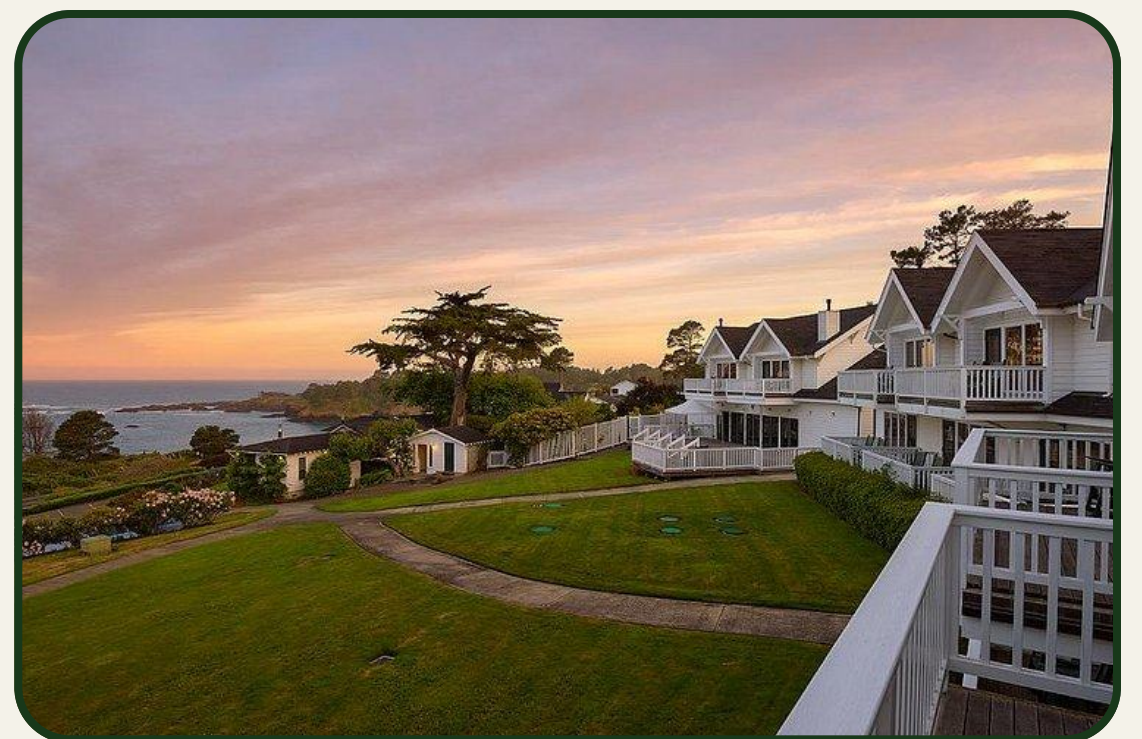
QUIET & SCENIC ALTERNATIVE
