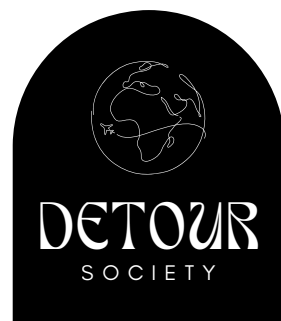

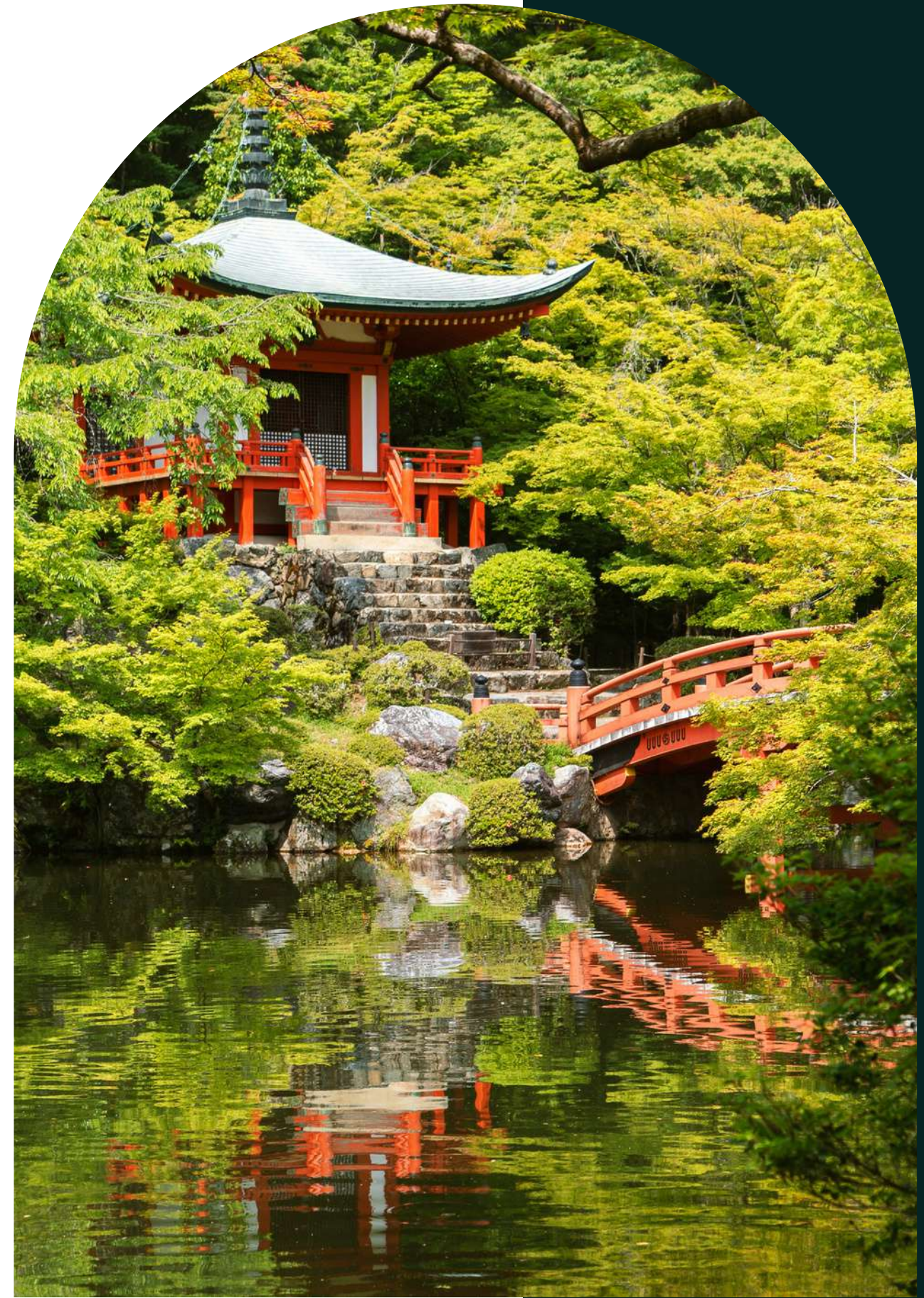

Visa Requirements

For your visa application, follow the [LINK](#) and ensure all documents are prepared in advance. A key requirement is a “Schedule of Stay” document outlining your hotel bookings and duration of stay. Along with this, keep your flight tickets, hotel confirmations, NOC (if required), bank statements and a photograph ready for submission.

E-SIM

It is recommended to purchase an eSIM in advance using this [LINK](#), ensuring you have access to data and navigation throughout your trip without any connectivity issues.

Weather & Packing

March and April in Japan can still be slightly chilly, especially in the mornings and evenings, as the season transitions from winter to spring. Temperatures are generally mild but can vary, so it’s best to check the weather closer to your travel dates. Pack layers to stay comfortable throughout the day and carry a light jacket or sweater. It’s also advisable to keep an umbrella handy, as there can be occasional light rain.

Approximate Travel Times

All travel times mentioned in this itinerary are approximate and have been calculated from point A to B, taking into account both walking distances and train durations. This should help you better plan your day while allowing some buffer for delays or navigation.



SUICA Card

You will need to purchase a Suica card, which works like a prepaid metro card and is essential for convenient travel within cities. It can be bought at the airport or from any JR service center or station, and can be easily topped up as needed.

JR Pass

In addition to the Suica card, you will also need a JR Pass, which is used for travel on JR train lines across cities. This is separate from the Suica card and covers longer-distance routes. You can collect it from a JR ticket office or Travel Service Center, with the nearest option approximately a 10-minute walk from your Shinjuku hotel.

Suica is a prepaid card used for everyday local travel within cities, where you pay per ride. JR Pass offers unlimited travel on JR trains (including bullet trains) and is best for long-distance trips between cities.

Train Timings & Navigation

Train timings can be checked using this [LINK](#), which will help you plan routes efficiently. It's also recommended to refer to the train usage guide to understand how the system works. Always carry both your Suica card and JR Pass while traveling.

Google Translate

Download Google Translate before your trip, as it will be extremely helpful for navigating language barriers. You can translate text, voice and images (like menus and signs) in real time, making communication much easier.





DESTINATION GUIDE

Cherry blossom (sakura) season in Japan runs from late March through April and this itinerary is planned for **3rd–13th April** to align with peak bloom and several evening sakura festivals, maximising your chances of experiencing the season at its best. Please note this is peak travel time, so hotel prices are higher and may vary by month. The costs mentioned are approximate for this duration and are based on two people.

(1h 15 min total to Otsuki). Otsuki to Kawaguchiko: Use your Suica card for this leg (45 mins total to Kawaguchiko).	Train (JR Ticket & Suica Card)	2 hours
Head to Chureito Pagoda - it's about a 15 minute walk from Kawaguchiko Station. On clear days, you'll be rewarded with one of the best views of Mount Fuji.	Walk	15 minutes

Higashi Chaya District - 20 mins walk from Kanazawa Station. Explore the local shops and eateries.	Walk	20 minutes
From the Chaya District, it's a 15 min walk to Kenrokuen . Once there, take your time to stroll and explore the gardens.	Walk	15 minutes
Lunch : Omicho market , it's the “Kitchen of the City,” famous for fresh seafood, local produce and traditional snacks. It's a 15 min walk from Kenrokuen.	Walk	15 minutes
From Omicho Market, it's a 20-minute walk to Kanazawa Castle Park .	Walk	20 minutes
To return to Tokyo (Shinjuku Station) from Kanazawa Station, you can walk 25 minutes or take an 8 minute taxi from the castle. We’ve included directions for the Borderless one. (Refer to page 33) From the hotel, walk to Shinjuku Station and take the Ōedo Line to Roppongi, then walk to TeamLab. The train ride is about 35 minutes.	JR Pass	45 minutes
Lunch : Enjoy a picnic at Shinjuku Gyoen National Garden (¥500 entry fee for adults). Pick up some easy-to-eat food beforehand and relax in the gardens. It’s about a 45-minute train ride back, followed by a 20-minute walk to the hotel.	Walk + JR Pass	1 hour
Head to Daikanyama, a chic and quiet neighborhood just 20 minutes from Shinjuku, known for its boutiques, cafés and the beautifully designed Daikanyama T-Site.	Walk	20 minutes
Dinner : Wagyu SHOUTAIAN SHIBUYA, serves premium A5 Wagyu beef, from steaks to yakiniku-style grilled dishes. From Shinjuku Station, take the JR Yamanote Line to Shibuya Station, then walk 10 minutes to Wagyu SHOUTAIAN SHIBUYA.	Train (Suica) + Walk	20 minutes
After dinner, head to Red Bar, just a 15 minute walk from SHOUTAIAN. From there, make your way back to the hotel.	Train (Suica) + Walk	25 minutes

Stroll around Pontocho Alley along the Kamo River and explore the Gion District (Geisha district) . It's about a 15 minute walk from Nishiki Market to Gion, giving you plenty of time to explore.	Walk	15 minutes

From Arashiyama Bamboo Grove, walk to Adashino Nenbutsuji (opens at 9 AM), then continue on foot to Otagi Nenbutsuji Temple (opens at 8 AM).	Walk	35 minutes
Lunch : Arashiyama Kijurou , Japanese steakhouse / yakiniku-style dining.	Walk	10 minutes
From Arashiyama Kijurou, take a train back to Mercure Kyoto Station: walk about 10 minutes to Saga-Arashiyama Station, board the JR Sagano Line (Sanin Main Line) toward Kyoto Station, then walk 8 minutes from the station to the hotel.	Train (Suica) + Walk	45 minutes
From the hotel, you can walk 5 minutes to Kyoto Tower for panoramic city views and 10 minutes to To-ji Temple , famous for its five-story pagoda and seasonal flea market.	Walk	20 minutes

From Osaka Station, it’s about a 15 minute walk to The Westin Osaka . Just follow signs toward the Umeda Sky Building area - the hotel is right next to it.	Walk	20 minutes
Dotonbori : Take a train from Umeda Station to Namba Station to reach Dotonbori - Osaka’s vibrant food and entertainment district, famous for its neon lights, street food and lively canal-side atmosphere.	Train (Suica)	25 minutes
Lunch : Kani Doraku Dotonbori : A well-known crab specialty restaurant, famous for its fresh seafood and iconic moving crab sig.	Walk	NA
Explore Dotonbori	Walk	NA
Dinner : You can choose Hanadako (famous for takoyaki), Okonomiyaki Kiji (classic Osaka-style pancakes) or The Cosmopolitan Grill Bar Terrace for something more upscale.	Walk	20 minutes



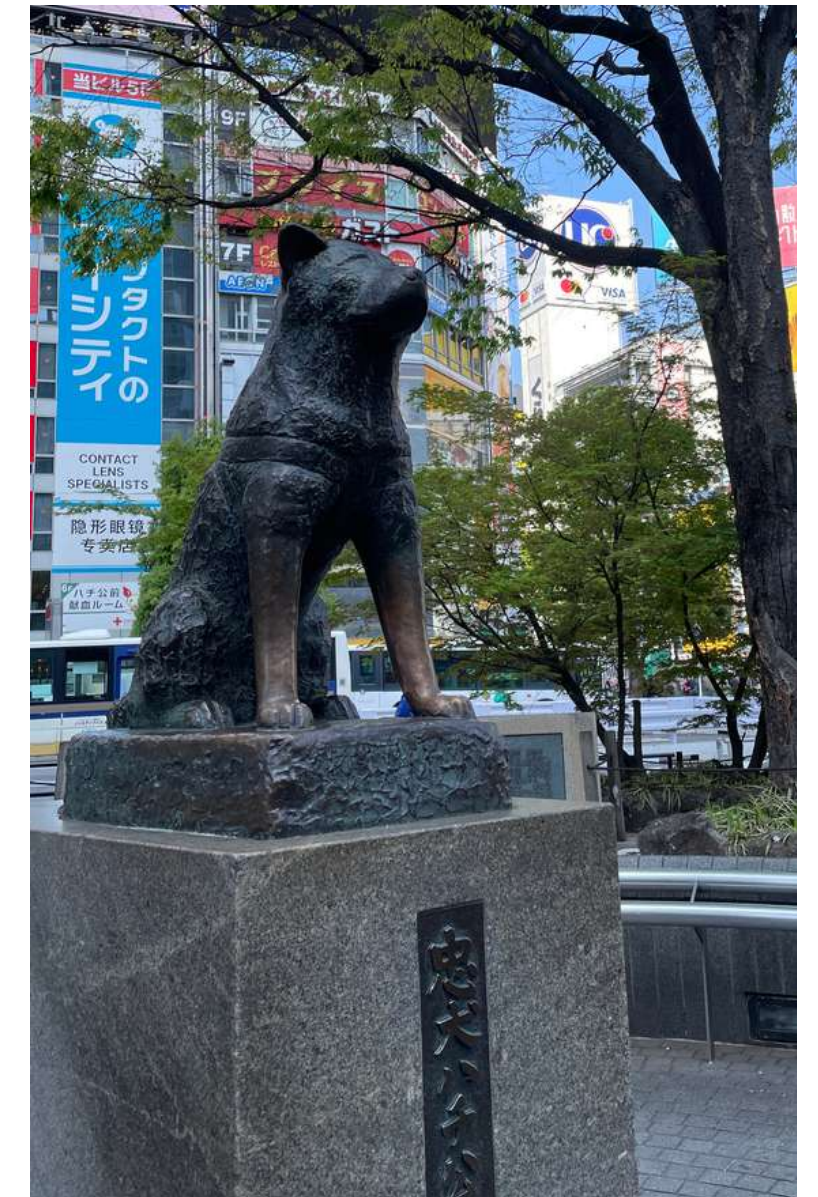

Osaka Castle (opens 9 AM) - From the hotel, take the JR Osaka Loop Line from Osaka Station to Morinomiya Station or Osakajokoen Station. From there, it's a short walk to Osaka Castle.	Train (Suica) + Walk	45 minutes
Stroll through Osaka Castle and the nearby Nishinomaru Garden (9 minute walk from the main castle grounds). Then head to Kuromon Ichiba Market (30 min from the castle) for a quick bite and to soak up the lively market atmosphere. From there, explore the energy of Namba before visiting Namba Yasaka Shrine (10 minute walk), and finish with shopping in Shinsaibashi (20 min walk from the shrine/market area).	Walk	NA
Lunch : Around this area, you can try local favorites like Endo Sushi for fresh sushi at Kuromon Market , or Mizuno Okonomiyaki in Dotonbori for classic Osaka-style pancakes.	Walk	NA
After lunch, take the train from Namba Station (Midosuji Line) north to Umeda Station, then walk 10 minutes back to the hotel.	Train (Suica) + Walk	25 minutes
Dinner : Tsurutontan Soemoncho (known for udon), Koryu (traditional kaiseki) or Hajime (modern Japanese fine dining).	Train (Suica)	20 minutes

Start with a short walk from the hotel to Hachiko , then continue on to Shibuya Crossing just a couple of minutes away. From there, head to Ginza (around 26 minutes by train), where you'll find plenty of shopping options, including Uniqlo and much more to explore.	Train (Suica) + Walk	45 minutes
Lunch : Sushi no Midori Ginza	Walk	NA
Explore Ginza	Walk	NA
Head to Andaz in the evening for drinks and dinner (leave by 5:00 PM) to catch the sunset, with the journey taking approximately 30 minutes by train. From here, you'll also have one of the best views of Tokyo Tower. (Refer to page 32 for reservation link)	Train (Suica) + Walk	30 minutes

Start with MEGA Don Quijote for souvenirs and essentials, then explore Cosme Tokyo for beauty, Shibuya 109 for fashion, Loft and Tokyu Hands for lifestyle and gifts and Uniqlo Shibuya for basics.	Walk	NA
Lunch : Uobei Sushi (conveyor belt sushi) or Ichiran Ramen - both quick, popular and close to the main shopping area.	Walk	NA
Head back to the hotel with a short 10–15 minute walk and check out.	Walk	15 minutes
Leave the hotel and head to Shibuya Station to catch the JR Narita Express 47 to Narita Airport Terminal 2 (Double check your terminal as per your flight booked) . It takes approximately 1 hour 20 minutes to get to the airport.	JR Ticket	1 hour 20 minutes

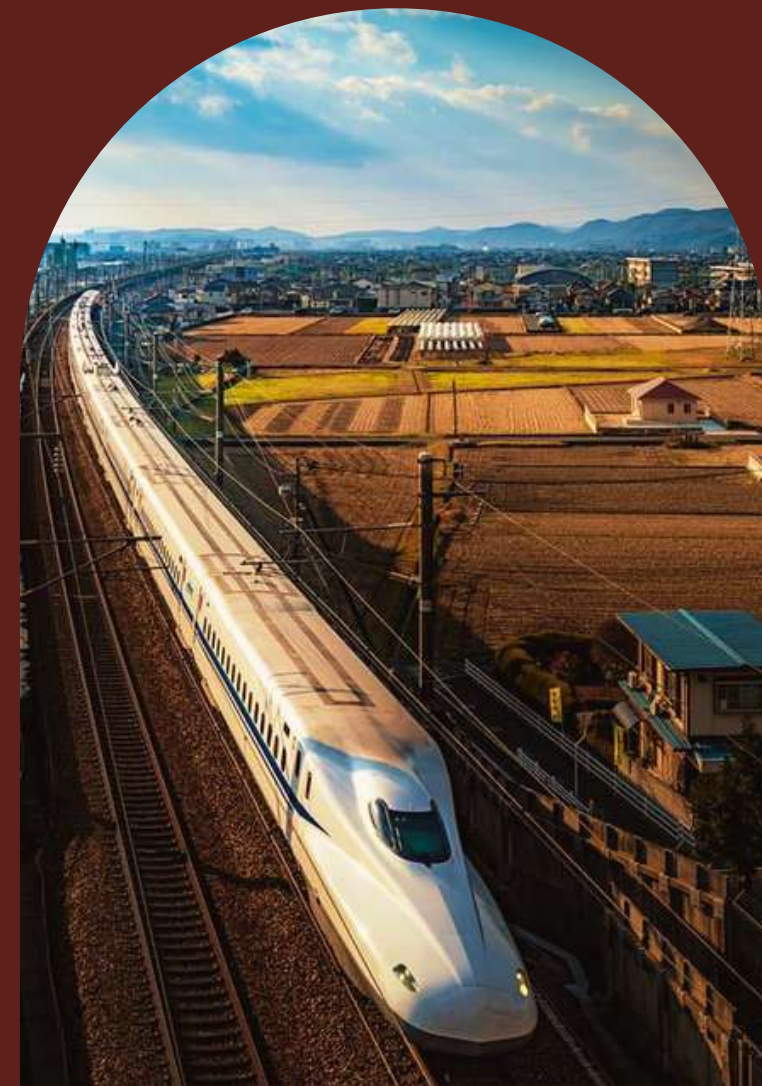
