## RSA Legal Defense Alert!!

Always consult with an association representative/lawyer before responding to any report, letter, memo and/or questions concerning an investigation that could possibly lead to punitive action. If ordered to do so, ask to have it recorded and read the following: Non-waiver statement:

"I have been refused the right to have a representative of my choice. I understand that I am being ordered to make a report or answer questions and that, if I do not comply with the order, I may be disciplined for insubordination.

Therefore, I have no alternative but to abide by the order. However, by so doing, I do not waive my constitutional rights to remain silent under the 5th and 14th amendments to the United States Constitution and under the protections afforded me under state law."

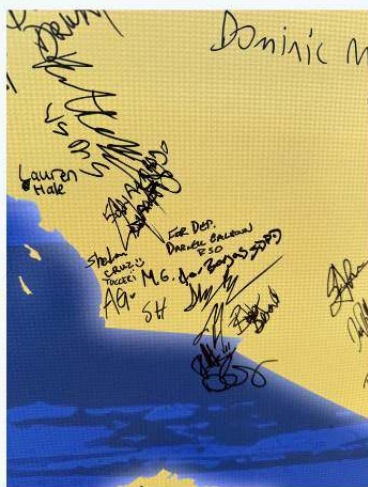

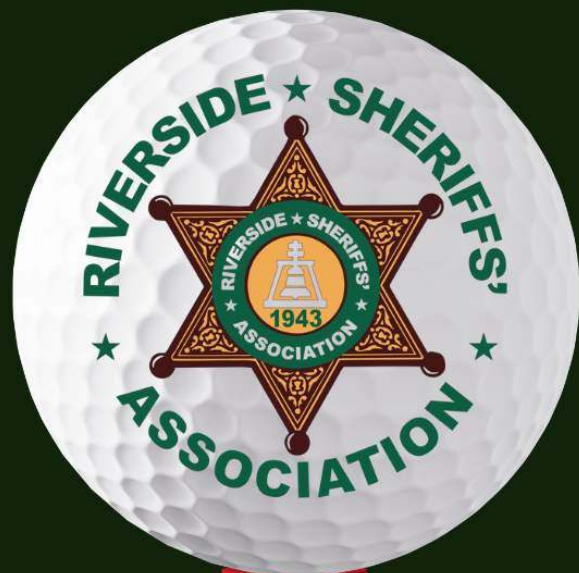

# Fiscal Restraints Triggering The End Of Bills

## The Impact Of The Massive Budget Deficit

**A**s reported last month, many of the bills we opposed this year (and many we supported) met their fate as the deadline for bills to pass their policy committee arrived at the end of April while others advanced to their respective “appropriations” committees for further consideration.

The appropriations committees generally focus on the anticipated state costs associated with each legislative proposal. For example, bills that seek to increase the criminal sentences for dealing fentanyl or committing retail theft are evaluated not based on whether the underlying policy should be advanced, but rather on potential costs to the states (and counties) for housing convicted offenders longer than is currently permitted.

Using recent figures as guidelines, the committee will approximate the number of these offenders currently incarcerated and the average length of their time behind bars. If the committee determines there are, let's say, 1,000 offenders convicted each year for such offenses and a bill would increase time served by 3

years, the math is pretty straightforward, with an average cost of a state inmate at around \$130,000 per year.

1,000 inmates x 3 years x \$130,000 per year = \$390 million estimated annual cost for the bill. These estimated numbers are not necessarily reflective of the actual costs, but are provided for illustrative purposes. Such potentially high costs for the state to incur at a time when it is trying to resolve a budget deficit in the range of \$40-70 billion is a non-starter for these fiscally-focused committees. As a result, unless a costly bill is a top policy priority of the legislature or the governor, it will

likely be held in the appropriations committee and fail passage for the year.

On the plus side, the fiscal restraints that accompany a massive budget deficit triggering the death of many good public safety related bills also resulted in numerous bad bills being held in committee and being defeated.

It's somewhat ironic that state budget deficits can actually have some positive benefits for those who advocate for public safety. Although bills that seek to better hold offenders accountable for actions tend to die, so do the proposals that seek to spend more public dollars coddling criminals.

**SOME BAD BILLS RECENTLY DEFEATED**

**AB 2354 BONTA** - would have allowed felons convicted of any violent offense to be able to seek resentencing if they claim they had ever been a victim of human trafficking, sexual abuse or domestic violence.

**AB 2280 JONES-SAWYER** - would have required confidential jail phone calls to be made available to all inmates each month.

**SB 912 WIENER** - would have banned the use of presumptive “color-metric” field tests used to determine if a suspected drug or chemical contains a controlled substance.

**SB 1012 WIENER** - would have decriminalized certain psychedelics, including magic mushrooms, ayahuasca, mescaline and ecstasy if used for “therapeutic” purposes, without any medical or mental health diagnosis required. Medical screening and oversight during its use were also not required.

**BAD BILLS AMENDED**

**SB 1253 GONZALEZ** - required annual firearms safety certificate for each firearm owned and required everyone, including peace officers, to pay for and complete specified firearms safety training each year. The bill now requires a firearms safety certificate whenever a person moves into California with a firearm.

**AB 2042 JACKSON** - as introduced, the bill restricted the lawful use of police K9s and banned their use in assisting in

the arrest and apprehension of suspects. The bill has since been amended to now require POST to develop regulations on the use of police K9s.

**AB 2709 BONTA** - is another attempt to codify a “right” for inmates to have prison and jail visits, regardless of their violent or dangerous behavior. However, as recently amended, the bill no longer applies to county jails.

**OTHER BILLS OF NOTE**

**SB 1264 GROVE** - exempts law enforcement employees performing certain functions and sworn staff from current employment discrimination protections related to off-duty cannabis use.

**AB 2441 KALRA** - eliminates current mandated reporting to law enforce-

ment when a pupil attacks a teacher or other school employee. The bill also makes it no longer a crime for students to disrupt or interfere with any school proceeding, including school board meetings, mandatory school testing, sporting events, etc.

**AB 3127 MCKINNOR** - eliminates current mandated reporting to law enforcement by medical personnel when they treat patients suffering from sexual assault, domestic and other types of violent attacks. Unfortunately, this bill already passed the Assembly and awaits action in the Senate.

**AB 1874 SANCHEZ** - changes penalty from misdemeanor to wobbler for a second or subsequent offense of secretly recording a minor in full or partial undress without consent.

**AB 2168 KALRA** - requires dismissal of misdemeanor and infraction charges against a person currently imprisoned for a felony.

**AB 2365 HANEY** - prohibits the sale of “kratom” to persons under 21 and requires manufacturing quality control measures to be implemented.

**AB 2419 GIPSON** - permits search warrants to issue for child prostitution cases.

**AB 1996 ALANIS** - naloxone training for entertainment venues and amusement parks.

**AB 1892 FLORA** - permits wiretapping in child porn cases

**AB 2645 LACKEY** - sharing electronic toll collection information with law enforcement

**AB 3241 PACHECO** - law enforcement-backed bill on the use of police canines; this bill is “joined” with now-amended AB 2042 (Jackson) SB 1502 Ashby and AB 3029 (Bains) - classifying xylazine (tranq) as a Schedule III drug and mandates certain reporting and storage requirements

**THEFT/RETAIL THEFT BILLS**

**AB 1802 JONES-SAWYER** - removes sunset of organized retail theft laws.

**AB 1794 MCCARTY** - increases available sentence enhancements for theft crimes.

**AB 1960 SORIA** - sentencing enhancement for cumulative property theft

**AB 2943 ZBUR** - permits warrantless arrests by peace officers for misdemeanor shoplifting, creates new theft-type crime to avoid Prop. 47 restrictions, permits aggregation of thefts for felony grand theft, increases probation terms for petty theft/shoplifting, etc.

**SB 905 WIENER** - improves ability of DAs to secure convictions for car burglaries

**AB 1990 W CAR-RILLO** - allows warrantless by peace officers of suspected misdemeanor shoplifters

**SB 982 WAHAB** - deletes sunset of current organized retail theft crime law

**SB 1416 NEWMAN** - creates additional sentencing enhancements for large thefts

These and all other bills must now pass their “house of origin” - meaning bills introduced in the Assembly must pass the Assembly floor and Senate bills must pass the Senate floor - before May 25th or they will fail passage for the year.

# The California Assembly Committee On Insurance Approved AB1870

## Additional Requirements For Posting Legal Rights

**T**he Assembly Committee on Insurance has now approved AB1870 by Assembly member Liz Ortega. Once approved by the Assembly it moves to the State Senate, and with their approval it goes to the Governor for his signature. AB1870 establishes a clear mandate that the employer post additional information regarding the employee's right for legal representation. If the employer does not follow the proper procedures to educate the employee by posting the rights for treatment, other benefits, and the added rights for legal representation, it will result in a misdemeanor.

Currently L.C. §3550 states:

- 1) How to obtain emergency medical treatment, if needed.
- 2) The kinds of events, injuries and illnesses covered by workers' compensation.
- 3) The injured employee's right to receive medical care.

AB1870 adds to L.C. §3550 as follows:

- 4) The injured employee may consult with a licensed attorney to advise them of their rights under workers' compensation laws. In some instances attorney fees may be paid from an injured employee's recovery.

Continuing with L.C. §3550:

- 5) The rights of the employee to select and change the treating physician pursuant to provisions of L.C. §4600.
- 6) The rights of the employee to receive temporary disability indemnity, permanent disability indemnity, supplemental job displacement and death benefits as appropriate.
- 7) To whom injuries should be reported.
- 8) The existence of time limits for the employer to be notified of an occupational injury.
- 9) The protections against discrimination provided pursuant to L.C. section 132a.
- 10) The internet website address and contact information that employees may use to obtain further information about the workers' compensation claims process and an injured employees' rights and obligations, including the location and telephone number of the nearest Information and Assistance Officer (through the WCAB).

YOUR RIGHT TO BE INFORMED

A significant element of the current L.C. §3550 is section (e) which states if the employer fails to provide proper notices the employee is permitted to be treated by their personal physician during the failure of not providing notice. This could be a short window but it does allow for treatment.

Labor Code §3550 and the update by AB1870 provide a more complete opportunity for the injured worker to be cured or relieved from the job related injury. Labor Code §3550 states that the information in L.C. §3550 must be “posted and keep in a conspicuous location frequented by employees, and where the notice may (be) easily read by employees during the hours of the work day”. “Failure to keep any notice required by the State shall constitute a misdemeanor.”

The mandate by the current L.C. §3550 and the update made by AB1870 removes some of the restraint and guilt some employers place on the injured worker’s opportunity to receive medical care to cure or relieve the effects of the job related injury. ★

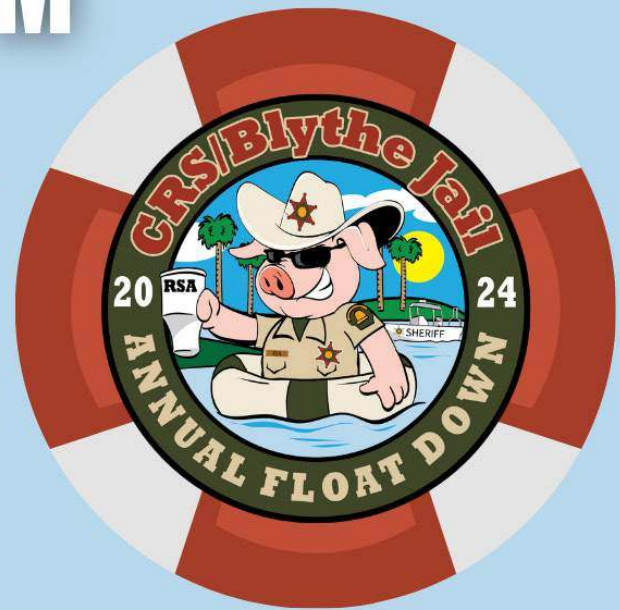
