Bev got it at the pet shop.

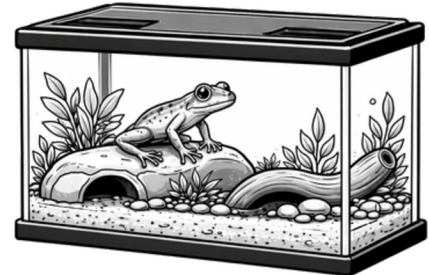
When she feeds it, she lifts her chin and looks in.
