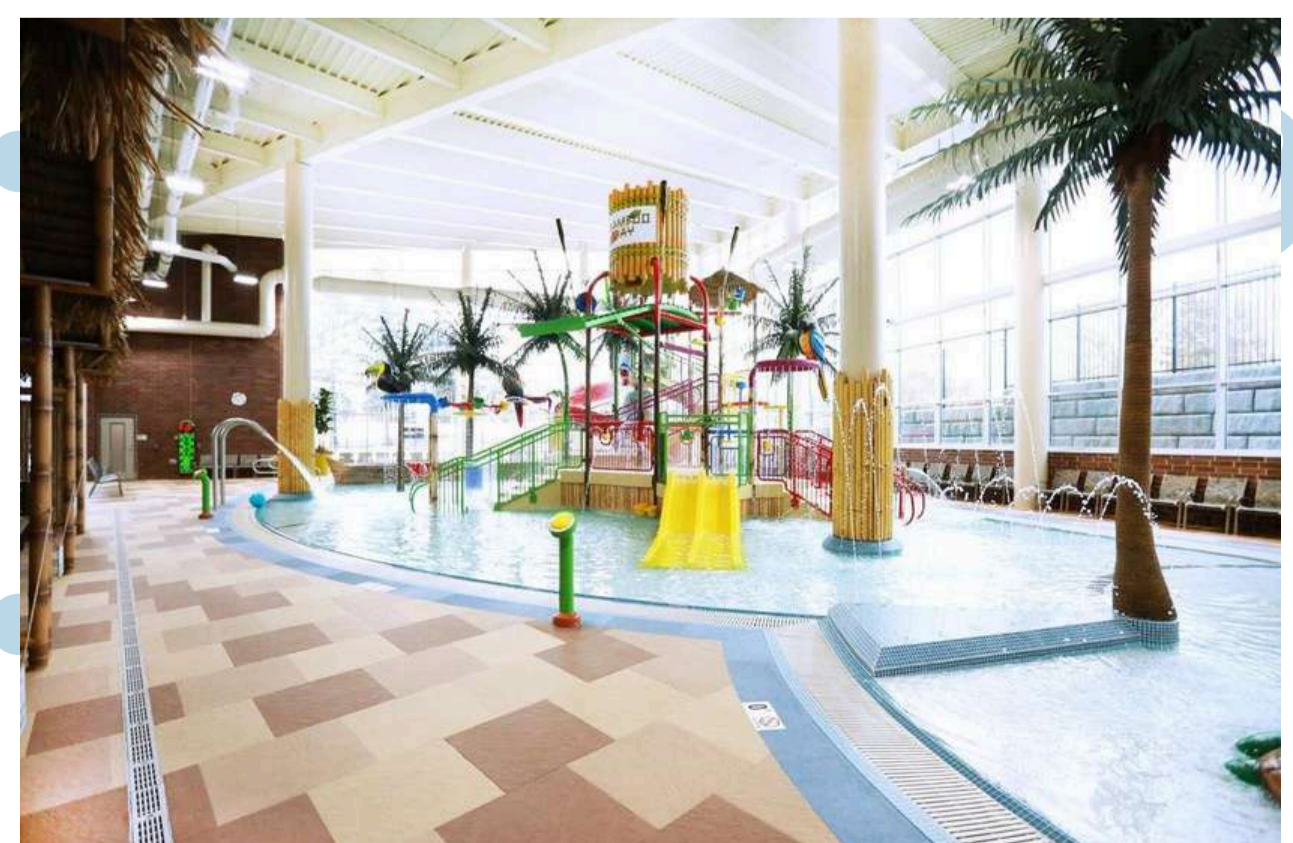
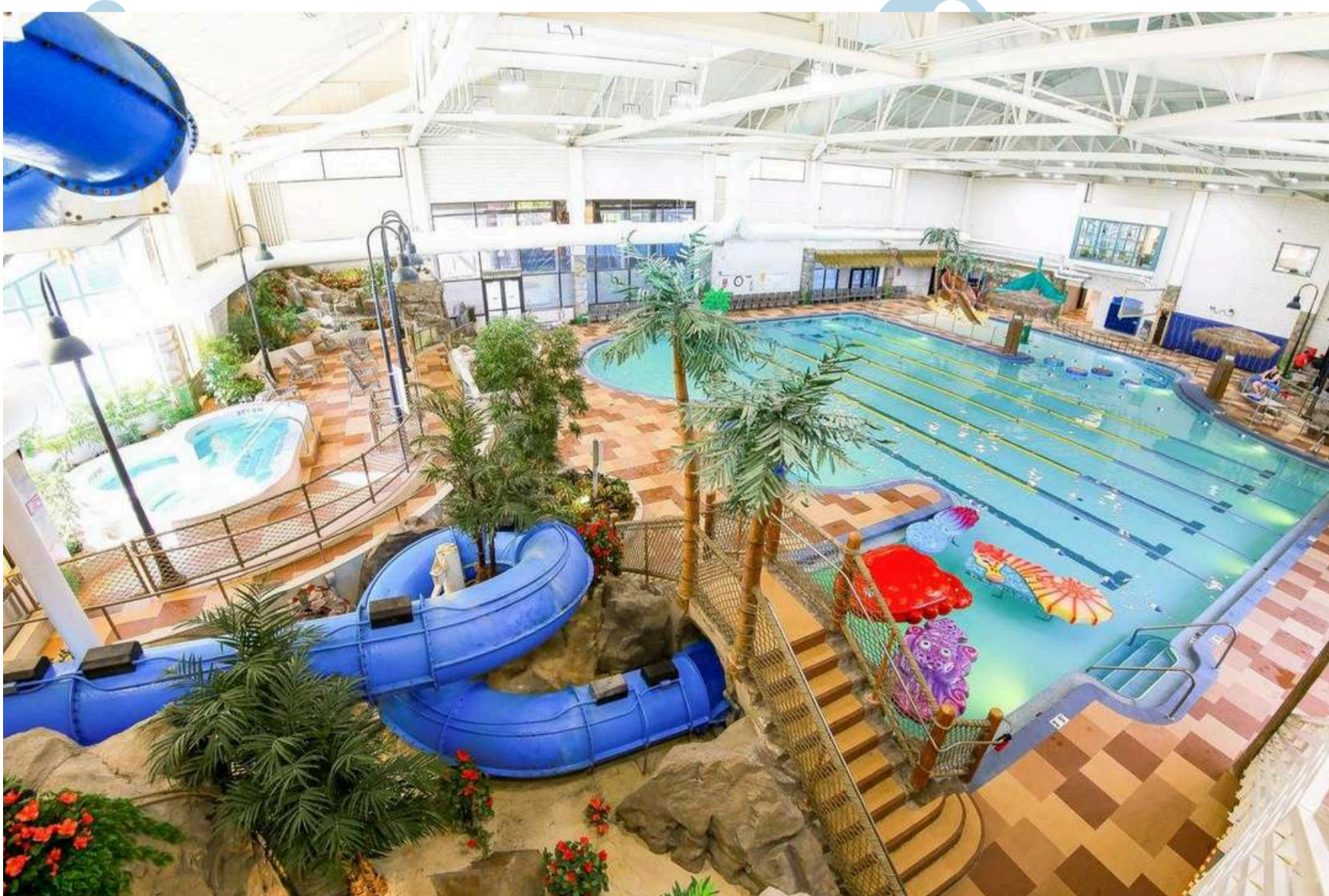


Fusion will experience Water Wednesdays at Shoreview Community Pool with our final Water Wednesday happening at Bunker Beach!

Shoreview Community Pool has a maximum depth of 4'6", with most of the pool at a depth of 3'4" or shallower. The waterslide exits into a 3'4" area. There is a zero-depth playground, similar to Great Wolf Lodge, along with an additional kids' swim area.

Before summer begins, families will receive a swim survey to inform summer staff of their child's swim level. Life jackets are available on-site based on availability.

Students will use the family restrooms within the zero-depth playground rather than the locker room facilities. All students will change into their swimwear on campus before departure and will change back once we return.

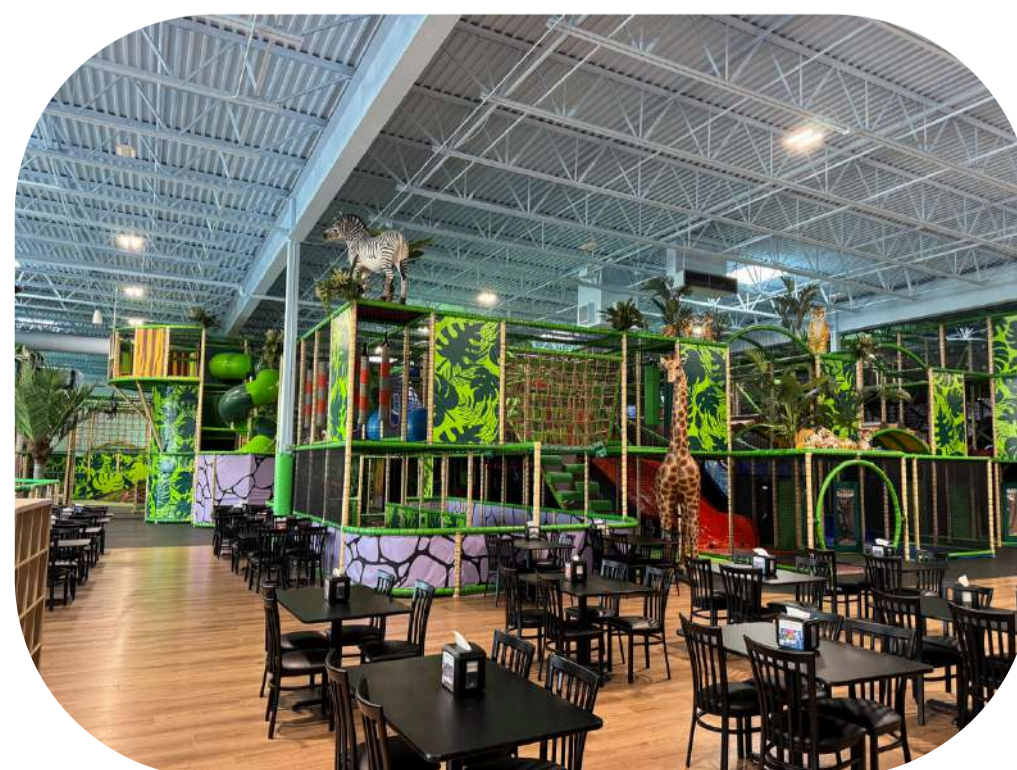

What Are Enrichment/Athletic Clubs?

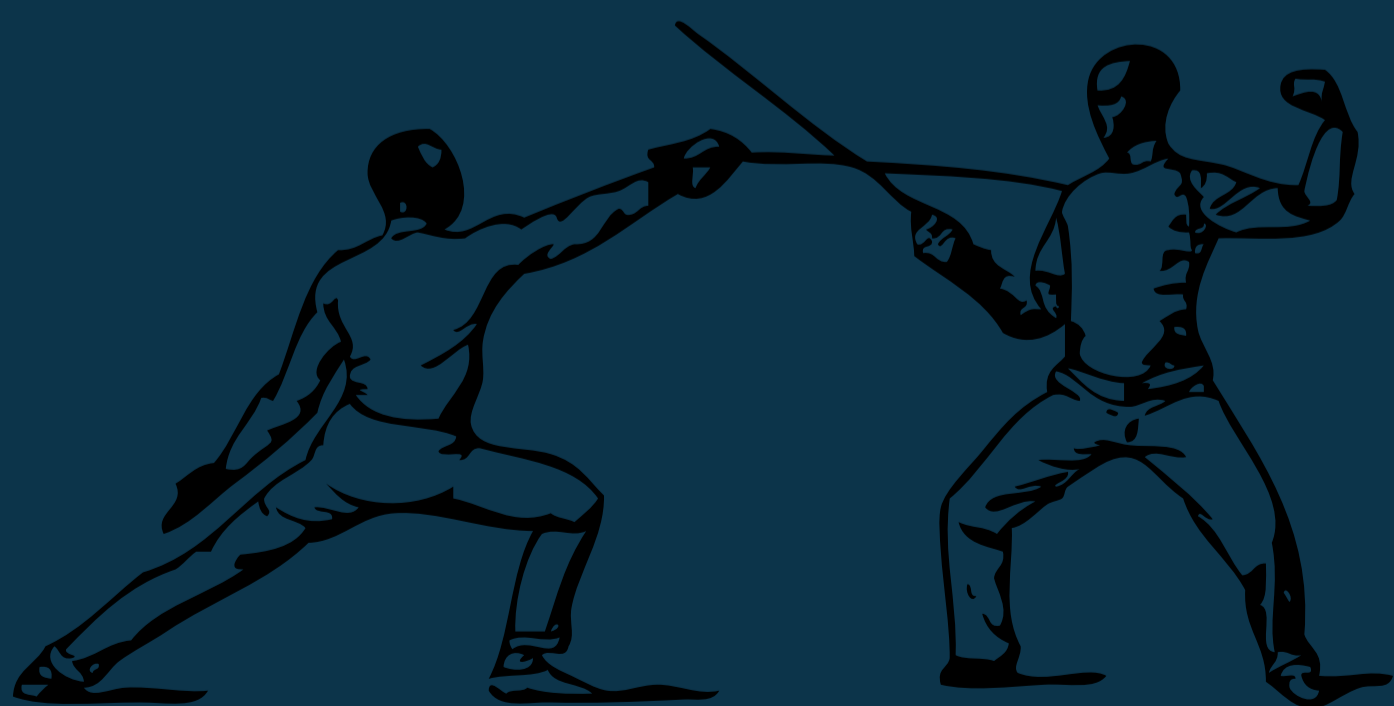
Enrichment and Athletic Clubs are optional, fee-based programs designed to enhance your child's Summer Program experience. While all students will have plenty of engaging activities throughout the program, these clubs provide opportunities to develop specific skills and explore new interests.

Participation in these clubs requires an additional fee beyond the standard daily care rate. Families who are only interested in Enrichment or Athletic Clubs may enroll solely in those programs and are responsible for transporting their child to and from the club at the designated times. Please note that students dropped off too early or picked up late may incur additional care fees.



Enrichment and Athletic Clubs are scheduled to avoid conflicts with Water Wednesdays and Field Trip Fridays and will conclude before lunch or start after lunch is concluded. Additional club offerings may be introduced at a later date.

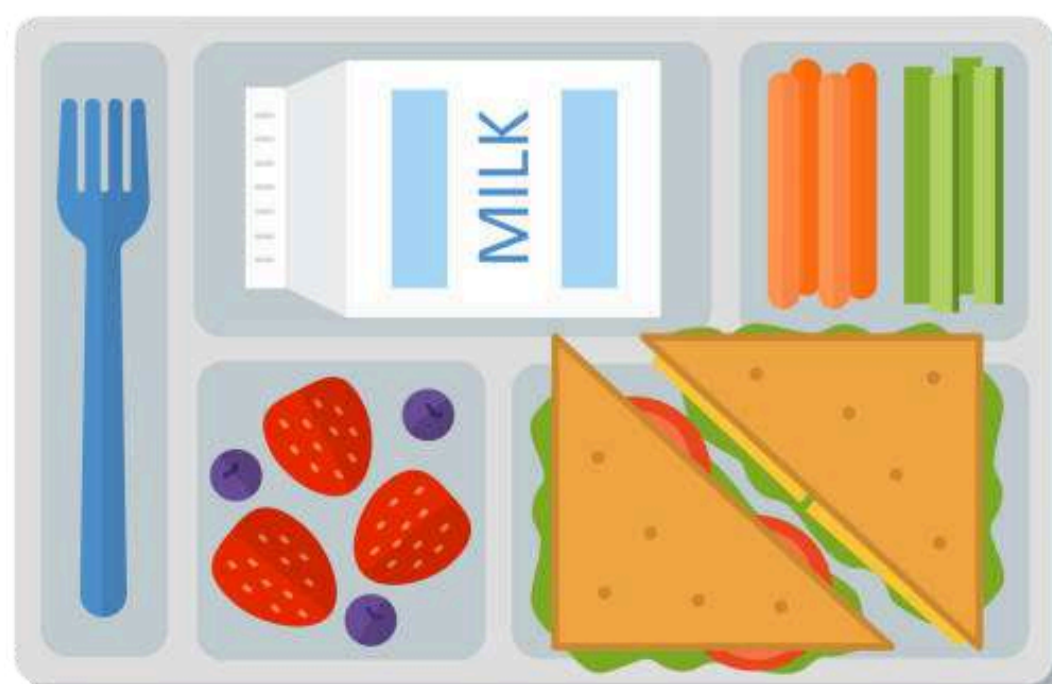

Registration

You can find the registration link online at www.mcamustangs.org/summer. Parents are required to complete a *Conduct Waiver, Financial Agreement, Participation Agreement, and Media Release Form* along with inputting an emergency contact and medical information for each participant. Also, an authorization for administration of medication is needed, if applicable.

Students should register for classes according to **the grade they will attend in the fall**. A confirmation of your registration will be sent via email upon successful completion of the registration process. Clubs are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Payment

Payment for each activity is listed on the registration site, along with available payment plans if you choose. A \$25 fee will be assessed for insufficient funds or a declined credit card.

Refund eligibility will depend on the timing of your request. Please note that all cancellations are subject to a non-refundable cancellation fee, and a full refund may not be available based on when the request is received per the refund policy below.

Refund Policy

Requests for refunds for weekly sessions or enrichment clubs prior to June 1st will receive a full refund. **No refunds will be issued on or after June 1st to ensure staffing and programmatic commitments to all families.** This policy is applied to all registrants and includes cancellations due to vacation schedules, conflicting activities and/or just a change in plans.

If a student is absent for two or more days due to medical reasons, a doctor's note is required, and the refund will be issued in full.

If a student is asked to withdraw from an activity because of inappropriate conduct, a refund will not be issued.

Camp Changes and Cancellations

We reserve the right to combine or cancel camps as needed. If a camp is changed, the dates may be adjusted. In the event of a cancellation, we will make every effort to notify families at least two weeks before the start of the class and provide the option of a refund.

Lost or Stolen Items

Parents are requested to label all clothing with the student's name to ensure complete identification of all items and to protect against loss. MCA's Summer Program assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen personal property. We discourage all participants from bringing anything of value, such as jewelry, electronics, money. Students should not bring toys, electronic units, trading cards, or other similar items.

Appropriate Dress

Students are expected to dress appropriately for summer activities. Clothing that exposes underwear, shows excessive skin (e.g., halter tops, crop tops, or very short shorts), or displays advertisements for alcohol, drugs, weapons, or organizations supporting substance use is prohibited. Students not following the dress code will need to change into suitable attire. Certain field trips may also have specific clothing requirements.
