OUR 3-DAY EXAMPLE ITINERARY

DAY 1 – Journey Back in time to the Jurassic period

7.30AM: Meet at school bus bay for departure
9.30AM – Visit Coonabarabran Crystal Kingdom and learn about the incredibly rich geological footprint.
10.30 AM – Visit the largest Marsupial that ever lived at the Diprotodon exhibition
3.00 PM – Step back into the 19th century to explore Australian convict and colonial history. Students will walk through sandstone corridors, stand inside tiny isolation cells, and examine the intact gallows gallery to learn about regional justice, colonial architecture, and social structures at the old Dubbo Gaol.
5.00PM Students will overnight at Discovery Parks Dubbo

DAY 2 - Explore Taronga Western Plains Zoo

9.00 – Explore this massive 300-hectare open-range sanctuary. Unlike traditional city exhibits, the vast, naturally designed habitats use hidden moats instead of fences, providing an authentic safari feel that emphasizes wildlife preservation and ecology.
3.00PM – Royal Flying Doctors: Students will explore the incredible history and modern realities of remote healthcare in Australia's outback. This interactive facility uses touchscreens, life-sized aircraft models, and live regional flight screens to show how doctors, nurses, and pilots deliver emergency care across millions of square kilometers.
5.00PM – Students will overnight at Discovery Parks Dubbo

DAY 3 – Astronomy and Space science Day

9:00 AM – Depart Dubbo and Travel to Connabarabran where we will explore the Siding Spring Exploratory Centre, an interactive science exhibition filled with graphs, audiovisual displays, and hands-on activities (like planet-weight simulators). Students will also head up to the public viewing gallery inside the massive Anglo-Australian Telescope building.
4.00 PM: Estimated arrival back at school (Parents collect from bus bay)
