

Home.Earth is looking for a Student Assistant for our Finance team.

Location: Copenhagen | Start date: As soon as possible | Approximately 15 hours per week

Home.Earth is one of Denmark's most ambitious and fast-moving real estate companies. B-Corp certified and built from the ground up with sustainability at our core, we work to redefine what responsible urban development looks like. Our first project, 158 homes in Hedehusene, achieved the lowest carbon footprint ever recorded for a multi-story residential building in Denmark, probably in Europe. Our second development in Høje Taastrup is on track to go further.

We both develop new residential projects and acquire standing assets, so new companies keep joining the group and the portfolio keeps growing. We are adding a student assistant to the Finance team to help carry the growing volume of reporting and analysis.

We are now looking for a curious and analytical student to join our Finance team to help us deliver on our growth ambitions.

The role

The Finance team works across the whole company on accounting, reporting, and analysis, from the monthly management reports to the quarterly updates that go to our investors and our board. The work is a mix of recurring reporting on a fixed cycle and ad hoc analysis that comes up as the portfolio grows.

From the start you'll have your own tasks and real responsibility for them. We also work actively with AI and with improving our own processes, and that part of the job keeps growing. If you have a feel for finding a better way to do something, there is real room to shape how the team works.

Home.Earth is a lean team and intends to stay that way, which means short decision paths and senior exposure from day one. You will work closely with Kristian Andersen (Controller in Finance, former PwC Senior Manager), Jakob Hermann (CFO, former PwC Partner), and Rasmus Stigaard, who works in finance and investments alongside his master's at CBS. - Prepare parts of the monthly and quarterly reporting to management and investors.
- Build analysis in Excel, from key figures and budget follow-up to ad hoc requests.
- Help bring new companies and investments into our reporting as the portfolio grows.

- Support the reconciliation and documentation work behind the reporting.
- Help automate and improve how the Finance team works, including with AI.
- Take on project work across the team, with your own tasks and your own deadlines.

- Flexibility around your studies, in particular during exam periods.
