

HOW TO DRAW ROVER

from Taylor Woolley's picture book, *Earth Rover*

①



Start by drawing a small, lumpy, upside down triangle.

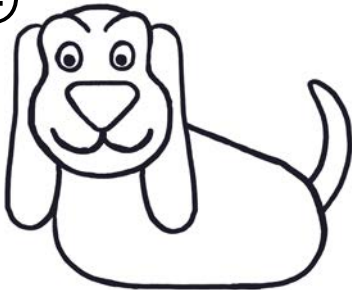
Draw a peanut shape around the triangle.

③



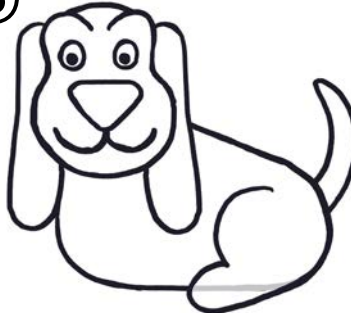
Add two long C shaped ears on the sides of the peanut, circles with dots for eyes, and a w-shape under the triangle for the mouth. Give Rover two big, curved eyebrows at the top of the peanut shaped head, erasing where the shapes overlap.

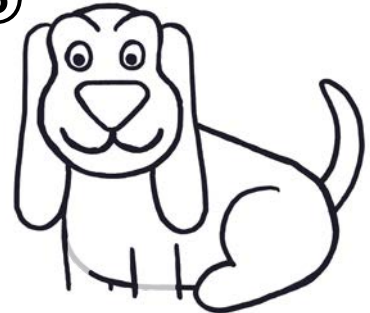
Starting under the head, draw a long rounded triangle for the body. Add a rounded crescent shape for the tail.

Draw a sideways lopsided heart shape for Rover's back leg. Erase where the leg overlaps with the body.

Draw four vertical lines for the front legs, erasing where they overlap with the body.

⑦



Add two C shapes at the bottom of the front legs for feet and lines for toes.

⑧



Color light brown patches covering Rover's eyes, ears, back, and tail.

Finish your drawing by adding the dark spot on Rover's back with a darker brown or black and coloring his nose dark blue or dark purple. Now you've drawn Rover the dog!
