# 1. Villa life

## 1.1. Arrivals

In the house you will find the remote control to open the gate, which you can use during your stay. Don't forget to leave it in the box in kitchen when you leave.

## 1.2. Departures/Inventory

We ask you to vacate the property before 11am.

- Please remember to lock the front door using the keypad (lift the door handle fully and press on the padlock logo.. all the lights should be green)
- Don't forget to leave the keys/remote controls, etc. in the box provided.
- A member of our team can be present to ensure that your departure goes smoothly (check for presence of gate and swimming pool remote control, state of accommodation) to avoid any subsequent inconvenience and for everyone's peace of mind.

Oh, and before you head off, don't forget to tell us how wonderful your stay was in our guest book and/or on the website!

## 1.3. House rules

You'll be staying in a happy family home, so please treat it with respect.

Autonomous arrival with connected lock or personalised welcome (as you prefer)

from 4 pm. Departure before 11 pm.

### During your stay

- 15 guests maximum (including children and babies)
- Maximum of 2 pets allowed (ground floor only, not in the bedrooms, see under "Pets")
- No parties
- The entire house is non-smoking

### Before you leave

- Collect dirty towels (baskets available in bathrooms).
- Take out the bin bags/recycling bin (collective bins on the other side of the street).
- Empty the dishwasher, put dishes away, clean the coffee make, empty the fridge.
- Close all windows tightly and lock the doors.
- Turn off the lights, radiators and towel rails.
- Clean the barbecue.
- Close the pool cover.

- Close the electric gates and pull the manual gates shut.

We get on very well with our neighbours, who are very friendly. To make sure that we stay on good terms, we ask you to respect their peace and quiet. So, between 11 pm (the time when the summer events at the Grand Port finish) and 8 am, "the sound of silence" should be top of your playlist!

Please consider your noise levels at all times. 🙏

## 1.4. Bedrooms

### 1 - Corsuet

The 27 m<sup>2</sup> "Corsuet" bedroom has a private balcony overlooking the pool and the Corsuet hills. This comfortable room has a queen-size bed (160 cm), a single bed and a TV.

### 2 - Aix

On the city side, the "Aix" bedroom is 16 m<sup>2</sup> and can accommodate 2 people with its 180 cm king-size bed, which can also be divided into 2 separate 90 cm beds.

### 3 - Chambéry

With its small balcony overlooking the street and its 14 m<sup>2</sup>, the "Chambéry" bedroom, with its 140 cm bed, is right at the heart of the action.

### 4 - Port

This 11 m<sup>2</sup> room is perfect for keeping an eye on activities in the main port. Two 90 cm beds and desk area.

### 5 - Mémard

The 14 m<sup>2</sup> "Memard" bedroom with its 140 cm bed is a cosy cocoon in the heart of the house.

### 6 - Lac

The height of elegance, make yourself comfortable in the 13 m<sup>2</sup> "Lac" bedroom. A blend of tradition and modernity with a 180 cm king-size bed that can be divided into two single 90 cm beds.

### 7 - Dent du Chat

Dive into the big blue in the "Dent du Chat" bedroom with its single bed (90 cm) and pull-out bed. 11 m<sup>2</sup> on the second floor.

### 8 - Revard

Admire the Revard mountain range every morning from this bedroom with its warm green tones. A large 160 cm bed in a cosy 11 m<sup>2</sup> room.

## 1.5. Heating

The house has an individual gas heating system. We control the boiler remotely to ensure that you enjoy your stay in comfortable, environmentally friendly conditions.

For economic and ecological reasons, we ask you to use heating responsibly and sensibly, in particular by switching off the towel rails after use.

If you wish to change the settings, please contact us. The temperature is set to 20°C. It is strictly forbidden to change the settings yourself or to tamper with the boiler.

For obvious safety reasons, the fireplaces are not in use and any infringement of this rule will have consequences.

## 1.6. Activities

A whole array of activities can be found just a stone's throw from the villa or in the surrounding area. Immerse yourself in the Aix-les-Bains way of life, with its water-based leisure activities, cultural discoveries and range of outdoor sports. Take a look at the brochures provided in the lounge. You'll be spoilt for choice: golf/cross-country skiing/sailing/tennis/swimming/wine tasting.

- **Mémard beach** (200 m away): restaurants, water sports and outdoor activities, excursions on Lac du Bourget...
- **Aix-les-Bains tennis club**: 19 courts, 11 clay courts including 2 indoor courts
- **Aix-les-Bains international golf course**: 18 holes, 5,519 metres long, par 70 over 45 hectares. Practice open to all.
- **Aix-les-Bains Olympic swimming pool** (by the lake): 25 m pool, learning pool and paddling pool inside. Outside: 50 m pool, snack bar, slides, trampolines, beach and mini-golf. Several activities are on offer: swimming lessons, aquagym, water garden, baby swimming times.
- **Paths** around Lac du Bourget for walkers, cyclists and skaters. Bike hire is available at the Grand Port, 200 metres away.
- **Savoie Grand Revard Nordic and Alpine ski area**, La Féclaz, Saint- François-de-Sales: 25 minutes away for Nordic skiing, Alpine skiing, snowshoeing, paragliding, sledging, mountain biking...
- **Relaxation and wellbeing at the Thermes Chevalley in Aix-les-Bains**: indoor thermal pool, outdoor pool with heated thermal water, relaxation circuit in the pools with jet beds and seats, whirlpool baths, counter-current swimming corridor, multi-jets, goosenecks, steam rooms, saunas, solarium, gym relaxation room.
- **Several of the town's hotels also offer premium spas**: Marina Adelpia, Golden Tulip, Domaine de Marlioz.

- **Nearby towns:** Aix-les-Bains as well as Chambéry and Annecy less than 35 minutes away, Chamonix, Geneva and Lyon around 1 hour. Turin around 2 hours away.
- There are a number of **hiking trails** starting from the Villa Rossa, where you can enjoy the local flora and fauna, as well as the architectural heritage.
- **Water sports enthusiasts** will be in their element here, with boat hire, kayaking, kitesurfing, water-skiing and sailing.

## 1.7. Cleaning

The package includes cleaning at the end of your stay. However, we reserve the right to ask for a cleaning supplement depending on the state of the villa on your departure (after an inspection and discussion with the guest).

Hoovers and cleaning supplies are available in the utility room on the ground floor, the bathroom/laundry room on the first floor and the bathroom on the second floor to clean up any mishaps during your stay.

## 1.8. Instructions for use

The operating instructions for the various appliances can be found in the bottom left-hand drawer next to the dishwasher in the back kitchen.

## 1.9. Check-in/Check-out times

Check-in is from 4 pm and check-out until 11 am. Arrivals and departures take place independently thanks to the smart door lock.

## 1.10. Towels

Towels are provided. Please use them indoors only and not as beach towels, which are not provided.

If you need more towels, please send us a message and the concierge will make the necessary arrangements.

## 1.11. Bed linen

Beds are made for your arrival. Leave the sheets on the beds on departure.

## 1.12. Consumables

Shower gel and shampoo are provided in all three bathrooms.

## 1.13. Hair Dryers

A hair dryer is available in each of the 3 bathrooms.

### 2.1. Wi-Fi

## 2.2. Televisions

You have 3 televisions at your disposal (living room, games room and "Corsuet" bedroom).

## 2.3. Outdoor equipment

The following facilities are available in summer:

- Terrace with tables and chairs
- Barbecue
- Garden with swimming pool (see "Swimming pool")
- Fins, goggles, swimming masks
- Ski/bike room
- Boules
- Volley ball/badminton net

## 2.4. Indoor equipment

For a complete list of interior equipment, please refer to the list used for the inventory of fixtures and fittings.

## 2.5. Bike/Ski/Golf room

A bike/ski/golf room is located on the ground floor, with separate access to avoid having to bring everything through the house. Thanks to its location within the house, you'll sleep peacefully knowing that your belongings are safe and sound.

## 2.6. Barbecue

Summer wouldn't be the same without it, which is why a barbecue awaits you for your planchas and grills. An extra bottle of gas is available in the garden shed adjoining the house in case you run out of gas between your merguez sausages and prime rib... or halloumi and grilled peppers for our vegetarian friends!

Please remember to clean the barbecue after use out of respect for the following guests and our cleaning team. Barbecue cooking and cleaning utensils are at your disposal.

## 2.7. Swimming pool and rules

Our swimming corridor is our pride and joy. Its 15 metres make for a real swimming experience. The swimming pool is heated between April and October but can be used throughout the year (please let us know in advance so that we can get it ready for you).

But be warned: the pool is only 1.5 metres deep. **No diving or dangerous games are allowed.**

The pool is regulated remotely by us. In the event of a problem, we can send our swimming pool technician on site. Don't hesitate to let us know if you have any technical problems.

A pool skimmer is available in the shed adjoining the house for daily maintenance.

### SWIMMING POOL RULES

The Villa Rossa swimming pool is equipped with a roller shutter that complies with standard NF P90-308, designed to enhance safety. However, this does not mean that you should not be constantly vigilant, especially in the presence of children.

#### **Please observe the following rules:**

- Always close the cover after swimming.
- Never leave children unsupervised near the pool. Children should always swim under the supervision of a responsible adult.
- It is forbidden to walk, jump or sit on the cover, whether it is open or closed.
- It is also forbidden to run around the swimming pool and to dive into the pool, as it is shallow and has no deep end.
- Finally, using the pool under the effect of alcohol or drugs is clearly highly inadvisable.



In the event of an accident resulting from failure to comply with these instructions, the owner or manager of Villa Rossa cannot be held responsible.

Thank you for your understanding and enjoy your stay in complete safety!

## 2.8. Pool cover/Gate remote control

The pool cover can be opened and closed using the key or the box that are left in the kitchen on your arrival. Please always put the key and remote control back where you found them. Instructions are posted on the back of the remote control.

To close the cover, you need to turn the key and hold it down or, if you're using the box, hold down the last button in the sequence. This is a safety mechanism to ensure that no-one is left "forgotten" under the cover!

A remote control for the gate is waiting for you in the box in the kitchen. At the end of your stay, please return it to the same place for our next guests.

## 2.9. Iron/Ironing board

You're on holiday but, if you want to take the creases out of your travel clothes or smarten up your work clothes, an ironing board and iron are waiting for you in the bathroom/laundry room on the 1st floor.

### 2.10. Washing machine/Dryer

A washing machine and tumble dryer are available in the bathroom/utility room on the first floor.

### 2.11. Tesla charging

There is a Tesla charging point on the property. Use is subject to a charge in agreement with the owner before arrival.

## 3. Nearby

### 3.1. Shops and services

The nearest **grocery shop** (a SPAR) is 850 metres towards the town and a Carrefour Market is 1.5 km away in the town centre. The Grand Port **pharmacy** is 500 metres away. An **ATM** is located at the Grand Port Tourist Office, 250 metres away. We recommend the Potes & Pâtons **bakery** on Avenue du Grand Port (1.5 km) and the Fournil de la Grotte des Fées (1.4 km via the Jardin Vagabond and cycle path).

### 3.2. Markets

- In **Aix-les-Bains** every Wednesday and Saturday morning from 6am to 1pm on Place Clémenceau.
- In **Chambéry** every Tuesday morning from 7 a.m. to 12 p.m. and Saturday morning from 6 a.m. to 1.30 p.m.

### 3.3. Restaurants

### 3.4. Entertainment nearby

We're not exaggerating when we claim that the Villa is the place to be in Aix les Bains. Nearby, you have cinemas (Toiles du Lac and Victoria), a bowling alley, an escape game, the Aqualis discovery centre on foot, the famous Casino and its theatre, the Marlioz racecourse... and if axe-throwing is your cup of tea, it's forbidden on the property but permitted in Voglans at Lumber Jacks!

### 3.5. Thermal baths and spas

Aix is a renowned spa resort. Make the most of it! As well as the **Chevalley thermal baths**, which offer cures, many hotels offer relaxing spas and rejuvenating treatments! The **Hôtel Adelpia Marina** is a 5-minute walk away, but others such as the **Bains du Lac** at the Domaine Marlioz and **La Parenthèse** at the Golden Tulip hotel offer spa experiences to recharge your batteries.

## 4. Sports and leisure activities

### 4.1. Sports equipment

As a holiday home worthy of the name, a selection of sports facilities can be found at the accommodation to enhance your stay:

## 5. Families and children

### 5.1. Baby-sitter

## 6. Animals

### 6.1. Pets

We accept pets because we know that travelling with them has its share of joys and constraints. We also love children and have four of our own. To ensure that everyone gets on well together, dogs are not allowed on the lawn, but the lakeside, the 'Jardin Vagabond' behind the house and the nearby Corsuet forest are perfect places for them to go for a walk.

For obvious reasons of hygiene, pets are only allowed on the ground floor of the villa and must not be allowed on the sofas. We apply these rules to our own four-legged friends. Bowls for their meals and water are provided in the entrance area near the radiator.

Out of respect for other guests and our cleaning team, please remember to pick up and dispose of dog poop in the bins on the other side of the road. You'll also find dog poop bags on the shelf in the entrance in case you forget yours.

### 6.2. Pet sitter

If you need someone to look after your pets occasionally during your stay to be able to go out and enjoy certain activities, don't hesitate to find a pet-sitter on one of the websites that offer this service (animaute). The villa is not a kennel and pets must not be left alone in the house in the absence of their owners.

## 7. Transportation

### 7.1. Airports

You are 15 minutes from the small airport at Chambéry and 1 hour from Lyon or Geneva airports.

### 7.2. Train station

The station is 2.8 km away, so 30 minutes on foot or 15 minutes by bus (the stops are located at Grand Port or Avenue du Grand Port, 250/100 m away).

Aix-les-Bains station is served by the TGV high-speed train, which takes you to Paris in 3 hours..

### 7.4. Cars

Secure parking for 5 cars is available alongside the house (left-hand driveway and right-hand driveway). For other cars, spaces are often available on Boulevard Garibaldi. The **Grand Port car park** 100 metres away is free outside the peak summer months.

### 7.5. Bikes

Bikes can be hired at Le Grand Port for a day or a week. If you are hiring for several days, you can store them either in the house in the storage room on the ground floor or in the adjoining outdoor cabin.

Two bicycles are available if you just need to get some bread from the bakery or go for a short ride. Never leave a bike unattended. Thieves are never on holiday. There is a bike lock available. Don't hesitate to use it! There is also a bicycle pump on the premises.

### 7.6. Public transport

There are two bus stops within two minutes of the house, at the Grand Port and on Avenue du Grand Port on the left as you leave the house (at the crossroads). **Line 1** and

**line 11** give you total freedom to explore the pretty town of Aix les Bains and its surrounding area, as the line goes as far as Bourget du Lac.

## 8. Health, safety and emergencies

### 8.1. Alarm/Safety devices

The house is equipped with a carbon monoxide and smoke detector.

The house is also equipped with a state-of-the-art security device linked to the smart lock. Don't panic, Big Brother isn't watching you because we'll never be able to photograph you because these devices are equipped with a cover that protects your privacy at all times. For the motion detectors to work, simply remove the cover.

You benefit from these systems for your own safety. The door contact detectors will protect you and your possessions in the event of an intruder, and the connected smoke detector alerts us in the event of a fire. Guaranteed peace of mind all round.

### 8.2. How to use the alarm

For security purposes, the house is equipped with a Verisure alarm and a smart lock.

#### When you arrive:

- Go to the back of the house, where there are two glass doors.
- Go to the door on the right.
- To the right of this door is a black keypad.
- Press the disable button.
- Enter the access code you received in your welcome message. (For even numbers, press twice quickly).
- Wait a few seconds: the door will unlock automatically in two stages.



#### During your stay:

- To your left as you enter, a white keypad allows you to manage the alarm.
- The alarm can remain disabled when you are inside.
- To activate the partial alarm, press the partial alarm button.
- If you leave the house, activate the full alarm by pressing the button and leave the premises within 30 seconds.



#### When you leave:

On the external keypad, activate the alarm:

- Press the button



- Enter your code
- The door locks automatically after activation.
- To simply lock the door without activating the alarm: press this button without entering a code.

#### *In the event of a problem:*

If the alarm is triggered, the Verisure centre will contact us immediately via the voice unit, so, if you have triggered it by mistake, please send us a text message to warn us straight away.

If you have any questions or concerns, contact us via the Airbnb messaging system or by phone.

#### *Recommendations:*

- Never share your code.
- Never dismantle or tamper with any Verisure equipment.
- If in doubt, contact us immediately.

### 8.3. Oops, a slight problem !

If you have a maintenance problem during your stay, don't hesitate to contact us to sort it out. We have someone who can help with minor problems (plumbing, locksmiths, etc.).

In the event of a more serious problem, the numbers of the police and information on duty pharmacies can be found in the 'Emergencies' section.

In the event of a power cut during your stay, the electric cabinet is located in the storage room on the ground floor, on your left as you enter.
