

Information pursuant to Article 13 EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

We, Quest One GmbH, inform you about the processing of your personal data:

Responsible body and contact details of the data protection officer

The responsible body pursuant to data protection laws, in particular the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), is Quest One GmbH, Alois Senefelder Allee 1, 86153 Augsburg.

Categories of personal data

We process your name, job title, company details as well as your email.

Further, we process photo/video recordings which we create and collect during our information events. Insofar as photo/video or audio recordings give indications of your ethnic origin, religion or health (e.g. skin colour, head covering, glasses), we also process these.

We also store your consent declaration.

Purposes of data processing

If you register for the event, we process your personal data to manage your registration, communicate event details, coordinate access, and conduct the event.

If you give your consent during event registration, we may capture and process photo and video recordings of you. These recordings are used for marketing and public relations purposes (e.g., website, social media and promotional materials). The rights to the photos, videos, and audio recordings are granted without compensation and include the right to archive and edit them, provided that such editing does not distort the content or purpose of the recording.

We process your name and first name, as well as your email address to be able to identify you for future requests, e.g. the exercise of data subject rights. The storage of your consent declaration serves verification and documentation purposes.

Legal basis for data processing

We process personal data pursuant to Article 4 GDPR in accordance with the provisions of the EU General Data Protection Regulation and the Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG-new).

The processing of your contact data during the registration and the creation and publication of photo/video recordings takes place within the framework of your consent (Article 6 (1) (a) GDPR), which you may withdraw at any time.

The storage of the consent declaration takes place for the fulfillment of legal obligations pursuant to Article 6 (1) (c), Article 5 (2), Article 7 (1) GDPR.

Recipients and transfer of data

If we publish photo/video recordings on social media channels, the data are transmitted there and also processed by the operators of the social media platforms. We cannot influence how these operators handle your data; you may view the respective information of these third-party providers here:

When posted online, photos and/or videos can be accessed and saved worldwide. Such data can therefore also be found via so-called “search engines.” It cannot be ruled out that other individuals or companies may alter these photos and/or videos, use them for other purposes, or link them to other data available online to create a personal profile. Moreover, the data can often still be accessed via the archive function of search engines, even if they have already been removed from or modified on the aforementioned websites. Where publication takes place on social media channels, the data may also be processed outside the European Union, in particular in countries which may not provide a level of data protection equivalent to that in the European Union. Storage duration

We store the personal data provided during registration for as long as necessary to organize and conduct the event, as well as to fulfill post-event follow-ups. Thereafter, your data will be deleted, unless statutory retention obligations (e.g., under tax or commercial law) require longer storage.

The photo/video or audio recordings are stored indefinitely, as this is the only way to achieve permanent documentation of our activities. The image material will be deleted if consent should be withdrawn.

The consent declarations will be stored as long as they are necessary for proof of consent, e.g. also after withdrawal for video recordings.

Your rights

Using the contact details given above, you may at any time exercise the following rights:

- Information about the data stored with us and their processing,

- Correction of inaccurate personal data,
- Erasure of the data stored with us,
- Restriction of data processing, insofar as we may not yet delete the data due to legal obligations,
- Objection to the processing of the data with us,
- Data portability

If you have given consent that we may process your personal data, you may withdraw the consent at any time with effect for the future. The withdrawal does not affect the legality of the data processing that took place based on the consent in the period up to the withdrawal. The withdrawal may generally be submitted without a specific form. However, for verification purposes, we request that you submit the withdrawal by post or email to the contact details given at the beginning of this information sheet, please use the subject "Withdrawal of consent".

You may at any time lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

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
