What to expect in a week at Outset*

Practical Legal Skills & Workshops

Students get a firsthand look at what attorneys practice, using real-world legal tools and guided exercises in research, writing, and advocacy. Every program includes its own set of hands-on activities designed to help students understand what practicing law actually looks like.

Examples of activities may include:

Legal Research & Writing:

Learning how to find case law, construct legal arguments, and draft the kinds of documents lawyers use every day.

Mock Trial & Advocacy:

Developing courtroom presence through structured exercises in oral argument, examination, and presenting a case.

Legal Skills Workshops:

Focused micro-sessions on practical capabilities lawyers build during early career – including research techniques, professional writing, and client communication.

Lectures with Legal Faculty & Attorneys

Students attend sessions led by attorneys and law faculty from a range of practice areas who share firsthand perspectives on legal careers. These interactive discussions help students understand what different fields of law require and what a day in the life of an attorney looks like.

- What an attorney actually does day to day in their practice area
- How lawyers choose their area of law
- The path from undergrad through law school and early career
- Real stories from the courtroom and legal practice
- Student-driven Q&A about careers, school, challenges, and lifestyle

These sessions help students better understand whether a legal career is the right fit for them.

Headstart Learning on How Law School Works

All students participate in Outset's "Path to Law School" curriculum. It is designed to demystify the entire journey to becoming an attorney. Students learn:

- The full timeline from high school to college to law school
- What pre-law classes and majors to consider
- Strategies for succeeding in a competitive undergraduate environment
- How to choose the right college for their goals
- What the LSAT is, how, and when to prepare for it
- How to make smart choices about extracurriculars, internships, and gap years
- What law school applications look for

FAQs

Admissions deadline & process?

There is no deadline! We have rolling Admissions. We have a simple 4-step Admissions process including an online application and 10min video interview

What is the cost?

Tuition and housing for our programs is \$2,950, including 24/7 staff, dorms, meals, 20+ hours of academics, speakers, evening activities, and activity transport. Travel to and from campus is not included.

Is there financial aid?

Yes, if you need financial aid please indicate this on your online application and fill out the aid information. We are not able to guarantee aid but we do take every aid request seriously.

How do I apply? How competitive is it?

Applying online is easy: **click here**. You'll hear from us within 2 business days. Outset is competitive and we look for motivated students with strong grades and a genuine interest in law.

Are students supervised 24/7?

Outset maintains a 8:1 student-to-staff ratio, with ACA-trained staff providing 24/7 supervision. Our programs meet strict safety standards, and campuses are monitored to ensure students are safe at all times.

What are rooms and housing like?

Outset partners with college residence halls/dorms. Rooms are shared with 1-2 students of the same gender, & shared bathrooms. Single rooms are available for an additional fee- please check with our team for up-to-date info on cost and availability.

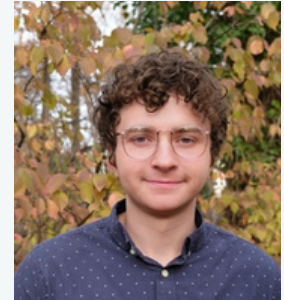

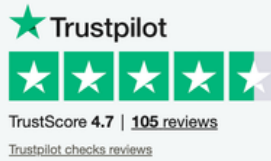

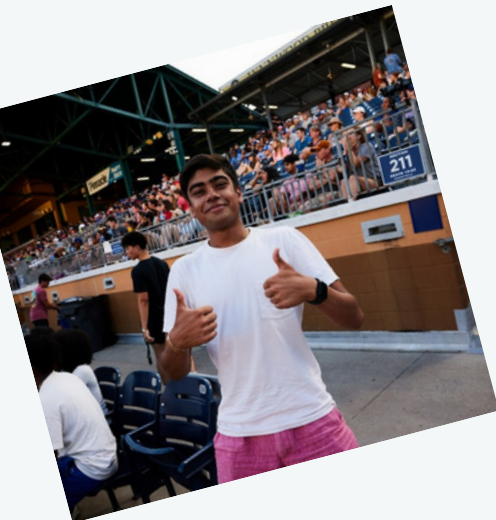
