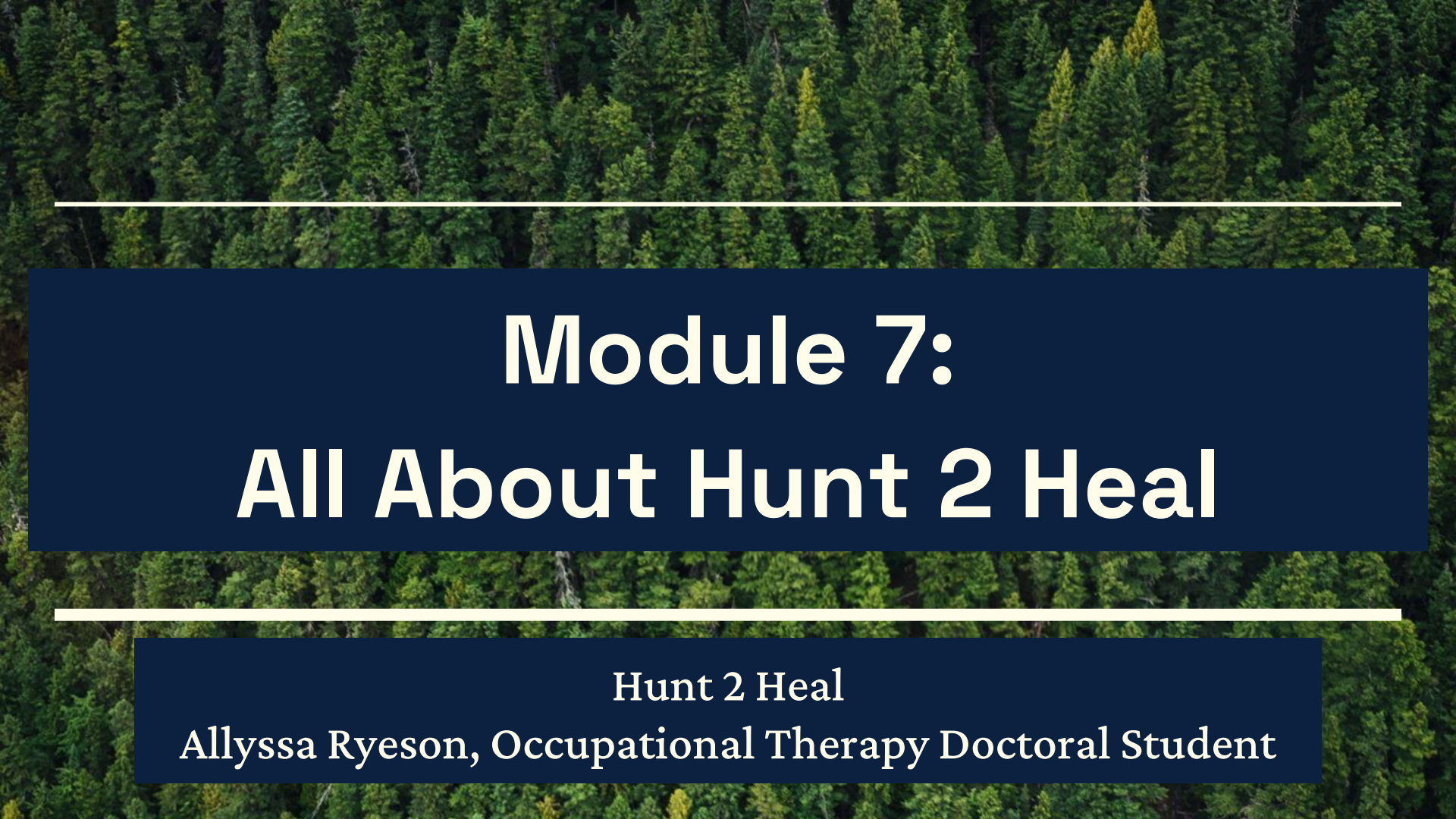

Rules & Considerations

Stay on designated trails ONLY – Land management staff, alongside dedicated volunteers, work tirelessly to preserve and enhance habitats, ensuring optimal results for participants. Please do your part to help maintain these efforts.

ATVs on Trails: Respect the trails, adhere to the 15 MPH speed limit, and operate vehicles with care. No recklessness!

Gate at front of property must remain closed while participants are hunting. Hiking is strictly prohibited while hunting takes place.

Main Objective: Have fun & be safe while respecting the land and others around you!

640 acres of accessible land.



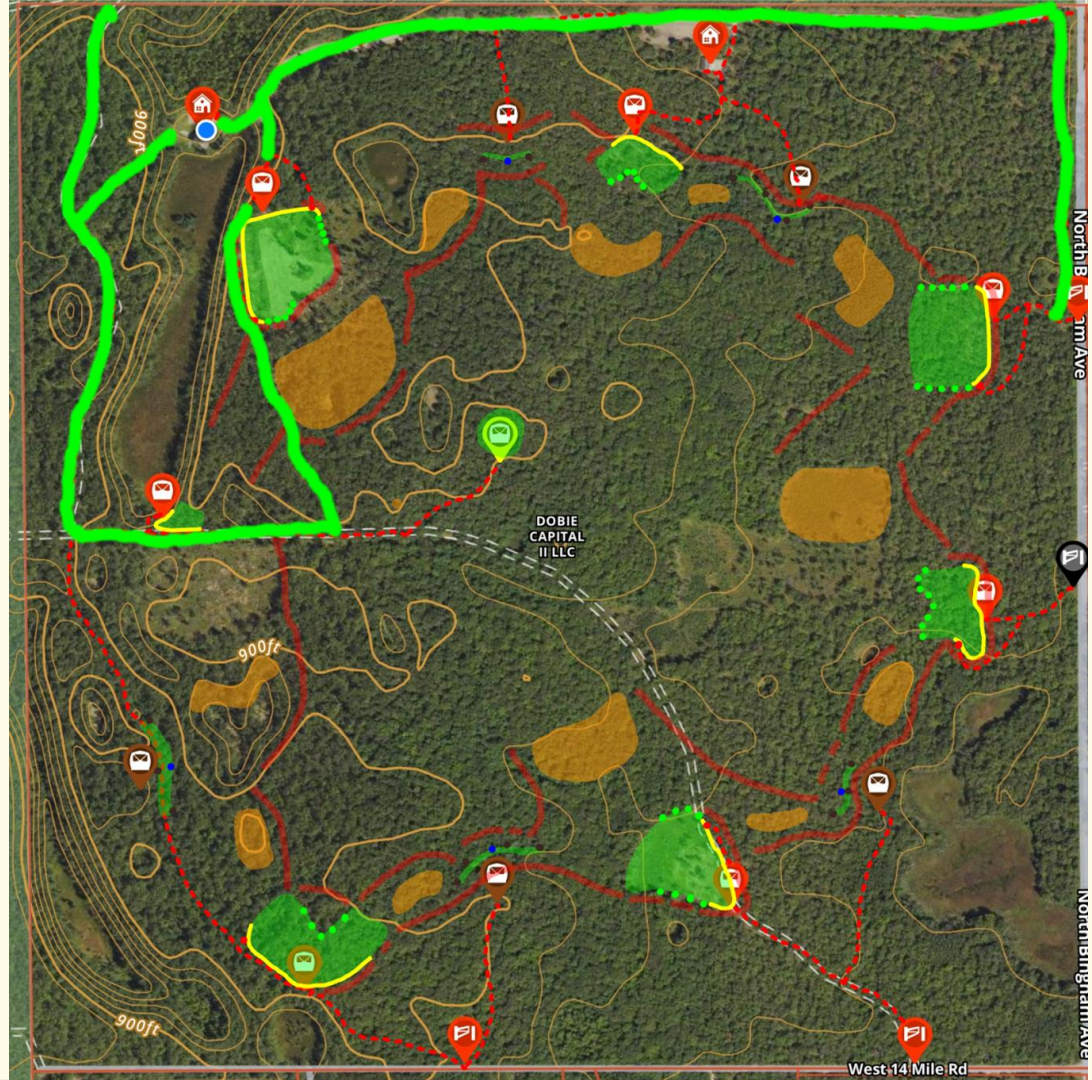
The following slide includes a map of the H2H property & lodge. The green line indicates trails. The lodge & blinds are also labeled.
