2025 WATERWORKS INFORMATION

WATERWORKS RATE POLICY:

On August 28, 2019, Council passed a bylaw to fix the rates to be charged for the use and consumption of water and to fix the rates to be charged by way of rent and service charge for the use of sewer.

Under this water rate policy Bylaw No. 3-2019, the water rate is \$14.00 per 1,000 gallons with a minimum monthly charge of \$42.00.

The objective of the Waterworks rate policy is to maintain waterworks that are self-financing, and to set aside funds for future capital expenditures. Renewal and replacement of infrastructure is being prioritized and completed as funds allow.

WATERWORKS CAPITAL INVESTMENT STRATEGY:

The objective of the waterworks capital investment strategy is to address anticipated waterworks infrastructure maintenance and future infrastructure replacements in a timely fashion to ensure the municipal waterworks provides safe drinking water to residents and businesses. A Water Treatment Plant Upgrade Feasibility Study and Waterworks System Assessment was completed in 2020 which recommended the replacement of the current Waterplant. Council is exploring grant funding options for this upgrade. The Town of Gull Lake has drilled an additional water well as backup to the existing well. This new well will be tied into a new pumphouse which is scheduled for completion in 2026.
