What do we do?

WorkSHOP is a project that supports people to gain skills, confidence and work experience within a structured and sheltered work environment.



How much, when & where?

Cost: Approved day service rates (CBMDC).

When: Wednesdays 10:00 -3pm

Where: The Second Time Around Charity Shop in Keighley.

Who is it for?

It has been developed for people who are not ready to work independently and require more tailored support to partake in work activities.



Participants work in a group setting under supervision. They receive direct support from skilled staff.

What will I learn?
