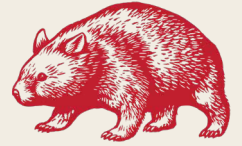


ADELAIDE HILLS BUTTERY CHARDONNAY



REGION:

Adelaide Hills, South Australia

WINEMAKER:

ALCOHOL:

13.5%

WINEMAKING:

Sourced from vineyards located in the Adelaide Hills, fruit planted to warmer sites are combined with later ripening sites to deliver complex characters, freshness and with breadth of ripe fruit flavours. Handpicked, whole bunch pressed straight to oak where it was fermented on full solids with intermittent stirring and malolactic fermentation. This wine spent 7 months in varying French oak formats before bottling with minimal fining and filtration.

TASTING NOTE:

The Little Giant Adelaide Hills Chardonnay displays enticing aromas of golden peach, pineapple, vanillin oak and a touch of caramel that lead into a generous palate with excellent weight and a buttery mouthfeel. Juicy acidity lifts the richness and buttery texture, making this wine both vibrant and effortlessly drinkable.
