UNLTD CHARITY PARTNER ELIGIBILITY.

One complete list.

To be eligible to become an UnLtd Charity Partner, organisations must:

01

WORK PRIMARILY WITH CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE.

Specifically those experiencing disadvantage, with programs that clearly fit at least one primary UnLtd Impact Lane: Start, Safe Home, or Belong.

02

DEMONSTRATE EVIDENCE.

Tracking 3-5 meaningful outcomes (e.g., wellbeing, identity connection, engagement in learning, stability in housing/ education, help-seeking or safety).

03

SUPPORT AND REPORT.

We need figures around the number of children/young people reached each year, plus where services operate (metro/ regional) and how impact is measured.

04

SHOW READINESS FOR PARTNERSHIP.

Through the ability to collaborate on campaigns, events or volunteering. And have at least one full-time marketing/ communications staff member.

05

ADHERE TO UNLTD'S ETHICAL STORYTELLING EXPECTATIONS.

Including: dignity-based, non-deficit language; informed consent; lived-experience leadership; system-level framing; and no shock, pity, or hero-organisation narratives.

06

BE ACNC-REGISTERED WITH DGR STATUS.

Financially stable, operating for at least two years, and supported by sound governance and business planning.

07

GOVERNMENT FUNDING.

Organisations need to receive less than 50% of total income from recurring government funding.

08

STAFF AND OPERATIONAL CAPACITY TO DELIVER.

On partnership requirements, without compromising service delivery.

09

ALIGN WITH UNLTD'S VALUES

Specifically, our values around equity, inclusion, cultural safety, and respectful engagement with diverse communities, including Indigenous and First Nations young people; LGBTQIA+ young people; young people with disability; and those impacted by systemic inequality.
