## ANGELUS ADDRESS

of Pope Francis

Saint Peter's Square

Sunday, 2 July 2017



Today's liturgy presents to us the last lines of the missionary discourse in Chapter 10 of the Gospel of Matthew (cf. 10:37-42), by which Jesus instructs the 12 Apostles at the moment in which, for the first time, he sends them on mission to the villages of Galilee and Judea. In this final part, Jesus underscores two essential aspects for the life of a missionary disciple: the first, that his *bond with Jesus is stronger* than any other bond; the second, that the *missionary brings not himself, but Jesus*, and through Him the love of the heavenly Father. These two aspects are connected, because the more Jesus is at the center of the heart and of the life of a disciple, the more this disciple is "transparent" to His presence. The two go hand in hand.

"He who loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me..." (v. 37), Jesus says. A father's affection, a mother's tenderness, the gentle friendship among brothers and sisters, all this, even while being very good and valid, cannot be placed before Christ. Not because he wants us to be heartless and ungrateful, but rather, on the contrary, because the condition of a disciple demands a priority relationship with the teacher. Any disciple, whether a layman or laywoman, a priest or a bishop: an all-absorbing relationship. Perhaps the first question that we must ask a Christian is: "Do you meet with Jesus? Do you pray to Jesus?". The relationship. One could almost paraphrase the Book of Genesis: Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and cleave to Jesus and the two shall become one (cf. Gen 2:24).

Those who allow themselves to be drawn into this bond of love and of life with the Lord Jesus become his representatives, his "ambassadors", above all in the way of being, of living. To the point that Jesus himself, in sending his disciples on mission, says to them: "He who receives you receives me, and he who receives me receives him who sent me" (Mt 10:40). It is important that the people be able to perceive that for that disciple Jesus is truly "the Lord"; He is truly the center of his or her life, the everything of life.

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La liturgia nos presenta las últimas frases del discurso misionero del capítulo 10 del Evangelio de Mateo (cf. 10, 37), con el cual Jesús instruye a los doce apóstoles en el momento en el que, por primera vez les envía en misión a las aldeas de Galilea y Judea. En esta parte final Jesús subraya dos aspectos esenciales para la vida del discípulo misionero: el primero, que su vínculo con Jesús es más fuerte que cualquier otro vínculo; el segundo, que el misionero no se lleva a sí mismo, sino a Jesús, y mediante él, el amor del Padre celestial. Estos dos aspectos están conectados, porque cuanto más está Jesús en el centro del corazón y de la vida del discípulo, más "transparente" es este discípulo ante su presencia. Van juntos, los dos.

«El que ama a su padre o a su madre más que a mí, no es digno de mí...» (v. 37), dice Jesús. El afecto de un padre, la ternura de una madre, la dulce amistad entre hermanos y hermanas, todo esto, aun siendo muy bueno y legítimo, no puede ser antepuesto a Cristo. No porque Él nos quiera sin corazón y sin gratitud, al contrario, es más, sino porque la condición del discípulo exige una relación prioritaria con el maestro. Cualquier discípulo, ya sea un laico, una laica, un sacerdote, un obispo: la relación prioritaria. Quizás la primera pregunta que debemos hacer a un cristiano es: «¿Pero tú te encuentras con Jesús? ¿Tú rezas a Jesús?». La relación. Se podría casi parafrasear el Libro del Génesis: Por eso deja el hombre a su padre y a su madre y se une a Jesucristo, y se hacen una sola cosa (cf. Génesis 2, 24). Quien se deja atraer por este vínculo de amor y de vida con el Señor Jesús, se convierte en su representante, en su "embajador", sobre todo con el modo de ser, de vivir. Hasta el punto en que Jesús mismo, enviando a sus discípulos en misión, les dice: «Quien a vosotros recibe, a mí me recibe, y quien me recibe a mí, recibe a Aquel que me ha enviado» (Mateo 10, 40). Es necesario que la gente pueda percibir que para ese discípulo Jesús es verdaderamente "el Señor", es verdaderamente el centro de su vida, el todo de la vida.
