

Health & Safety: Student Responsibilities



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1. Introduction

- 1.1 The ICMT is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for all students. We will take all reasonable steps to achieve this. However, the outcome will depend on the cooperation of students complying with this guidance and policies and practices.

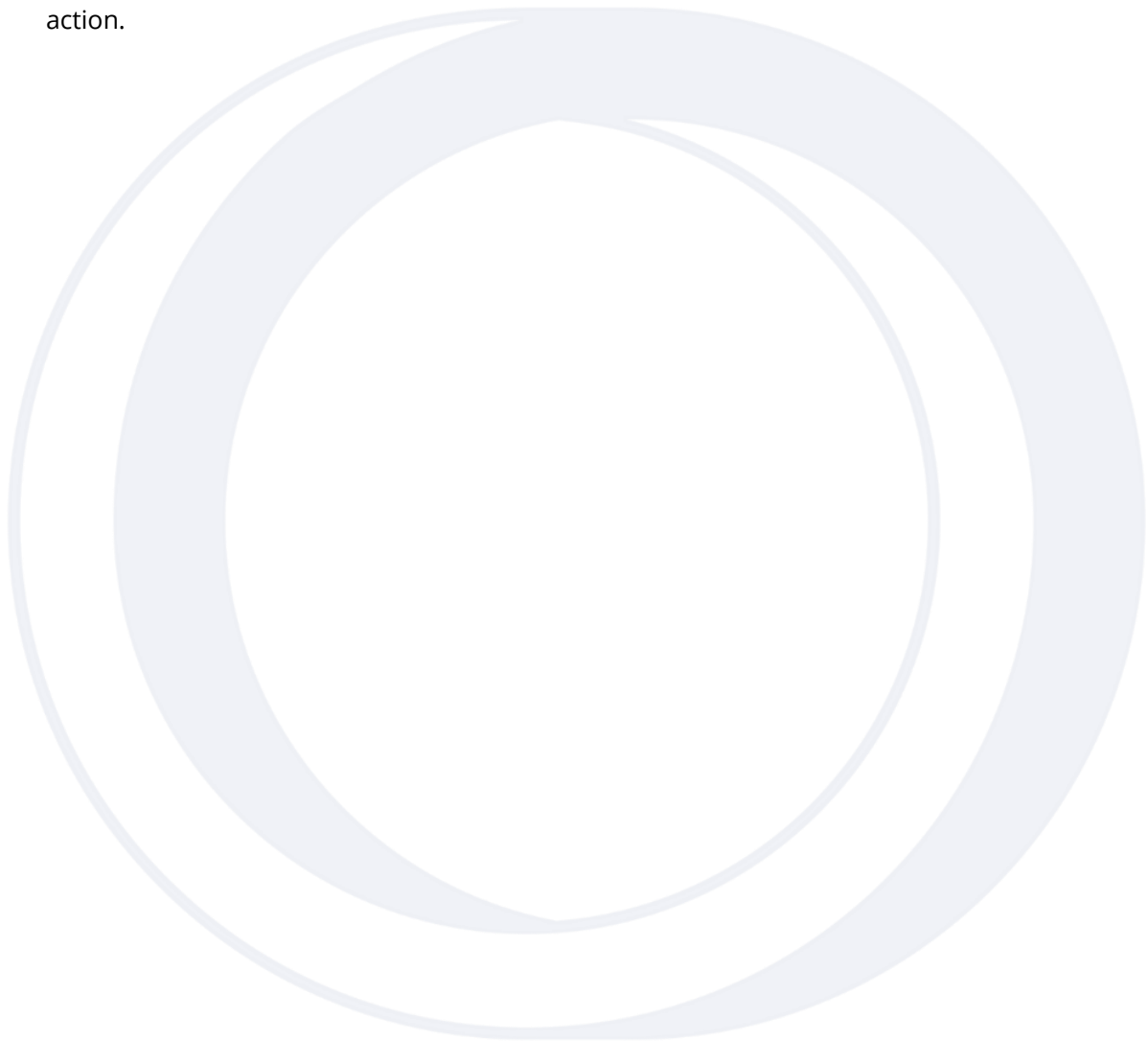
2. Students have a responsibility to themselves and others

- 2.1 As well as looking after themselves, students must not do anything which may put others at risk, damage equipment or buildings or cause injury to someone else. This may include indulging in horseplay, acting irresponsibly, ignoring safety instructions etc.
- 2.2 Students are expected to report all accidents incidents, including near misses and other situations they consider a health and safety matter, to a staff member.
- 2.3 Students shall cooperate with the ICMT so far as is necessary to enable any duty, statutory and/or regulating body requirements etc to be performed or complied with. This includes complying with staff instructions, participating in exercises such as fire drills and following any procedures to protect public health (social distancing, wearing face coverings, etc.), safeguarding issues, and escalating any concerns.
- 2.4 With regard to fire safety, students must not interfere with fire equipment, deface notices or activate false alarms. These actions could constitute a criminal offence, and the Fire Service may consider prosecution of the culprit. It is the policy of the ICMT to cooperate with the authorities on matters of fire safety.
- 2.5 Students must not attempt to gain entry into areas marked as or known to be out of bounds. This includes boiler rooms, electrical rooms and construction sites. This list is not exhaustive but indicates the areas students are prohibited from entering. If in doubt, students should seek permission before entering.
- 2.6 Students must always follow health and safety instructions, whether they are given verbally, provided in writing or during a training session.

2.7 While on the ICMT premises, students are responsible for the actions of their visitors and must ensure the requirements of this guidance are met. In the case of a breach, the visitor will be requested to leave, and the student could be subject to disciplinary action.

3. Students have a responsibility to themselves and others

3.1 Any breach of this guidance is deemed a serious offence and thus subject to disciplinary action.
