PXGEO commits to leading the marine seismic acquisition industry in minimizing the impact of our operations on the environment and the communities in which we work.



Through established procedures, PXGEO sets annual targets for minimizing waste and reducing emissions to ground, water and air. Measurement and monitoring the progress of our environmental stewardship is carried out continuously and our findings are reported in accordance with regulatory requirements and reviewed with the Company's Board of Directors.

PXGEO adopts the latest technologies and initiatives available in the geophysical and maritime industries to minimize our environmental footprint, including:

- Ultra-low sulphur fuels
- Ballast Water Management Systems (BWMS)
- Solid streamers
- Biodegradable hydraulic fluids on contracted ROVs and proprietary subsea node handling systems
- Highly accurate positioning of ROV for precise subsea operations to ensure integrity of the surrounding environment
- An optimized seismic source array specifically designed to minimize noise impact to the surrounding environment.

The PXGEO seismic fleet carries the stringent DNV Clean-Design notation.
