

DAY ONE

A Strong Marriage

Therefore what God has joined together, let not man separate.”

MARK 10:9 (NKJV)

Don't you dare skip this one, single ladies. Whether you're married or hope to be—pray this.

I can't tell you how many times I've listened to women complain:

“My husband isn't the head of the home.”

“I just wish that he were like...”

“I can't really submit under him anymore...”

Stop with the bickering and complaining because the reality is, he's probably a good guy. He might not know the Lord, but that's what you're going to pray about.

If this sounds like you, here's what you're going to do: find what it is you love about him. Don't you roll your eyes—you do love him. You fell in love with him for a reason. Instead of focusing on what drives you crazy, settle it in your heart: he is the person God has given you. He is your confidant. He is your teammate, and you will be kind to him because the goodness of God draws men to repentance.

Pray this aloud:

Lord, bring peace, understanding, and restoration to my marriage. Help me to honor and cherish him as the husband You've given me. Help me love him the way You love him.

Make my marriage a reflection of Your covenant love and faithfulness, in Jesus' name, Amen.

If you're single, pray this for your future because you'll be married one day. Pray that joy, peace, and understanding will fill your home, in Jesus' name.

DAY TWO

Family Unity

For God is not a God of disorder but of peace,
as in all the meetings of God's holy people.

1 CORINTHIANS 14:33 (NLT)

Pray this:

Lord, I commit my family into Your hands. Let Your peace, unity, and love reign in our home. Destroy chaos and disorder in my family, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Pray for unity and love to overtake your family, in the mighty name of Jesus. Let your home be a place of peace.

As you commit your family to the Lord, thank Him for supernatural protection over everyone in your household, in the mighty name of Jesus.

DAY THREE

Divine Protection

For he will order his angels to protect you
wherever you go.

PSALM 91:11 (NLT)

Pray this, even if you don't have children:

Father, protect my children and my family from all harm, and do not allow the evil one to touch them. Let Your angels watch over them wherever they go, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Regardless of what happens in this world today, you and your house will serve the Lord. His protection is upon you and your family. God has set His angels before you as a hedge of protection over your family, your children, and everything that pertains to you, in the mighty name of Jesus.

The Lord will give you a heads-up, so you will never be caught by surprise. He will frustrate every plan of the enemy assigned to your family, children, home, and business, in the mighty name of Jesus.

DAY FOUR

Wisdom for Your Children

And you must commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these commands that I am giving you today. Repeat them again and again to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are going to bed and when you are getting up.

DEUTERONOMY 6:6-7 (NLT)

Pray this:

Lord, fill my children with the wisdom and understanding of Your Word, so that they may walk in Your ways, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Your children will be filled with unusual wisdom beyond their years. They will understand things that many adults have difficulty understanding. God will anoint their minds and empower them to retain the Word of God.

Pray that the Lord would reveal Himself to your children during their private time with Him. God will give them discernment to know right from wrong, in the mighty name of Jesus. They will always walk in His ways. They will never be confused about their future.

Pray for your children's spouses. Lord, keep them holy, pure, and righteous. The Lord will protect and keep your children all the days of their lives. They will hate sin and love righteousness. They will love God's presence and His Word.

Every person sent to destroy your children's lives or distract them from their calling will be removed. Anyone sent to discourage your children won't make it anywhere near them. God will protect their hearts, in the mighty name of Jesus.

DAY FIVE

Wisdom to Raise Godly Children

Train up a child in the way he should go, and
when he's old, he won't depart from it.

PROVERBS 22:6 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Father, grant me the wisdom and grace to train my children in Your ways, ensuring a legacy of righteousness, in Jesus' name, Amen.

I pray that the Lord would anoint every mother and father to train their children in the way that they should go. I pray God will give you wisdom, grace, patience, and understanding, in Jesus' name. You will raise good, godly men and women.

DAY SIX

A Home Filled with God's Presence

Unless the LORD builds a house, the work of the builders is wasted. Unless the LORD protects a city, guarding it with sentries will do no good.

PSALM 127:1 (NLT)

Say this out loud:

Father, establish Your presence in my family. Making my home a sanctuary of your love, peace, and purpose, in Jesus' name, Amen.

The Lord will transform the atmosphere of your home into a place where He can abide—where love, unity, peace, and purpose abound. Anything causing strife and chaos ends today. Your home will be filled with overwhelming joy, peace, and fun—a sanctuary for His presence, in the mighty Name of Jesus.

DAY SEVEN

Family Alignment

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

EPHESIANS 2:10 (NKJV)

Pray this over your household:

Father, align every member of my family with their divine destiny. Empower us to walk in Your perfect plan, unhindered by distractions or delays.

As you pray this prayer over your family, every distraction of the enemy will leave. God will strengthen your family and sharpen your vision as you move forward together in the purpose God has for you.

Week Thirteen

Win the Lost



Winning the lost is not a suggestion—it’s a divine mandate! Jesus commanded, “*Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature*” (Mark 16:15). Two things stand out in this scripture: first, there’s no mention of the fivefold ministry—this command is for *every* believer. Second, the word *GO* is not a suggestion—it’s an action.

Too many people are waiting for revival, hoping God will miraculously save the lost, but He has already entrusted *us with* that assignment. When should we win the lost? *Now. Go. NOW!* There is no perfect time to obey God’s Word—the time is always now!

God has a dream found, and it’s found in 1 Timothy 2:4—that *all* would come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. We have the privilege of fulfilling that dream *today!* Will you answer the call?

DAY ONE

Become a Living Testimony

That all the peoples of the earth may know the hand of the LORD, that it is mighty, that you may fear the LORD your God forever.

JOSHUA 4:24 (NKJV)

Pray this out loud:

Father, make me a testimony of Your mighty power, so that others may come to know and glorify You. Let the multitudes be affected by my testimony in Jesus' name, Amen.

Pray that God will give you a testimony that draws people to Him. Whether it's healing, prosperity, or favor, let your testimony be an awesome demonstration of His mighty power. May your miracle bring people to salvation. Ask the Lord to give you a powerful testimony this month in Jesus' name.

DAY TWO

Preach with Boldness & Power

Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to
Your servants that with all boldness they may
speak Your word

ACTS 4:29 (NKJV)

Pray this from the depths of your soul:

Lord, give me the boldness to declare Your Word without fear or hesitation. Let me proclaim the truth with *power* and *authority*.

Pray that God would put boldness inside of you to preach the Gospel. If you're already bold, pray He would increase your boldness today. Ask God to use you to proclaim His power to this generation with authority and an anointing, in the mighty name of Jesus.

This is prayer is not reserved for those in ministry—everyone is called to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ. You will do it without fear or hesitation. He will fill your mouth with what to say, ensuring that every word you speak is effective. Everything you say will pierce the hearts of those listening.

DAY THREE

Passion to Win the Lost

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

ROMANS 1:16 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Heavenly Father, fill me with boldness and compassion to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with the lost. Let my heart burn passionately as You fill my words with Your power, bringing salvation to all who hear them, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Be filled with urgency for souls. People live and die daily without knowing the Lord. From this moment forward, may your heart break for what breaks God's heart.

Be free from fear and timidity now and be filled with boldness, compassion, and love to win the lost. May you be motivated to share the Good News of Jesus Christ.

DAY FOUR

Power to Perform Signs & Wonders

Then He said to His disciples, “The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.”

MATTHEW 9:37-38 (NKJV)

And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word through the accompanying signs. Amen.

MARK 16:20 (NKJV)

Pray this out loud:

Lord, I pray the fields of this world, which are white for harvest, be brought into Your Kingdom. Fill me with Your Spirit. Let signs, wonders, and miracles confirm Your Word as I share the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Use me as a vessel to bring multitudes to Your eternal life, in Jesus’ name, Amen.

God said He would confirm His Word with signs and wonders. No one will walk away questioning whether He’s real—He makes Himself real to them and us through the manifestation of His power.

Let Him turn you into a living testimony of His power. Trust Him to confirm His Word as you share the Gospel with others, and He will use you to bring in the harvest.

DAY FIVE

Receive God's Perfect Love

And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma.

EPHESIANS 5:2 (NKJV)

There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.

1 JOHN 4:18 (NKJV)

I want to encourage you to walk in love every day—even when people test your patience. Your life should reflect your heavenly Father's love. Let Him make you a living testimony.

Pray this:

Father, let Your perfect love cast all fear out of my life. Teach me to trust in You, knowing that Your love never fails. Help me to share Your love fearlessly with those who are hurting and lost, in Jesus' name, Amen.

God will banish every form of fear in your life. Ask the Lord to teach you to receive His love, so that you will be perfected. He will teach you to trust Him wholeheartedly.

DAY SIX

Urgency to Win Souls

Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit

MATTHEW 28:19 (NKJV)

And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.

EPHESIANS 4:32 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Father, give me a sense of urgency for Your Kingdom. Let my heart burn with compassion for others, making me a true reflection of Christ to a hurting world. Fill my heart with Your love to win souls, disciple others, and advance Your Kingdom, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Let the love of God flow through you, so that everything you do is done in love. Let love be the motivator behind every action you take. Be kind and tender-hearted towards others. Be kind to your spouse, your children, your neighbors, and everyone you encounter. Make a decision to be kind to everyone who crosses your path.

As you continue to be filled with God's love, may it birth an urgency in you to advance God's Kingdom by the power of the Holy Spirit. You will have an urgency for souls and a deep desire to make disciples, in Jesus' name.

DAY SEVEN

Focus on Your Assignment

Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

HEBREWS 12:2 (NKJV)

Pray this with confidence:

Father, I declare that nothing will distract me from fulfilling my assignment. Let my heart remain steadfast, my eyes fixed on Jesus, and my mind focused on the Great Commission. I command every distraction to bow to the name of Jesus, Amen.

You will fulfill your God-given assignment, and no distractions will hinder you. Your heart will remain steadfast. You will not quit. Keep your eyes fixed on Jesus and your mind focused on the Great Commission.

Week Fourteen

Kingdom Advancement



You shall be blessed above all peoples; there shall not be a male or female barren among you or among your livestock.

DEUTERONOMY 7:14 (NKJV)

When the Bible speaks about barrenness, it is talking about children, but it's also referring to production. You've been charged with making each year, each month, and every day count.

Did you know Jesus is coming back shortly? The world is looking for extraterrestrials for Pete's sake—the end is near. There has never been a better time to diligently pursue everything God has in store for you.

Do you know you will meet God the Father, and give an account for everything you did and didn't do on Earth? If He put a dream in your heart and you haven't tackled it—if you haven't even made an effort to go after it—what are you doing? It's time to analyze and recalibrate. Evaluate your life and decide what you need to change and pursue in order to accomplish what God has called you to do. Take it seriously. If you haven't already begun—start today.

DAY ONE

Be Used for Kingdom Expansion

And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.

MATTHEW 24:14 (NKJV)

Jesus is coming soon. Are you ready? It's a sobering thought. Are you actively pursuing the call of God on your life? The best time to start obeying God was yesterday, and the second best time is right now.

Pray for God to anoint you to preach the Gospel like never before—to every nation, tribe, and tongue—that His Kingdom may be established across the Earth.

Pray this out loud:

Heavenly Father, empower me to expand Your Kingdom. Let multitudes come to know You as Lord through my life, testimony, and work, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Pray that God would use you to bring in the lost souls of this world, in the mighty name of Jesus. Give Him all of you, so that you become useful and productive for His Kingdom.

DAY TWO

Provision to Advance the Kingdom

And you shall remember the LORD your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.

DEUTERONOMY 8:18 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Father, bless me with the resources, influence, and favor I need to carry out the vision You have given me for Kingdom work, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Command the spirit of lack and poverty to leave you, in the mighty name of Jesus. Thank God for endowing you with the power to produce wealth. Thank Him ahead of time for providing the resources, influence, and favor you need to carry out the vision He's placed in your heart.

DAY THREE

A Reflection of Heaven's Wealth

The blessing of the LORD makes one rich, and
He adds no sorrow with it.

PROVERBS 10:22 (NKJV)

First, say this: **I'm rich, baby!**

Now pray this:

Lord, thank You for being the God of abundance. I declare lack is defeated, and I walk in supernatural provision. Let my finances reflect the wealth of Heaven as I live as a steward of Your Kingdom, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Once you believe and declare this over your life, lack is defeated. You are a faithful steward of God's Kingdom, so poverty must cease. You walk in supernatural provision, breakthrough, favor, and promotion from this moment forward. The blessing will begin to overtake and overwhelm you to the point that you feel embarrassed by the goodness of God manifesting in your life.

DAY FOUR

Live a Kingdom-Focused Life

The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD, and He delights in his way.

PSALM 37:23 (NKJV)

Declare this:

Lord, let my life be marked by purpose and intentionality. I will live with a Kingdom focus—pursuing souls, *serv*ing others, and building what lasts for eternity. Teach me to walk in step with Your Spirit, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Align your focus with God's heart. Opt out of any opportunity that doesn't line up with what He wants you to do. May you never prioritize what is not in line with His priorities. If you want to go higher and change levels, you must align with the Spirit of God.

DAY FIVE

Command Resources to Expand Kingdom Endeavors

And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

PHILIPPIANS 4:19 (NKJV)

Say this:

Lord, I declare that every resource needed to accomplish Your work will be provided. Let Heaven's storehouse be open over my life for the sake of Your Kingdom, in Jesus' name, Amen.

This doesn't just apply to you and your home—this applies to your business as well, if it's attached to the Kingdom. If you have a Kingdom focus, the blessing will come upon you and your family.

Declare supernatural provision over every area of your life. Heaven's storehouse will be open to accomplish the work you've been called to complete, and to expand the Kingdom of God.

DAY SIX

Inherit the Nations

Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for
Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for
Your possession.

PSALM 2:8 (NKJV)

Pray this:

**Lord, I ask for the nations to be brought into Your Kingdom,
that Your glory may fill the Earth as the waters cover the sea.
Use me to do it, in Jesus' name, Amen.**

The nations are your inheritance—ask Him for them.

DAY SEVEN

Become a Laborer in God's Kingdom

Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few."

MATTHEW 9:37 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Father, raise up faithful and fearless laborers who will carry the message of Your Kingdom to the ends of the Earth.

Say this:

Anoint my children to take Your message to the ends of the Earth, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Pray that the Lord would raise up faithful and fearless laborers to carry His Kingdom message to the ends of the Earth. Not only that, pray He would use you. Tell Him you'll go—ask Him to send you. Tell someone about the love of Jesus Christ today.

Week Fifteen

A Righteous Nation



Anation's strength is not found in its wealth, military, or politics—it is found in its righteousness. *"Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people"* (Proverbs 14:34). God is looking for people who will stand for truth, uphold His Word, and refuse to bow to the culture of compromise.

DAY THREE

DAY FIVE

PSALM 121:5 (NLT)

Pray this:

Don't waste another minute being spiritually dead. Be strong in the Lord and the power of His might (Ephesians 6:10). Put the time in and receive spiritual growth by faith. Set yourself apart to receive spiritual things. Let the desire to grow spiritually be at the forefront of everything you do.

God never asked about your qualifications—He simply told you to do it. Life is too short to wait for the right time. The time is now. Start the business. Pack up and move. End the relationship. Whatever it is He has told you to do, act now in faith, in the mighty name of Jesus!

DAY FOUR

An Increased Hunger for The Word

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled.

MATTHEW 5:6 (NKJV)

Pray this:

Lord, increase my hunger for Your Word and Your presence. Help me to live a life that is holy and pleasing to You. Sanctify me by Your truth, for Your Word is truth, in Jesus' name, Amen.

Pray this prayer:

Father, ignite the fire of Your Spirit within me. Forgive me for allowing complacency to creep into my walk with You. Stir up a burning passion in my heart to seek You fervently and serve You wholeheartedly all the days of my life, so I may never be lukewarm in my faith, in Jesus' name, Amen.

May what Jesus said in Revelation 3:15-16 never be said about you. Refuse to allow even a hint of apathy to creep its way into your walk with the Lord. You will hunger and seek after God like you never have before. Ask Him to burn laziness, defeat, and complacency out of you, so that you are free to serve Him faithfully all the days of your life.

DAY SIX

Faith for the Impossible

For assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.

MATTHEW 17:20 (NKJV)

Say this out loud:

God's Word declares faith comes by hearing, hearing by the Word of God (Romans 10:17). That means you need to gain an understanding of His Word so your faith increases, and any doubt within you leaves.

Pray for the Lord to release a fresh anointing upon your life—that you would be empowered to move into your new dawn with strength, courage, and divine enablement. Receive a fresh anointing today. Everything in your life will reach a new level, in Jesus' name.

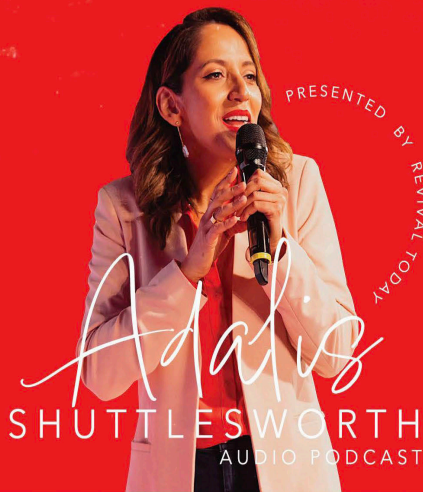
