### 1. Introduction

---

Welcome to the Elaqt Law website ("Website"). Elaqt Law ("we", "us", or "our") is a law firm committed to protecting the privacy of all visitors who access our services online. This Privacy Policy explains what personal data we collect, how we use it, and the rights you have with respect to that data.

### 3. Information We Collect

---

We collect two categories of data:

#### 3.1 Information You Provide Directly

When you contact us, submit an inquiry, or book a consultation, you may provide:

- Full name
- Email address and phone number
- Subject matter of your legal inquiry
- Any other information you choose to include in your message

#### 3.2 Information Collected Automatically

When you browse our Website, the following data is collected automatically via third-party tools:

- IP address and approximate geographic location
- Browser type, device type, and operating system
- Pages visited, time spent on each page, and navigation paths
- Referring URLs (how you arrived at the Website)
- Search queries used to find the Website (via Google Search Console)

## 4. How We Use Your Information

---

We use your data for the following purposes:

- To respond to your inquiries and provide legal consultation services
- To analyse Website usage and improve user experience
- To monitor Website performance and resolve technical issues
- To understand how visitors discover and interact with the Website (via Google Search Console)
- To comply with applicable legal obligations

We do not use your data for automated profiling or decision-making.

## 5. Third-Party Services

---

Our Website uses the following third-party services that may process your personal data:

### 5.1 Google Analytics

We use Google Analytics to understand how visitors use our Website. Google Analytics collects anonymised usage data, including pages viewed, session duration, and geographic region. This data is processed by Google LLC in accordance with their privacy policy.

We have enabled IP anonymisation on Google Analytics, which means your full IP address is never stored.

### 5.2 Google Search Console

We use Google Search Console to monitor our Website's presence in Google Search results. This service provides aggregated data on search queries and page performance. It does not collect personally identifiable information about individual users.

### **5.3 Webflow**

Our Website is hosted on Webflow, Inc., a website-building and hosting platform. Webflow processes certain technical data (such as your IP address and browser information) as part of serving web pages to you.

## **6. Cookies**

---

Our Website uses cookies — small text files placed on your device — to enable analytics and improve performance. The cookies we use include:

- `_ga`, `_gid`, `_gat` — Google Analytics cookies used to track session and usage data
- `__utma`, `__utmz` — Legacy Google Analytics cookies (if applicable)

You can control or disable cookies through your browser settings. Note that disabling cookies may affect certain Website functions.

## **7. Legal Basis for Processing**

---

We process your personal data on the following legal grounds:

- Consent — where you have explicitly agreed to the use of your data (e.g., by submitting a contact form)
- Legitimate Interests — for website analytics and performance monitoring, where your rights are not overridden
- Legal Obligation — where we are required to process data to comply with applicable law

Where we rely on consent, you have the right to withdraw it at any time.

## **8. Data Retention**

---

We retain your personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected:

- Inquiry and contact data: retained for up to 3 years, or as required by professional legal obligations
- Google Analytics data: retained for 26 months (default Google Analytics retention period)
- Server/hosting logs: typically retained for up to 90 days by Webflow

You may request deletion of your personal data at any time (see Section 10 below).

## 9. Data Sharing & International Transfers

---

We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal data with third parties. We may share your data with:

- Google LLC — for analytics and search console services (data may be processed in the United States)
- Webflow, Inc. — for website hosting (data may be processed in the United States)
- Legal authorities — if required by law or court order

Where data is transferred outside your country of residence, we ensure appropriate safeguards are in place (e.g., Standard Contractual Clauses or equivalent mechanisms).

## 10. Your Rights

---

Depending on your jurisdiction, you may have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- Right of Access — to request a copy of the personal data we hold about you
- Right to Rectification — to correct inaccurate or incomplete data
- Right to Erasure — to request deletion of your personal data
- Right to Restrict Processing — to limit how we use your data
- Right to Data Portability — to receive your data in a structured, machine-readable format
- Right to Object — to object to processing based on legitimate interests
- Right to Withdraw Consent — at any time, where processing is based on consent
