Introducing SensorHubb: Predictive Sensor Intelligence, Now Connected to FMX

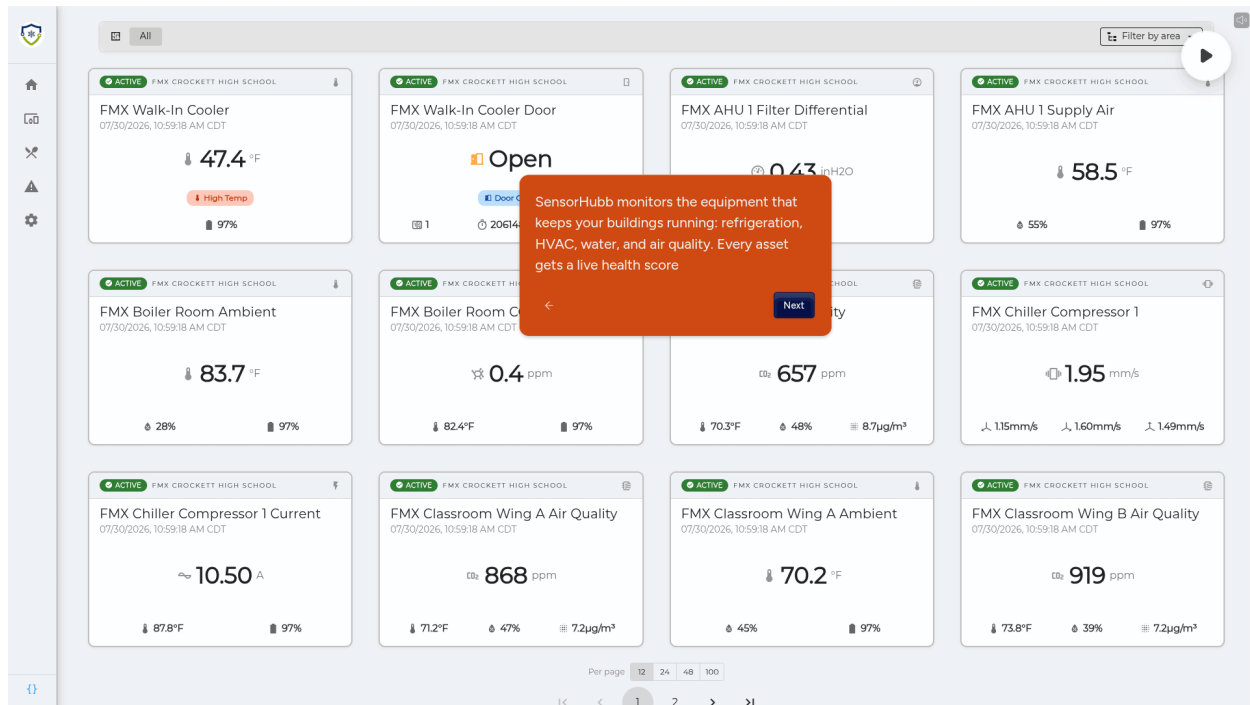
We're excited to welcome SensorHubb as a FMX solution partner. SensorHubb is an AI-driven sensor intelligence platform, and they've built an integration that connects their system to FMX so your team can catch equipment problems before they turn into emergencies.

Here's how it works: SensorHubb monitors the equipment you count on every day (refrigeration, HVAC, water systems, air quality, and more) and learns what normal looks like for each unit. When something starts to drift, like a cooler recovering too slowly or a compressor short-cycling, SensorHubb flags it and sends an alert into FMX, creating a work order automatically. Close the ticket in FMX and the alert clears in SensorHubb, so both systems stay in sync.

For your team, that means planned maintenance instead of emergency repairs. Rather than scrambling after a freezer fails overnight, you get an early warning while there's

still time to schedule the repair, protect what's inside, and skip the after-hours call.

For school nutrition teams, there's a second benefit. Temperature records for every cooler, freezer, and milk case are captured continuously and automatically, which means HACCP and USDA Child Nutrition documentation builds itself. No clipboards, no missed checks, and no gaps to explain at inspection.
