Our dock, fleet, and day-of flow are organized around camp bookings — from 15 campers up to 100+.

✦ Structured Rotation

Tubing for the full group, with optional wakeboard and surf rotations on the 24ft for advanced campers — every camper gets equal time on the water.

▲ Lakeside Meals at The Beacon

We coordinate large-group meals through The Beacon Restaurant on the water. Standard restaurant menu — talk to us about your group's needs and we'll see what we can arrange.



SAFETY ON THE WATER

Trained drivers on every boat. USCG-approved life vests sized for kids, in-boat safety briefings before every session, and counselors stay with their groups throughout.

ONE IN FLEET

24ft Wake Boat

Wakeboarding & surfing · intermediate to advanced — our flagship boat throws the cleanest wake for campers ready to step up.



TWO IN FLEET

22ft Wake Boats

Tubing & wakeboarding · all levels — workhorses of the fleet, sized right for the bulk of camp rotations.



ONE IN FLEET

Sport Tritoon

Tubing & lake cruising · all levels — open-deck pontoon for relaxed rides with tube rotations.



TWO ON REQUEST

Bow Riders

Tubing & transport · all levels — smaller, nimble boats for breakout groups or shuttle runs.

Straightforward rates, a clear two-hour rhythm, and a short list of policies that keep group days running smoothly.

Pricing & Booking

PRICING

Camp rates, *built around your group.*

Pricing is based on group size, session length, and boats deployed. Reach out with your numbers and we'll send back a firm quote within one business day.

MIN **2-hour minimum.** One-hour sessions aren't offered — there isn't enough time on the water for groups this size.

DRIVER **Trained driver included** on every boat. Gratuity is customary and appreciated.

HOLD **Dates are confirmed once payment is received** — we recommend booking early as peak weeks fill quickly.

The Day on the Water



A 2-hour session typically runs **5–6 rotations per boat**. On tubing boats, each camper gets **roughly 4–5 minutes of ride time**. Advanced campers on the 24ft can rotate through wakeboarding or surfing instead. Drivers rotate riders quickly while the rest of the group cheers from the deck — the energy stays high, no one sits out.

Camp Policies — Please Read Before Booking

- Mon–Thurs only.** Camp bookings are not offered Friday through Sunday.

- Arrive ready for the water.** We recommend campers come in swimwear with a towel and change of clothes — it keeps the day moving and maximizes time on the lake.

- No outside food, please** — water bottles and medically necessary snacks are always welcome. Group meals are coordinated through The Beacon.

- Buses welcome on-property.** We're set up to receive coach buses directly at the dock — no off-site shuttle needed.

- Counselors stay on-site.** Camp staff remain with their group for the full session — we're not set up for drop-off.

- Dietary needs.** Standard restaurant menu via The Beacon. Talk to us in advance about specifics and we'll see what we can arrange.

Common Questions & Next Steps

The questions camp directors ask most, two great spots to pair with a tubing session, and how to reach us.

What if it rains?

Light rain — we run as planned. Thunder, lightning, or unsafe conditions — we reschedule at no cost.

What if a camper doesn't want to participate?

No pressure — they stay on the boat with their group. Many end up joining in after watching their friends.

How many campers ride at once?

One tube per boat — typically two campers riding at a time. Wakeboard or surf rotations are one rider at a time.

Is there shade for kids waiting their turn?

Most waiting time is on the boat, where bimini tops and the cabin provide shade. Dock seating is covered.

What's the youngest camper you'll take tubing?

Age 6 and up, comfortable in a life vest. Younger or hesitant campers can ride along on the boat.

Do campers need to know how to swim?

All riders wear USCG-approved life vests. Comfort in the water helps; strong swimming isn't required.

Where do campers and counselors use the bathroom?

On-site facilities at the dock, with additional restrooms next door at The Beacon Restaurant.

What should counselors bring?

Sunscreen, towels, water bottles, and any camper medications. We provide all life vests and equipment.

BEFORE / AFTER

1.4 mi · 260 Lakeside Blvd, Landing, NJ

Swimming with lifeguards (Memorial Day–Labor Day), picnic areas with grills, courts, playground, small historical museum.

Modest weekday entry fee for cars; bus rate higher — see park website for current pricing.

Liffy Island

BEFORE / AFTER

0.6 mi · just north on New Jersey Avenue

Free public preserve. Tennis & basketball courts, open sports fields, scenic hiking trail, walk-through avian bird sanctuary.

Free public access — no entry fee, no reservation needed

BOOKING INQUIRY

Lock in your camp's date.

Peak weeks (late June – early August) fill quickly. Include camp name, group size, preferred dates, and dietary needs — we'll come back with availability and a firm quote within one business day.
