We are really pleased to be able to offer our FREE school uniform swap shop again this August. The scheme provides free (used) school uniforms for families who are struggling to buy new uniforms for their children – a situation that is increasingly affecting both non-working and working families. We also re-cycle unwanted/unusable items to reduce textiles going to landfill.

The stall will once again be manned by our lovely volunteers Cath and Lindsay.

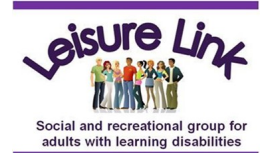
