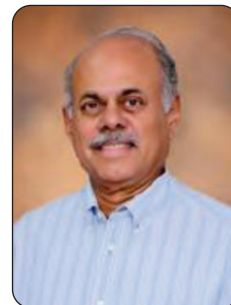

RAGGING AND ITS CONSEQUENCES

According to Act No. 7 of 1997 of the Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act, ragging in educational institutions in the State of Tamil Nadu is prohibited.

DEFINITION

According to this Act, 'ragging' means the display of noisy, disorderly conduct or any act likely to cause physical or psychological harm, apprehension, fear, shame or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution. This includes:

- ❖ Teasing, abusing, playing practical jokes or causing hurt to a student.
- ❖ Asking the student to perform an act they would not willingly do in the ordinary Course etc.

W A R N I N G O N R A G G I N G

In the light of Supreme Court's Order & Expression of Displeasure vide SLP (C) No.24295/2004, HRD Ministry's (Govt. of India) direction vide F.9-18/2008 (U-5) dated 29.4.2008 and F.9-43/ 2007-U-5, UGC's direction Vide No. FI-8/2006 (CPP-II), directions from AICTE & MCI; and directions from Bharathiar University, Vide No.B3-B4/4070/2008, dt.03.04.2008 and No.B3- 4/11947/2008 dt.03.04.2008 pertaining to the curbing of ragging altogether in Educational Institutions, the college issues this order that ragging, in any form, in and around the campus is strictly prohibited. The defaulters in this regard, have to face serious consequences /severe punishment as decided by law.



UGC REGULATIONS ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, 2009

In pursuance of the Supreme Court judgment dated 08.05.2009, the UGC (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2009 define ragging as any conduct causing physical or psychological harm, fear, shame, or embarrassment to a student, strictly prohibiting it in all forms within educational institutions. The Institutions are mandated to establish Anti-Ragging Committees and Squads, conduct awareness programs, and take strict disciplinary action, including suspension, expulsion, or cancellation of admission, against perpetrators. These regulations emphasize the responsibility of institutions to create a ragging-free environment, monitor and report ragging incidents, and provide support and rehabilitation to victims, aligning with the Supreme Court's directives to curb the menace of ragging and promote a culture of respect and safety on campuses.

PROHIBITION OF RAGGING

Ragging within the campus or outside the educational institution is strictly prohibited.

PENALTY FOR RAGGING

Anyone directly or indirectly involved in committing, participating in, abetting or propagating '**ragging**' within or outside any educational institutions shall face imprisonment as per the Law.

DISMISSAL OF A STUDENT

A student convicted of an offence shall be dismissed from the educational institution and barred from admission to any other educational institutions.



RULES AND REGULATIONS

BEHAVIOUR AND CONDUCT

- ❖ The College emphasizes the importance of grooming for both boys and girls. This includes specific guidelines for hairstyles and dress codes.
- ❖ **Boys in Formal Dress, Girl students in Sarees / Salwar Kameez / Churidhar.**
- ❖ Boys are explicitly prohibited from wearing certain accessories like earrings, kadas (metal bangles), and wristbands as part of the college dress code policy.
- ❖ The College places great importance on the decent behaviour of every student, encouraging respectful and courteous conduct at all times.
- ❖ Students must observe strict discipline in the Campus and outside.
- ❖ Students are advised to refrain from engaging in party politics or activities that could disrupt the peaceful environment of the college.

DISCIPLINE AND CLASSROOM ETIQUETTE

- ❖ Students are expected to maintain silence during class hours and break time.
- ❖ Specific areas within the college premises may have restrictions on loitering to ensure smooth functioning and safety.
- ❖ Students are not permitted to wander around the campus unnecessarily.
- ❖ Mobile phone usage is regulated in classrooms and during lab hours to minimize distractions and uphold academic integrity.
- ❖ **Mobile phones are strictly prohibited during examinations.**

ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

- ❖ Punctuality is stressed upon. Students are expected to attend classes on time.
- ❖ Taking notes during lectures is mandatory to enhance understanding and retention of course materials.
- ❖ Adherence to the academic calendar is essential, including timely payment of fees and compliance with scheduled events.
- ❖ In unavoidable situations, students are expected to seek permission from appropriate authorities before leaving the campus.
- ❖ Students are not permitted to attend external programmes without the permission of the Head of the Institution.

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- ❖ Students arriving late will not be allowed to attend class without getting permission from the concerned Head of the Department / Head of the Institute.
 - ❖ Absence for one or more hours during a session will be considered as half-day absent.

STUDENT VEHICLE PARKING REGULATIONS

- ❖ Parking regulations ensure efficient vehicle placement and order. Separate parking areas are designated for boys and girls for convenience.
- ❖ Having a valid driving license is mandatory. Safety measures such as wearing helmets for two-wheeler riders are enforced to protect students' well-being.
- ❖ The institution does not take responsibility for any valuables such as Helmet, Wallets etc., left in vehicles.
- ❖ The security personal / designated college staff are authorized to inspect the records of the vehicle entering the campus.

GENERAL CAMPUS REGULATIONS

- ❖ Tuition Fee, Examination fee, Bus Fee and Hostel Fee should be paid on time.
- ❖ Permission from the Principal is required for organizing or attending functions, conferences, meetings, or gatherings to coordinate activities and ensure smooth operations.
- ❖ Discipline is expected in common areas like cafeteria, seminar halls, training centres, etc. to promote a respectful and organized environment.
- ❖ Students are not permitted to bring their friends from other colleges to the campus under any circumstances without proper authorization.
- ❖ The college reserves the right to take disciplinary action, including penalties, suspension, or dismissal, for any student found violating rules or engaging in gross misconduct.
- ❖ Students who are charged with the criminal offence and are under suspension shall not be allowed to enter the campus without permission.
- ❖ Students guilty of visiting other colleges or institutions and involving act of indiscipline will be punished accordingly.
- ❖ Stringent action will be taken against the students found under the influence of Drugs, Alcohol etc.
- ❖ Smoking is prohibited inside the college premises.
- ❖ Using obscene and vulgar words against others and disrespect towards teacher will lead to punishment.
- ❖ The college authorities reserve the right to amend, repeal or modify any of the above rules.

IDENTITY CARDS

- ❖ Students should wear their identity card duly signed by the Principal, all the time inside the campus and must produce the ID card on demand by the college officials. It is essential for students to keep their ID cards visible and accessible at all times while on campus. Failure to comply with the ID card policy may result in disciplinary action. All students are required to surrender the ID card upon completion of their studies.

COLLEGE PROPERTY & EQUIPMENT

- ❖ Students are expected to take proper care of college property and maintain the premises in a neat and tidy condition. Any damage done to college property, such as disfiguring walls, doors, fittings or breaking furniture, constitutes a breach of discipline. The students found responsible will be held liable and charged for the loss or damage incurred.

MEETING OF PARENTS WITH HoD

- ❖ Parents/Guardians are encouraged to meet the Head of the Department periodically to inquire about their wards' progress in studies and behaviour, fostering a strong partnership between the college and families to ensure students' holistic development.

LIBRARY

1. The Library will be kept open on all working days from 8:30 am to 7:00 pm.
2. On non-working Saturdays, the library will be open until 1:00 pm.
3. Silence must be maintained within the library premises.
4. Students are prohibited from removing, tearing, underlining and writing in books.
4. Book borrowing rules are as follows:
 - ❖ Undergraduate students can borrow 2 books, while postgraduate students and research scholars can borrow 3 books using their ID cards.
 - ❖ A fine of 1 rupee per day will be charged for delays in returning books.
 - ❖ Students must return library books before going on vacation.
 - ❖ Magazines, newspapers, booklets, and reference books should not be taken out of the library.
 - ❖ When students receive books from the librarian, they should check for any damage. If any damage is found, it should be reported immediately.

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- ❖ If a book is lost, the student must pay its current price and a fine decided by the college authorities.
 - ❖ Belongings such as bags, notebooks, mobile phones and helmets are not allowed inside the library.

HOSTEL

- ❖ The college has fully furnished hostels for boys and girls for a holistic living experience. In addition to well-equipped gyms for physical fitness, students have access to playgrounds and indoor gaming facilities, promoting a balanced lifestyle.

HOSTEL MANAGEMENT

- ❖ The following officers constitute the Hostel Administration Committee (HAC):
 - a. The Warden
 - b. The Deputy Wardens
 - c. Assistant Deputy Wardens
 - d. Residential Wardens
- ❖ Each hostel is managed by the Deputy Wardens / Assistant Wardens / Residential Wardens who are regular faculty of the College.
- ❖ The students can approach any of the above officers for help, guidance and grievance redressal. Representations to higher officers must be forwarded through proper channel.

ACCOMMODATION

- ❖ Hostel accommodation is available to the Students only during working semesters. During vacations, if needed a stay to complete a course work, students may avail it on additional fee.

CONDITIONS OF ALLOTMENT

- ❖ At the time of admission of a student into the hostel and at the beginning of every academic year, each resident is required to submit a duly completed Personal Data Form. The telephone number of the parent or local guardian must be provided. Any change of address / telephone number of the parent / local guardian, at any point of time, has to be intimated immediately to the hostel office in writing.
- ❖ Rooms once allotted to the students for an academic year will not be changed except on special circumstances.

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- ❖ The students are entitled for accommodation in the hostel as long as they are full time registered students. Accommodation will not be provided to any student whose registration is cancelled. Any student who is removed from the Roll of College will automatically cease to be a member of the hostel.
 - ❖ The inmates are responsible for the electrical installations, furniture etc. Fine will be imposed for any damages.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- ❖ All the students are expected to behave courteously and fairly with everyone.
 - ❖ All Students are required to carry their valid Identity Cards issued to them by the Institution.
 - ❖ The rooms, common areas and surroundings should be kept clean and hygienic. Avoid pasting notices on walls and refrain from scribbling on them.
 - ❖ **All the students are expected to be in the hostel before 6.30 p.m. If any student wishes to be away from the hostel during the weekend, holidays or any other time, he / she has to get prior permission from the Warden or the Residential Warden.**
 - ❖ Leaving the hostel without proper permission will lead to expulsion from the hostel.
 - ❖ Room allotted to each student is his / her personal responsibility. He/she should see to the upkeep of his / her room, hostel and its environment. Students should bring to the notice of the maintenance office, through the Warden, for all routine maintenance works (Civil, Carpentry and Electrical), if any, to be carried out in their rooms.
 - ❖ The students should not screen pirated / unauthorized / unlicensed movies in their computers and common rooms. Any violation will be dealt severely. Punishment for the same will be decided by authorities.
 - ❖ The resident shall not move any furniture from its allotted place.
 - ❖ The resident shall not remove any fittings from any other room and get them fitted in his/her room.
 - ❖ Ragging is totally banned. Any violation of this by the students will be dealt with very severely as per the law.
 - ❖ **Smoking and consumption of alcoholic drinks and / or narcotic drugs in the hostel and college premises is strictly prohibited. Students shall not enter the hostel and college premises in intoxicated state and should not possess such materials. Severe action will be taken if any resident is found to violate this, resulting in expulsion from hostels and suspension from the Institution. Hostel zone is a smoke-free zone in the Institution. Students should not smoke inside the hostel / room / common room / dining hall / toilets / corridors / terrace etc. Depending on the case, the management reserves the right to take direct disciplinary action, amounting to even expulsion at short notice from the hostel.**
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- ❖ Entertaining unauthorized guests will lead to severe punishment including expulsion from the hostel.
- ❖ All visitors to the hostel including the parents / guardians will have to make necessary entries in the visitor's book available at the hostel entrance.
- ❖ The visit of male students to the girls hostel and vice-versa is restricted.
- ❖ The uses of audio systems which may cause inconvenience to other occupants are not allowed. The use of personal TV, VCR and VCD / DVD is prohibited. The students should not hire objectionable CDs from outside.
- ❖ When the students go out of their room they should switch off all the electrical / electronic appliances, and keep it locked at all times. Violation will attract suitable penalty and punishment as decided by authorities.
- ❖ Students should not arrange any functions or meeting within the hostel or outside or within the Institution / college premises without permission of the concerned authorities.
- ❖ Students should not arrange for any picnic outside without the permission of the concerned authorities.
- ❖ The residents of the hostel are responsible for the safe keeping of their personal belongings. They are advised to use locks to safeguard all valuable items such as Laptop, Mobile Phone, Cash etc., even when they are out for a short period.
- ❖ Students are asked to adhere to the timings for mess and follow the designated meal schedule :

BREAKFAST	07.00 am	to	08.45 am
LUNCH	12.00 pm	to	02.30 pm
TEA TIME	04.30 pm	to	06.30 pm
DINNER	07.00 pm	to	08.45 pm

- ❖ Maintain hygiene by washing hands, disposing waste properly, and following cleanliness protocols in the mess area.
- ❖ Cooking with electric stoves in residential rooms is strictly prohibited; violating the rule will lead to severe punishment.
- ❖ It is the duty of the students to take utmost care of their valuables.

The declaration form attached in the Calendar (Page No: 63) must be submitted to the Head of the Department, duly signed by both the Student and the Parent.

EXAMINATION

The examination system is structured to evaluate students comprehensively through both Internal Continuous Assessment (CIA) and External Examination (CE) components for each course. Typically, each course includes two Internal Examinations with defined assessment patterns, followed by one External Examination. The passing minimum for Undergraduate (UG) courses is set at 40%, while for Postgraduate (PG) courses, it is 50%. Additionally, some subjects may solely rely on Internal Assessment for grading.

To earn an Undergraduate Degree, students must accumulate a minimum of 140+10 credits, while for Postgraduate studies, 90 + 8 additional credits are required. This system ensures a thorough and structured approach to assess students' academic progress and achievements across various levels of study.

ATTENDANCE REGULATIONS (UG & PG) FOR APPEARING EXTERNAL EXAMINATION (SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS)

PROFORMA I: The candidates those who have secured 75% attendance of 90 working days or above in the current semester (both practical and theory) are eligible to appear for semester examinations.

PROFORMA II:

The candidates who secure attendance between 65% and 74% (inclusive) in the current semester are eligible to appear for the semester examinations, if the shortfall condoned by the Principal (**only under valid medical grounds - Maximum 9 days only**) by paying the condonation fee.

PROFORMA III:

The candidates who secure attendance between 50% and 64% (inclusive) in the current semester are **not eligible** to appear for the current semester examinations. However, they are eligible to appear for arrear examinations (if any), and permitted to continue their studies in the next semester, provided this is their first instance. Otherwise, candidates must discontinue the course and re-join in the same semester the following year with proper approval from Bharathiar University.

PROFORMA IV:

The candidates who secure attendance below 50% must discontinue the course and they are **not eligible** to appear for the current semester examinations but are eligible to appear for arrear examinations (if any), they can re-join in the same semester next academic year with proper approval from Bharathiar University.

PROFORMA V:

The candidates who secured attendance between 50% and 64% in the previous semester and have secured a combined attendance of 70% or more by averaging the attendance earned in the current and previous semesters are eligible to take previous semester subjects along with the current semester subjects.

NORMS FOR THE CONDUCT OF SPECIAL COMPREHENSIVE SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS

ELIGIBILITY:

- ❖ NSS / NCC students representing NSS / NCC activities of the College / University / State / Central government, as well as participating in NCC / NSS special camps.
- ❖ The Sports student should have represented our college team during the academic year and participated in University / State / National or International Sports Events.
- ❖ Students involved in special internships, placements, and training, as well as professional examinations conducted by recognized Board / State / Central Government.

GUIDELINES:

- ❖ If the students are unable to attend the scheduled Comprehensive Semester Examinations due to participation in the above-mentioned activities / events, a Special Examination will be conducted with the approval of examination committee for the respective regular Comprehensive Semester Examination courses within 20 days from the last date of the Comprehensive Semester Examination scheduled by the COE.
- ❖ The eligible students should submit a proper requisition letter to the Principal within 15 days after the release of the Comprehensive Semester Examination Timetable, along with proper document/records to prove that they have activities /events on the day of the examination forwarded by the Physical Director / Coach / NSS Programme Officer / NCC Officer / Placement Officer / Training and Internship Coordinator and the Head of the Department. Last minute intimation will not be entertained.
- ❖ Special Examinations will be considered only for current semester theory courses [First Attempt].
- ❖ No special examination will be conducted for arrear papers.
- ❖ Students should have paid Tuition Fees and Examination Fees on time as given in the college calendar.
- ❖ It is the sole responsibility of the students to visit the college website for the Comprehensive Semester Examination Time Table. No special intimation will be given to the students by the college authorities.
- ❖ If any student fails to appear for the Special Comprehensive Semester Examination Scheduled by the COE, it will be marked as "Absent" and no re-examination request will be considered there after.
- ❖ No special examination will be conducted for the students those who have completed their course period.
- ❖ The students are asked to abide by the other rules and regulations of the Comprehensive Semester Examinations of the College.

EXAMINATION MALPRACTICE & PUNISHMENT (UG & PG)

- ❖ Punishment for malpractice committed during Continuous Internal Assessment Examinations and Comprehensive Examinations:

Disciplinary actions will be taken against the students found guilty of engaging in malpractice during CIA & CE exams, which will lead to award of Zero marks for the respective paper / cancellation of entire semester examinations.

TRANSPORT
