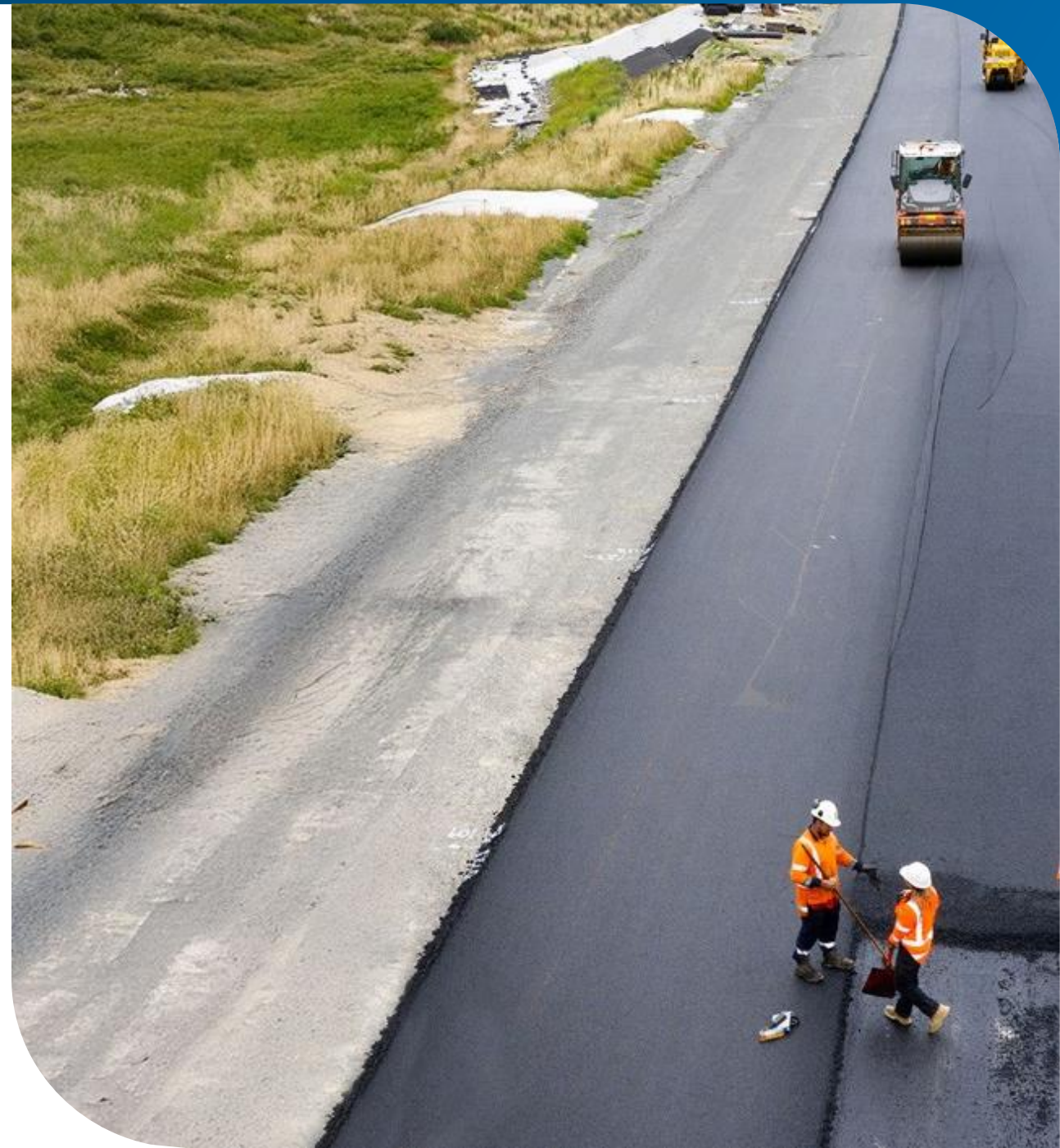
Good traffic management starts with planning, influences investment, supports delivery and strengthens long-term network performance.
