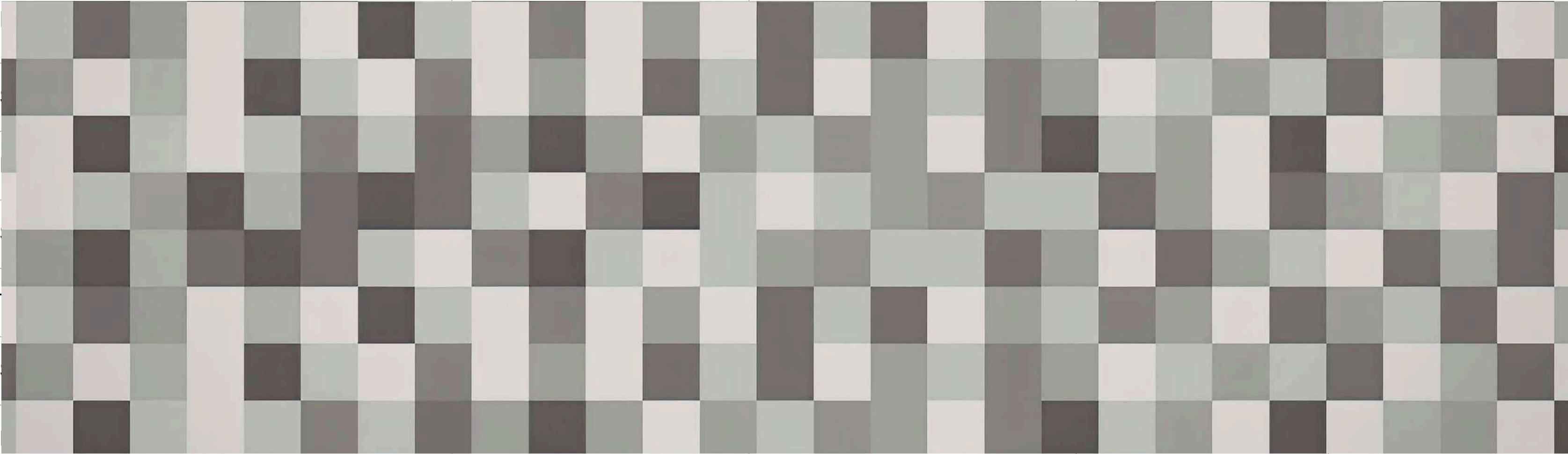
DESTINATION GUIDE
