

PRIVACY POLICY

of the website SCX Sustainability Scorex

This Privacy Policy (hereinafter referred to as the “Policy”) defines the terms of use of cookies, as well as the procedures for the collection, processing, use, and protection of personal data of users of the SCX Sustainability Scorex website (hereinafter referred to as the “Website”).

By using the Website, including by filling out feedback forms, the User confirms that they have read this Policy and consent to the processing of their personal data under the conditions set forth in this Policy.

Please note that you must be at least 18 years old to use our services, participate in marketing programs, subscribe to marketing newsletters, register on our websites and platforms, or otherwise provide us with your personal data.

This Policy does not apply to business relationships with us. The processing of personal data with our clients or business partners is governed by the relevant contracts or separate policies.

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1. The processing of personal data is carried out in accordance with the Law of Ukraine “On the Protection of Personal Data”, as well as taking into account the general principles of international data protection regulations, in particular the GDPR, to the extent applicable.

1.2. The controller of personal data is the individual entrepreneur - Physical Person-Entrepreneur Davydova Kateryna Olehivna, address: 5a Oleksandra Olesia Street, apt. 191, Kyiv, who administers the Website.

1.3. The Website is not intended for the collection of personal data of persons under the age of majority, and such data is not knowingly processed.

2. COMPOSITION AND METHOD OF COLLECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

2.1. In the course of the Website’s operation, the following categories of personal data may be processed:

- Personal data provided voluntarily by the User, including name and surname, company name, position, contact details (email address, phone number);
- Technical data collected automatically during the use of the Website, including IP address, browser type, device characteristics, interface language, date and time of access, as well as information about the User's actions on the Website collected through cookies and web analytics services.

2.2. The Website does not collect or process special categories of personal data (sensitive data), including data concerning health, political or religious beliefs, racial or ethnic origin, or other similar categories of data.

3. PURPOSES OF PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA

3.1. Personal data is processed for the purpose of communicating with the User, responding to inquiries, establishing and developing business relationships within the scope of providing consulting services, analyzing Website usage and improving its functionality, as well as ensuring an appropriate level of information security.

3.2. Personal data is not used for sale to third parties or for aggressive marketing purposes.

4. LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING

4.1. The processing of personal data is based on:

- Consent given by the User by filling out forms on the Website;
- Legitimate interest consisting in ensuring the functioning of the Website, its analytics, and improving the quality of services.

5. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

5.1. Personal data is stored for the period necessary to achieve the purposes of its processing, unless otherwise provided by the legislation of Ukraine.

5.2. Upon achievement of the purpose of processing or in case of withdrawal of the User's consent, personal data shall be deleted or anonymized, unless otherwise provided by law.

6. TRANSFER OF DATA TO THIRD PARTIES

6.1. Personal data may be transferred to third parties only in cases necessary for the functioning of the Website, in particular to hosting service providers, web analytics services, and other technical contractors.

6.2. The Website uses the Google Analytics service, which may involve the processing and cross-border transfer of anonymized data to the servers of Google LLC in accordance with the terms of use of this service. 6.3. Personal data is not sold or transferred to third parties for commercial use, except in cases provided for by law.

7. USE OF COOKIES

7.1. The Website uses cookies and similar technologies to ensure its proper functioning, analyze user behavior, and improve the user experience.

7.2. Cookies are small text files that are stored on the User's device and allow the device to be recognized during subsequent visits.

7.3. The Website may use essential cookies necessary for the technical operation of the Website, as well as analytical cookies used to collect statistical information about the use of the Website.

7.4. Cookies are not used for the direct identification of the User's identity.

7.5. The User may independently manage the use of cookies by changing their browser settings, including the ability to block or delete cookies.

7.6. Continued use of the Website constitutes the User's consent to the use of cookies in accordance with this Policy.

8. USER RIGHTS

8.1. The User has the rights provided for in Article 8 of the Law of Ukraine "On the Protection of Personal Data", in particular the right to:

- Know the sources of collection and the location of their personal data;
- Receive information about the conditions for access to personal data;
- Receive, no later than thirty calendar days from the date of receipt of the request (except in cases provided by law), a response as to whether their personal data is being processed, and to receive the content of such personal data;
- Submit a reasoned request to the controller of personal data objecting to the processing of their personal data;
- Submit a reasoned request for the correction or deletion of their personal data by any controller or processor if such data is being processed unlawfully or is inaccurate;
- Protection of their personal data from unlawful processing and accidental loss, destruction, or damage due to intentional concealment, failure to provide, or untimely provision, as well as protection from the provision of inaccurate information that discredits honor, dignity, or business reputation;
- Lodge complaints regarding the processing of their personal data with the Commissioner or with a court;
- Apply legal remedies in case of violation of personal data protection legislation;
- Make reservations regarding the restriction of the right to process their personal data when giving consent;
- Withdraw consent to the processing of personal data;
- Know the mechanism of automated processing of personal data;
- Protection against an automated decision that has legal consequences for them.

as well as other rights provided by the current legislation of Ukraine.

9. DATA SECURITY AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

9.1. Appropriate technical and organizational measures are applied to protect personal data in order to prevent unauthorized access, loss, alteration, or unlawful dissemination of information.

9.2. At the same time, the User understands that no method of data transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage is completely secure. Therefore, the Individual Entrepreneur Physical Person-Entrepreneur Davydova Kateryna cannot guarantee the absolute security of personal data.
