Relationships

- **Community Events** – partnering with events including NAIDOC Annual Junior Tournament and VACSAL State-wide Basketball Classic
- **Indigenous Artwork** featured on all staff uniforms, league referee shirts and Performance Pathways Program uniforms
- **Partnership MOU** with Indigenous Basketball Australia



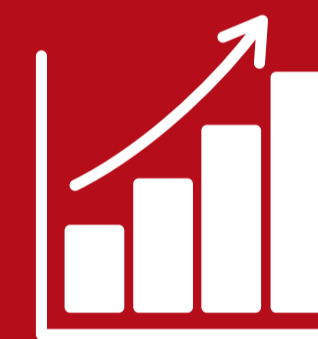
Respect

- **First Nations** round started in 2019 now expanded to include Big V. Acknowledging and celebrating NAIDOC Week
- **Inclusion** of Acknowledgment and Welcome to Country at events and meetings and guidelines for staff, associations and clubs
- **Connecting** associations with local community groups and organisations to deliver activity



Opportunities

- **Registration** subsidy support for clubs and participants
- **Increased** participation 1.84% to 2.15% Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander peoples in community basketball
- **Funding** to support events and activities to increase participation and ongoing opportunities in clubs and associations



Governance

- **Commitment** to invest in Reconciliation Action Plan
- **Staff** participation in Koorie Heritage Trust Cultural Education programs
- **Publicly** available and activity promoted on website



WHAT WE ARE CONTINUING TO DO

- Continued partnerships with First Nations led organisations and groups to increase participation opportunities
- Promote and showcase BV Indigenous Artwork and its meaning

- Supporting associations and clubs to celebrate First Nations peoples and connect with local community groups through FN Round
- Providing protocol resources and guidance to staff and members

- Funding fees to remove barriers to participation in community basketball
- Funding activities and events aligned to ongoing participation at association and club level

- Increase cultural awareness training and resources
- Develop anti-racism campaign and educational resources
