AHS contracts 11 fixed-wing aircraft to provide 24-hour air ambulance services throughout the province, and Fort Vermilion has one of those bases. Built in the early 1900s, this beautiful big yellow structure is the only Hudson's Bay Company factor's house on its original site in Alberta and provides a unique glimpse of Alberta's fur trade settlers.
