- If you become a legal guardian, adopt a child, or become legally separated, contact the Benefits Office at (951) 653-8014 within 30 days of the event.
- To ensure coverage, please respect these deadlines. Remember that the department does not notify the Benefit Trust of these changes.
- Please notify the Benefits Office of any changes in your address.
- Please provide dependent substantiation documents to the Benefits Office when requested to avoid cancellation of your dependent's coverage.

RSA Legal Defense Alert!!

Always consult with an association representative/lawyer before responding to any report, letter, memo and/or questions concerning an investigation that could possibly lead to punitive action. If ordered to do so, ask to have it recorded and read the following: Non-waiver statement:

"I have been refused the right to have a representative of my choice. I understand that I am being ordered to make a report or answer questions and that, if I do not comply with the order, I may be disciplined for insubordination. Therefore, I have no alternative but to abide by the order. However, by so doing, I do not waive my constitutional rights to remain silent under the 5th and 14th amendments to the United States Constitution and under the protections afforded me under state law."

Signs of Burnout

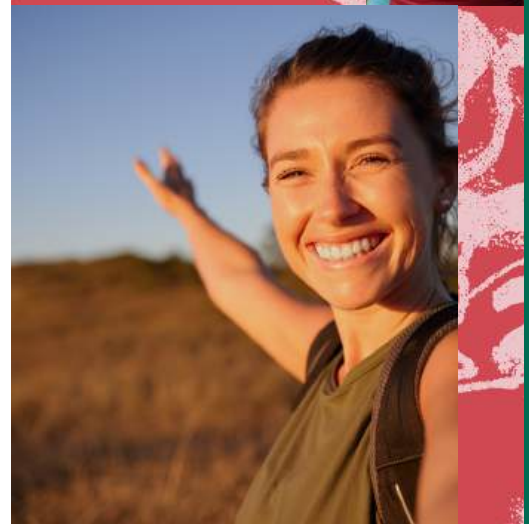
- Feeling emotionally or physically exhausted

- Lack of exercise, socializing, and participating in hobbies
- Frequent headaches and muscle tension

- **Ask for Help:** Lean on your support system to feel less alone
- **Move Your Body:** Even 10 minutes can reduce stress and boost mood
- **Practice Mindfulness:** Quiet moments can help calm the nervous system
- **Prioritize Rest:** Sleep and downtime support recovery
- **Make Time for Connection:** Spend time with people and activities that recharge you
- **Consider Therapy or Coaching:** Professional support can strengthen coping skills
- **Take Breaks:** Time off helps restore work-life balance

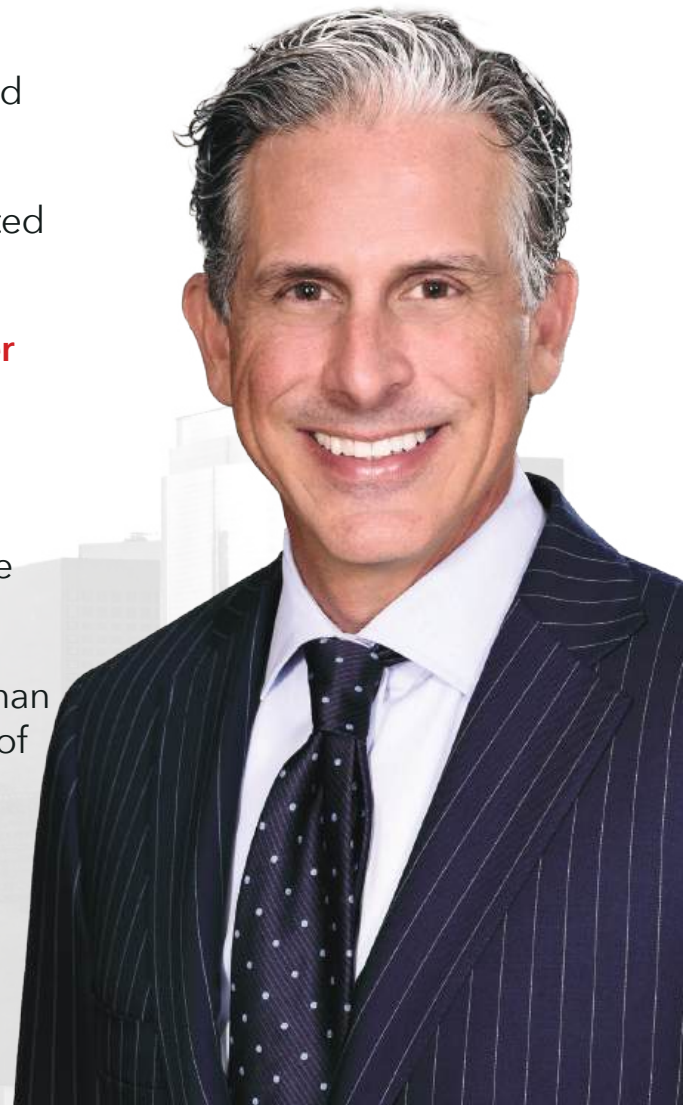

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THE LEGISLATURE'S FINAL SPRINT 2025-2026

The legislature recessed for its month-long summer break and during that time, as the saying goes, your wallet and your freedom were safe. However, upon returning to Sacramento on August 3, the legislative Appropriations committees for each house held hearings on their respective “suspense file” where they dispensed with over 800 bills in a single day. The bills that were approved during this process join the a

couple hundred others for final consideration on the floor by August 31. Those that advance will be sent to the governor’s office and a wait his signature or veto.

These are just some of the more than 100 bills we are continuing to advocate for -or against- during the last month of the 2025-2026 legislative session, including any last minute “gut-and-amend” bills related to public safety or law enforcement that may pop up before the legislature adjourns on August 31. We will provide a complete update on the final action by the Senate and Assembly next month. Until then, be safe.

Chef's Corner



Grilled Chile-Lime Corn



Cook Time: 00 Minutes



Prep: 20 Minutes



Serves: 4 - 6

Ingredients:

- 4 Ears of Corn
- 4 Tbsp Butter, softened
- 1 Lime
- 1 Tsp Chili Powder
- ½ Tsp Smoked Paprika
- ¼ Tsp Salt
- 1 Tbsp Chopped Cilantro
- Optional: Cotija Cheese

Instructions:

- **Step 1: Prep the Ingredients:**
 - Juice and zest one lime
 - Chop cilantro
- **Step 2: Make the Butter:**
 - Mix the softened butter, juice and zest of one lime, chili powder, paprika, salt, and cilantro.
- **Step 3: Grill Corn:**
 - Brush corn lightly with oil.
 - Grill over medium-heat for 10-15 minutes, turning every few minutes until tender and lightly charred.
- **Step 4: Add Butter:**
 - Brush hot corn generously with the premade chili-lime butter.
- **Step 5: Finish:**
 - Sprinkle with cotija cheese and extra chili powder,
 - Serve with lime wedges.
 - **Tip:** Add a little cayenne if you like it spicy

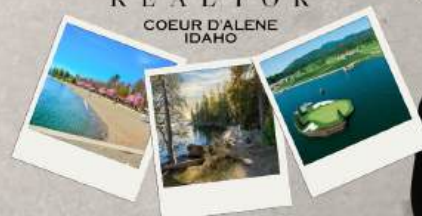

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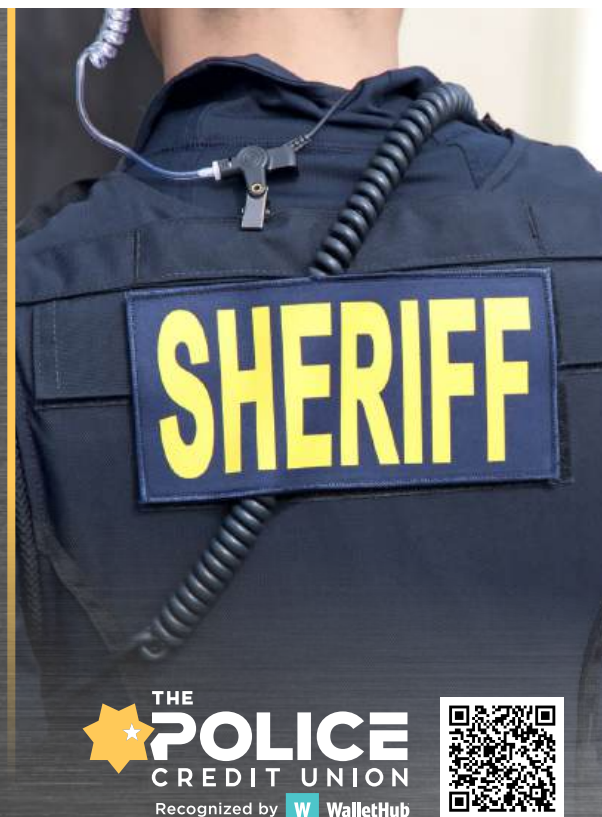
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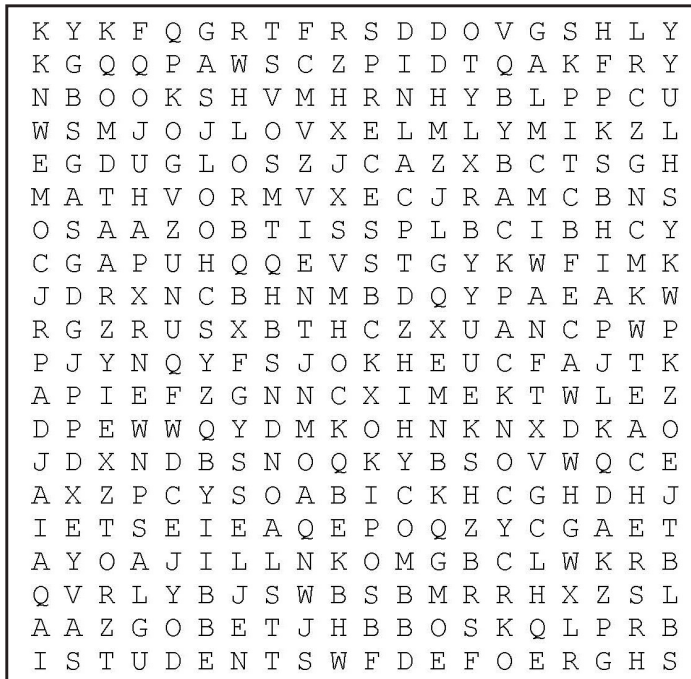
