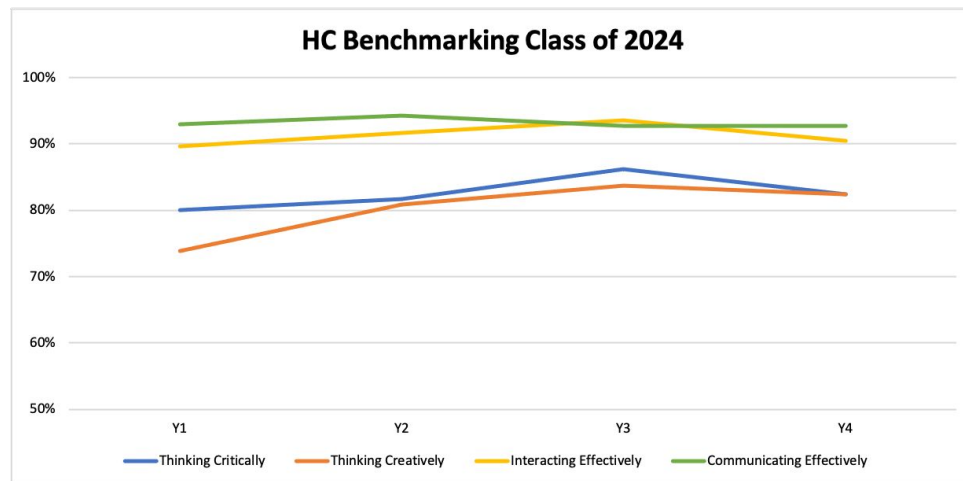

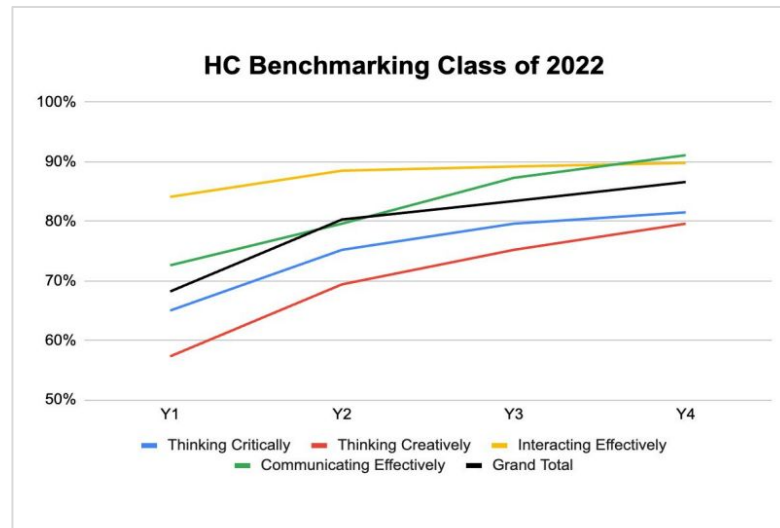
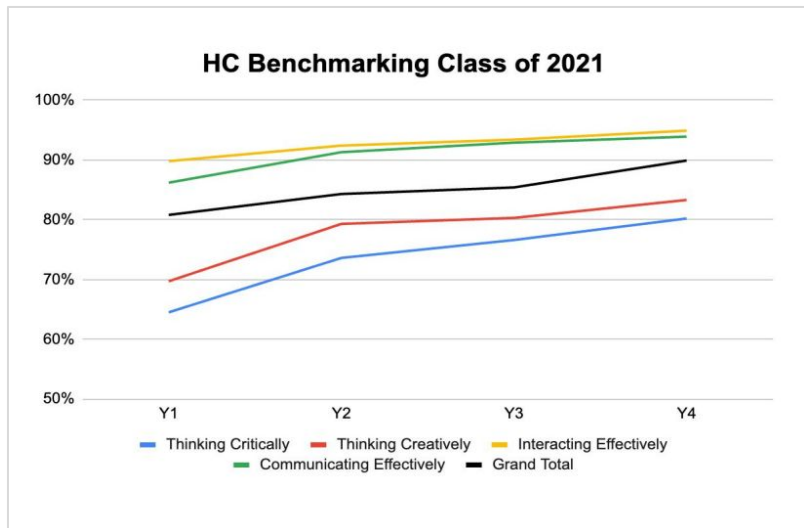
The Habits of Mind and Foundational Concepts (HC) derived from Minerva University's core competencies are introduced in the Cornerstone Courses and continue to be assessed over the following three years in courses. This results in continuous evaluation of student performance on Minerva's undergraduate degree learning outcomes. The benchmarking data shows the cumulative achievement of a benchmark of 3.0 ("knowledge") on a rubric scale of 1-5 for the graduating classes of 2021-2024 over the four years of their undergraduate degree programs, aggregated by sub-competency.

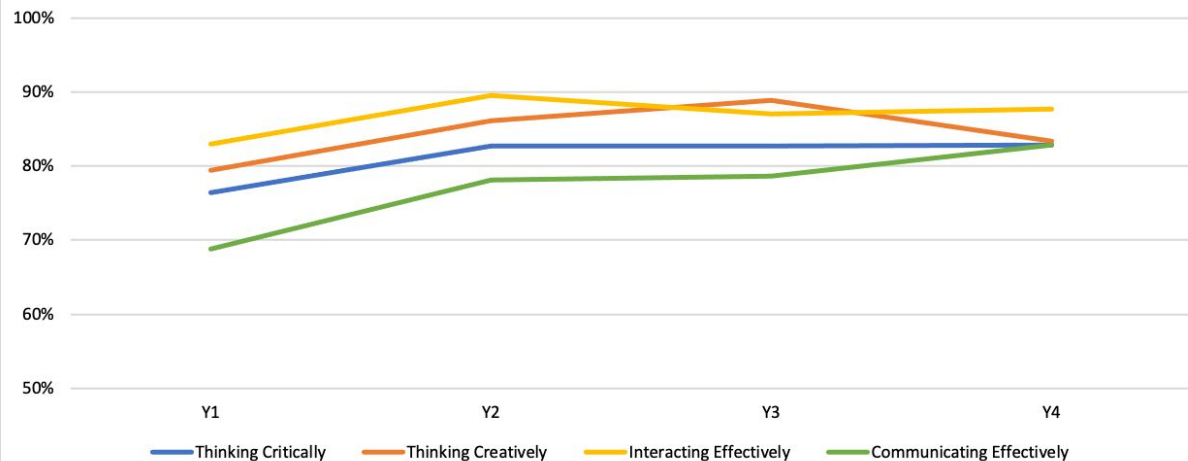
