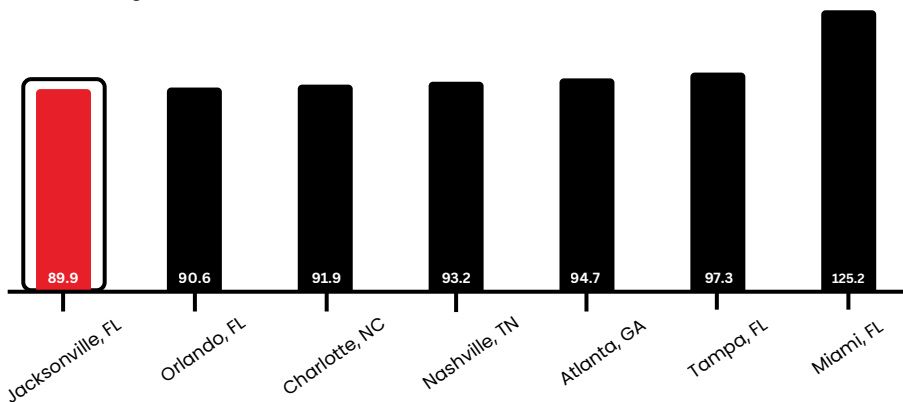

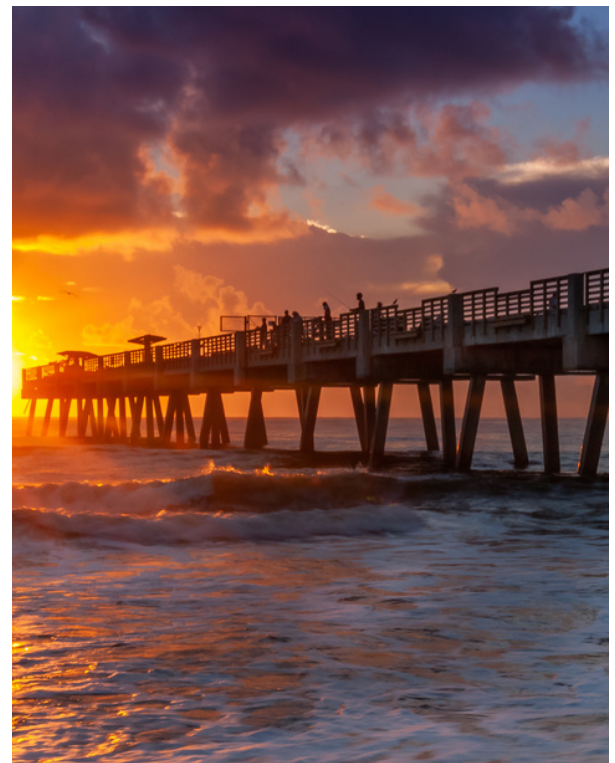
TOP ARTS & CULTURE DESTINATION
