4 Swiss Championship titles to be awarded

Official Regulations

1. General

- 1.1** The **Swiss Simracing Series (SSRS)** is a digital racing series. It is promoted and organised by:
- Race-Centers.com
 - RacingFuel Simulators AG (RFAG)
- 1.2** The **Swiss Simracing Series (SSRS) 2026** is held as the official Swiss Simracing Championship from 01 July to and including 15 November 2026.
- 1.3** The series is registered with **Auto Sport Schweiz (ASS)** under reg. no. 26-024/SIM and is run under its sporting authority. It is registered as an **official Swiss Championship** in simracing. All events are subject to the regulations of the ASS.
- 1.4** The event / series is registered and announced in the National Sports Calendar ESPORTS.
- 1.5** The **Swiss Simracing Series 2026** is held as a championship with qualifying and races 1 and 2 in the Race-Centers as well as races 3 and 4 at the **MOTORWORLD Manufaktur Region Zürich, Kemptpark 3, 8310 Kemptthal**.

4. Eligibility

4.1 Admission:

- Natural persons resident in Switzerland or Swiss citizens.
- Minimum height: 1.20 m
- No licence is required in any category to take part in qualifying.
- For races 1, 2, 3 and 4 an **IT ESPORT SIM Racing annual licence** of Auto Sport Schweiz (ASS) is mandatory (cost of the annual licence CHF 25.-). The annual licence must be applied for before the first race. Admission to the races only with a valid annual licence.

- No licence is required in the OPEN category.
- Center managers are excluded from participation.

4.3 Race licence system rules:

Important note:

The licence confirms that the driver has a basic knowledge of the rules of motorsport and has read and understood the applicable regulations. The driver behaves in a sporting and professional manner. In the event of disputes, the official jury may be contacted, which handles all properly submitted concerns impartially and objectively. With the race licence, every driver thus gains access to a proven organisation with clear regulations and a reliable sporting jurisdiction. It is therefore important to renew the licence annually – as is customary in real motorsport. This helps to finance the organisation, the running of the events and the training and further education of the officials.

5. Format and Procedure

5.1 2026 Calendar:

5.2 Registration for the championship:

- Free sign-up and registration **before taking part in qualifying** is mandatory via the form at <https://simracingseries.ch> (live from 01.07.2026)
 - Surname, first name (observe correct upper and lower case), do not use umlauts (ä, ö and ü), but ae, oe and ue
 - Email address
 - Entrant (e.g.: team name, écurie, Race-Center, etc.)
 - The name used for registration must match the registered name for all sessions in the Race-Centers. In the event of discrepancies, the times will NOT be recorded and are invalid.
 - Category selection:
 - PRO, Juniors, Ladies, Ü50 and OPEN (requirements see point 4.2)
 - Ladies and Ü50 drivers may also start in the PRO category, but must decide on one category when registering.
 - Drivers who have raced in the PRO category in the past may not start in the OPEN category
 - Drivers who have finished 1st in the OPEN category in the past must start in a different category.
 - Simultaneous registration in two or more categories (multiple entries) is not permitted.
- The center managers of the participating Race-Centers are happy to help with any questions regarding registration.

5.3 Simulation, vehicle and tracks:

- Simulation: Assetto Corsa (PC)
- Vehicle: SSRS TC351 with fixed setup at all events (vehicle download not possible); adjustments only permitted for ABS, TC, ESC and BB.
- Tracks: see point 5.1 2026 Calendar (track download not possible)
- Settings: No own settings to hardware, software and in-game are permitted.

5.4 Championship qualifying:

- Location: In certified, participating centers of Race-Centers.com (see point 5.5)
- Costs: CHF 40.- per 30-minute session (max. 4 attempts of 30 min. in the period 01.07. from 09:00 to and including 03.10.26, 19:00), payable directly at the Race-Center.
- Format: Qualifying takes place – analogous to real motorsport – in a common time window with all drivers present on the track. With several qualifying attempts (sessions), holding them at different Race-Centers is permitted.
- Scoring: The fastest valid lap counts; in the event of a tie, the second-fastest lap counts.

5.6 Championship format:

- The championship is decided over four (4) races, in which points are awarded for the finishing position in each race (see point 5.7 Championship points system).
- The overall winner in each category is the person who has scored the most points after all four (4) races.
- In the PRO, Juniors, Ladies and Ü50 categories, a Swiss Championship title “**Swiss Simracing Champion**” is awarded.
- In the OPEN category, the title “Winner of the OPEN category of the Swiss Simracing Series 2026” is awarded.
- Admission quota for championship races 1 and 2 based on the fastest times after qualifying in the centers (see point 5.4 Championship qualifying - scoring):

- Immediately after the end of qualifying, drivers may freely choose their preferred Race-Center for races 1 and 2 (by means of the form provided). The final allocation of center starting places will take place by 12.10.2026 at the latest.
- Admission quota for championship races 3 and 4 based on the most points from races 1 and 2 (see point 5.7 Championship points system):

- Race format (all races):
 - 7 minutes practice
 - 12 minutes qualifying
 - Race 1 or race 3: 18 minutes
 - Race 2 or race 4: 18 minutes (top 5 reverse grid)
 - the breaks within each race session are 3 minutes or 5 minutes

5.7 Championship points system:

- Races 1 and 2:

- Decision in the event of a points tie:
 - Number of higher individual placings** (e.g. more wins, then more second places, etc.).
 - Best individual result** (highest placing achieved in one of the four races).
 - Better placing in the last race** (if there is still a tie).

5.8 Championship participation fees:

- Qualifying: CHF 40.- per 30-minute session (payable on site at the Race-Center), see also point 5.4 Championship qualifying
- Races 1 & 2 participation fee: CHF 50.- (payable on site at the Race-Center)
- Races 3 & 4 participation fee: free of charge
- Cost SIM Racing annual licence: CHF 25.- (payable to ASS)

- The administrative check must be completed no later than 10 minutes before the start of the respective briefing.
- Personal attendance is mandatory for the administrative check and the briefing at the Race-Center or at the Motorworld Kempththal (ZH). The SIM Racing annual licence and a valid official ID must be presented.
- The award ceremonies will only take place on 15.11.2026, after the race of the respective following category.

5.10 Allocation of preferred Race-Center and simulators:

- The allocation is made on the basis of the current championship standings and the stated preferred Race-Centers. Changes remain reserved due to seat capacities.
